The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois PPA") has reviewed the Corrective Action Completion Report Parcel F051-Tank VR-51 which has been submitted for the above-referenced LUST incident. This information was dated September 2, 1997, was received by the Agency September 26, 1997, and was prepared by Morrison Kandson Corporation.

The Corrective Action Completion Report and the Professional Engine Certification submitted pursuant to 35 Illinois Administrative Code Section 732.300(b)(1) and Section 732.409(b) indicate that the remediation objectives set forth in 35 Illinois Administrative Code Section 732.408 have been met.

Based upon (a) the certification by Robert Hlavacek, a Registered Professional Engineer of Illinois, (b) the certification by Lt. 







APPENDIX I

An underground storage tank owner or operator may appeal this final decision to the !llinois Pollution Control Board ("Board") pursuant to Section 57.8(i) and Section 40 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act. An owner or operator who seeks to appeal the Agency's decision may, within 35 days of the date of mailing of the Agency's final decision, petition for a hearing before the Board; however, the 35-day period may be extended for a period of time not to exceed 90 days by written notice provided to the Board from the applicant and the Agency within the 35day initiai appeal period.
