Borrower covenants that Borrower is lawfully seised of the estate hereby conveyed and has the right to mortgage, grant and convey the Property, and that the Property is unencumbered, except for encumbrances of record. Borrower covenants that Borrower warrants and will defend generally the title to the Property against all claims and demands, subject to encumbrances of record.

Payment of Principal and Interest. Borrower shall pay when due the principal and interest indebtedness and late charges evidenced by the Note.

Borrower shall preserve and maintain the liens created hereby on the Property, including any improvements hereafter made a part of the realty. Borrower will not let any mechanic's or other workmen's judgment lien attach to the Property.

Application of Payments. Unless applicable law provides otherwise, all payments received by Lender shall be applied by

Lender according to the terms of the Note.

Prior Mortgages and Deeds of Trust; Charges; Liens. Borrower shall perform all of Borrower's obligations under any mortgage, deed of trust or other security agreement with a lien which has priority over this Mortgage, including Borrower's covenants to make payments when due. Borrower shall pay or cause to be paid all taxes, assessments and other charges, fines and impositions attributable to the Property which may attain a priority hereover, and leasehold payments or ground rents, if any.

- Insurance. All insurance policies and renewals thereof shall be in a form acceptable to Lender and shall include a standard mortgage clause in favor of and in a form acceptable to Lender, Lender shall lave the right to hold the policies and renewals thereof, subject to the terms of any mortgage, deed of trust or other security agreement with a lien which has priority over this Mortgage. In the event of loss, Borrower shall give prompt notice to the insurance carrie, and Lender, Lender may make proof of loss if not made promptly by Borrower. If the Property is abandoned by Borrower, or it Porrower fails to respond to Lender within 30 days from the date notice is mailed by Lender to Borrower that the insurance confers to settle a claim for insurance benefits, Lender is authorized to collect and apply the insurance proceeds at Lender's option either to restoration or repair of the Property or to the sums secured by this Mortgage. In addition, Borrower agrees to maintain flood insurance with Beneficiary as loss payce in an amount equal to the principal outstanding during the term of said indebte Irass if required pursuant to the Flood Disaster Protective Act (42 U.S.C. 4012a).
- Preservation and Maintenance of Property; Leaseholds; Condominiums; Planned Unit Developments. - Protection of Lender's Security. If Borrower fails to perform the covenants and agreements contained in this Mortgage, or if any action or proceeding is commenced which materially affects Lender's interest in the Property, then Lender, at Lender's option, upon notice to Borrower, may make such appearances, disburse such sums, including reasonable attorneys' fees, and take such action as is necessary to protect Lender's interest. If Lender required mortgage insurance as a condition of making the loan secured by this Mortgage, Borrower shall pay the premiums required to mai stain such insurance in effect until such time as the requirement for such insurance terminates in accordance with Borrower's and Lender's written agreement or applicable law. Unless Borrower and Lender agree to othe telms of payment, such amounts shall be payable upon notice from Lender to Borrower requesting payment thereof. Nothing contained in this paragraph 7 shall require Lender to incur any expense or take any action hereunder.

Inspection. Lender may make or cause to be made reasonable entries upon and inspections of the Property, provided that Lender shall give Borrower notice prior to any such inspection specifying reasonable cause therefor related to Lender's interest in

the Property.

Condemnation. The proceeds of any award or claim for damages, direct or consequential, in conacction with any condemnation or other taking of the Property, or part thereof, or for conveyance in lieu of condemnation, are type by assigned and shall be paid to Lender, subject to the terms of any mortgage, deed of trust or other security agreement with a lien which has priority hereover.

Borrower Not Released; Forbearance By Lender Not a Waiver. Extension of the time for payment or modification of 10. amortization of the sums secured by this Mortgage granted by Lender to any successor in interest of Borrower shall not operate to release, in any manner, the liability of the original Borrower and Borrower's successors in interest. Any forbearance by Lender in exercising any right or remedy hereunder, or otherwise afforded by applicable law, shall not be a waiver of or preclude the exercise of any such right or remedy.

Notice. Except for any notice required under applicable law to be given in another manner, (a) any notice to Borrower provided for in this Mor gage shall be given by delivering it or by mailing such notice by certified mail addressed to Borrower at the Property Address or at such other address as Borrower may designate by notice to Lender as provided herein, and (b) any notice to Lender shall be given by certified mail to Lender's address stated herein or to such other address as Lender may designate by notice to Borrower as provided herein. In the event that any provision or clause of this Mortgage or the Note conflicts with applicable law, such conflict shall not affect other provisions of this Mortgage or the Note which can be given effect without the conflicting provision, and to this end the provisions of this Mortgage are the Note are declared to be severable. As used herein, "costs", "expenses" and "attorneys' fees" include all sums to the extent not prohibited by applicable law or limited herein.

14. Borrower's Copy Borrower shall be furnished a copy of the Note and Mortgage at the time of execution hereof.

15. Rehabilitation Loan agreement. Borrower shall fulfill all of Borrower's obligations under any home rehabilitation, improvement, repair or other (ca) agreement which Borrower enters into with Lender. Lender, at Lender's option, may require Borrower to execute and deliver (o) ender, in a form acceptable to Lender, an assignment of any rights, claims or defenses which Borrower may have against parties was supply labor, materials or services in connection with improvements made to the Property.

16. Transfer of the Property or a Beneficial Interest in Borrower. 17. Acceleration; Remedies. Except as provided in paragraph 16 h recf. upon Borrower's breach of any covenant or agreement of Borrower in this Mortgage, including the covenants to pay when due any sur is secured by this Mortgage, Lender prior to acceleration shall give notice to Borrower as provided in paragraph 12 hereof specifying (1) the breach; (2) the action required to cure such breach; (3) a date, not less than 10 days from the date the notice is mailed to Borrower, by which such breach must be cured; and (4) that failure to cure such breach on or before the date specified in the notice may result in acceleration of the sums secured by this Mortgage, foreclosure by judicial proceeding, and sale of the Property. The notice shall further inform Borrower of the right to reinstate after acceleration and the right to assert in the foreclosure proceeding the nonexistence of a default or any other defense of Borrower to acceleration and foreclosure. If the breach is not cured on or before the date specified in the notice, Lender, at Lender's option, may declare all of the sums secured by this Mortgage to be immediately due and payable without further demand and may foreclose this Mortgage by judicial proceeding. 20. Release. Upon payment of all sums secured by this Mortgage, Lender shall release this Mortgage without charge to Borrower. Borrower shall pay all costs of recordation, if any.

21. Waiver of Homestead. Borrower hereby waives all right of homestead exemption in the Property.
