That part of the East half of Section 16, together with that part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 15, both in Township 40 North, Range 12 East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois, more particularly described as follows:

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

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") has reviewed the P.E. Certification Form and Legal Description and Real Estate Tax Index Form submitted for the above-referenced incident. This information was dated April 23, 1998; was received by the Agency April 27, 1998; and was prepared by Ram Engineering, Ltd.

The Site Classification Completion Report and associated Professional Engineer Certification indicate that this site is classified as "No Further Action" as identified in Section 57.7(b)(2) of the Environmental Protection Act and 35 Illinois Administrative Code Section 722.302(a).

Based upon the certification by Robert Mehrens, a Registered Professional Engineer of Illinois, and pursuant to Section 57.10 of the Environment Protection Act ("Act") (415 ILCS 5/17.11) your request for a no further remediation determination is granted under the conditions and terms specified in this letter.

Issuance of this No Further Remediation Letter ("Letter"), based on the certification of the Registered Professional Engineer, signifies that: (1) all statutory and regulatory corrective action requirements applicable to the occurrence have been complied with; (2) all corrective action concerning the occurrence has been completed; and (3) no further remediation concerning the occurrence is necessary for the protection of human health, safety and the environment. Pursuant to Section 57.10(d) of the Act, this Letter shall apply in favor of the following persons:
