C.T.I.C. MORTGAGE

THIS MORTGAGE IS DATED September 25, 1938, between John F. McDonaugh and Joan McDonaugh, his wife (referred to below as "Grantor"); and The First National Bank of Lincolnwood, a national banking association, 6401 N. Lincoln Avenue, Lincolnwood, Illinois 60645-4089 (referred to below as "Lender").

GRANT OF MORTGAGE. DEFINITIONS. The following words shall have the following meanings when used in this Mortgage:

Grantor. The word 'Grantor' means the mortgagor under this Mortgage.

Guarantor. The word "Guarantor" means and includes without limitation, each and all of the guarantors, sureties, and accommodation parties in connection with the indebtedness.

Improvements. The word "improvements" means and includes without limitation all existing and future improvements, fixtures, buildings, structures, mobile homes affixed on the Real Estate, facilities, additions and other construction on the Real Estate.

Indebtedness. The word "Indebtedness" means all principal and interest payable under the Note and any amounts expended or advanced by Lender to discharge obligations of Grantor or expenses incurred by Lender to enforce obligations of Grantor under this Mortgage, together with interest on such amounts as provided in this Mortgage.

Lender. The word "Lender' means The First National Bank of Lincolnwood, its successors and assigns. The Lender is the my tigated under this Mortgage.

Mortgage. The word 'Mortgage' means this Mortgage between Grantor and Lender.

Payment & Interest field Provisions. The principal sum and interest on said Note to be payable at the rate of 7,000% per annum in installments as follows: Six Hundred Twenty Nine and 18/100--- Dollars or more on the 1st day of December, 1998, and Six Hundred Twenty Nine and 18/100--- Dollars or more on the 1st day of each and every month thereafter until said note is fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due on the 1st day of December, 2013. All it stalment payments received on said note shall be auptied first to the payment of interest accound to the date the instalment is paid, and any amount remaining from an instalment after application to interest shall be applied in reduction of unpaid pricipal. If the monthly instalment payment is insufficient to pay the interest accound for any month, the Grantor agrees to pay the actual billing from the bank of interest accound for that month. Interest on said note shall increase to a rate per annum of 8.00% upon an Event of Delault, or after the due date of the final instalment until all flabitiles are paid. Interest on said note will be computed based upon a 365-day year for the actual number of days elapsed. All of said principal and interest being made layable at the office of The First National Bank of Lincolnwood, 6401 N. Lincoln Avenue, Lincolnwood, fillnots 60645.

Risal Estate. The words "Real Estate" mean the property, in erects and rights described above in the "Grant of Mortgage" section.

Related Documents. The words "Related Documents" mean and include without limitation all instalment notes, loan agreements, guaranties, security agreements, morigages, deeds of trust, assignment of rents and all other instruments, agreements and documents, whether now or hereafter existing, executed in or ninection with the indebtedness.

Rents. The word "Rents" means all present and future rents, revenues, income tractes, royalites, profits, and other benefits derived from the Real Estate.

THIS MORTGAGE IS GIVEN TO SECURE (1) PAYMENT OF THE INDEBTEDNESS AND (2) PERFORMANCE OF ALL OBLIGATIONS OF GRANTOR UNDER THIS MORTGAGE AND THE RELATED DOCUMENTS. THIS MORTGAGE IS GIVEN AND ACCEPTED ON THE FOLLOWING TERMS:

PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE. Except as otherwise provided in this Mortgage, Grantor shall pay to Lender all aircunts secured by this Mortgage as they become due, and shall strictly perform all of Grantor's obligations under this Mortgage.

POSSESSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PROPERTY. Grantor agrees that Grantor's possession and use of time it estate shall be governed by the following provisions:

Possession and Use, Until an Event of Default, Grantor may remain in possession and control of and operate and manage the Real Estate and collect the Rents from the Real Estate.

Duty to Maintein. Grantor shall maintein the Real Estate in tonantable condition and promptly perform all repairs, replacements, and maintenance necessary to preserve its value.

Hazardous Bubstances. The terms 'hazardous waste,' 'hazardous substance,' 'disposal,' 'release,' and 'threatened release,' as used in this Mortgage, shall have the same meanings as sel forth in the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and (Jability Act cr1980, as amended, 42 U.S.C. Section 9601, et seq. ("CERCLA"), the Superfund Amendmentsand Reauthorization Act of 1986, Pub.L.No. 99-499("SARA"), the Hazardous Malerials Transportation Act, 49 U.S.C. Section 1801, et seq., the Resource Conservation and RecoveryAct, 49 U.S.C. Section 6901, et seq., or other applicable state or Federal laws, rules, orregulations adopted pursuant to any of the foregoing. The terms 'hazardous waste' and 'hazardous substance' shall also include, without limitation, petroleum and petroleum by-products or any fraction thereof and aspectos. Grantor represents and warrants to Lender that: (a) During the period of Grantor's ownership of the Real Estate there has been no use-generation, manufacture, storage, treatment, disposal, release or threatened release of any

hazardous waste or hazardous substance by any person on, under, or about the Real Estate; (b) Grantor has no knowledge of, or reason to believe that there has been, except as previously disclosed to and acknowledged by Lender in writing, (i) any use, generation, manufacture, storage, treatment, disposal, release, or threatened release of any hazardouswaste or hazardous substance by any prior owners or occupants of the Real Estate or (ii) any actual or threatened litigation or claims of any kind by any person relating to such matters, and (c) Except as previously disclosed to and acknowledged by Lender in writing, (i) neither Grantor nor any tenant, contractor, agent or other authorized user of the Real Estate shall use, generate, manulacture, store, treat, dispose of, or release any hazardous waste or hazardous substance on, under, or about the Real Estate and (ii) any such activity shall beconducted in compliance with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations and ordinances, including without limitation those laws, regulations and ordinances described above. Grantor authorizes Lender and its agents to enter upon the Real Estate to make suchinspections and tests as Lender may deem appropriate to determine compliance of the Real Estate with this section of the Mortgage. Any inspections or tests made by Lender shall be for Lender's purposes only and shall not be construed to create any responsibility or liability on the part of Lender to Grantor or to any other person. The representations and warranties contained herein are based on Grantor's due diligence in investigating the Real Estate for hazardous waste. Granter hereby (a) releases and waives any future claims against Lender for indomnity or contribution in the event Grantor becomes liable for cloanup or other costs under any such laws, and (b) agrees to indemnity and hold harmless Lender against any and all claims, losses, liabilities, damages, penalties, and expenses which lender may directly or indirectly sustain or suffer resulting from a breach of this section of the Mortgage or as a consoluting of any use, generation, manufacture, storage, diaposal, release or threatened release occurring prior to Granto's concerning or interest in the Real Estate, whether or not the same was or should have been known to Grantor. The provisions of this section of the Mortgage, including the obligation to indemnify, shall survive the payment of the indebtedness and the satisfaction and reconveyance of the illen of this Mortgage and shall not be affected by Lender's acquisition of any interest in the Real Estate, whether by foreclosure or otherwise.

Nulsance, Waste, Cantor shall not cause, conduct or permit any nulsance nor commit, permit, or suffer any stripping of or waste on or to the Brial Estate or any portion of the Real Estate. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, Grantor will not remove, or grant to any other party the right to remove, any timber, minerals (including oil and gas), soil, gravel or rock products without the prior virition consent of Lender.

Removal of Improvements. Greater that not demolish or remove any improvements from the Real Estate without the prior written consent of Lender. As a condition to the removal of any improvements, Lender may require Grantor to make arrangements satisfactoryto Londer to replace such improvements with improvements of at least equal value.

Lender's Right to Enter. Lender and its offer a and representatives may enter upon the Reat Estate at all reasonable times to attend to Lender's interests and to inspect the Real Estate for purposes of Grantor's compliance with the terms and conditions of this Mortgage

Compliance with Governmental Requirements. Gantor shall promptly comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations, now or hereafter in effect, of all governmental authorities applicable to the use or occupancy of the Real Estate. Granter may contest in goodfaith any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Grantor has notified Lender's writing prior to doing so and so long as, in Lender's sole opinion, Lender's interests in the Roal Estate are not jeopardized tunner may require Grantor to post adequate security or a surety bond, reasonably satisfactory to Lender, to pretect Lender, interest

Duty to Protect. Granter agrees neither to abandon nor leave unattended the Field Estate. Granter shall do all other acts, in addition to those acts set forth above in this section, which from the character are use of the Real Estate are reasonably necessary to protect and preserve the Real Estate.

DUE ON SALE - CONSENT BY LENDER. Lender may, at its option, declare immediately due and payable all sums secured by this Mongage upon the sale or transfer, without the Lendor's prior written consent, of all or any part of the Revi Estate, or any interest in the Real Estate. A "sale or transfer means the conveyance of Real Estate or any right, title or interest therein, ", no. her legal or equitable; whether voluntary or involuntary, whether by outright sale, doed, instalment sale contract, land contract, contract for doed, leasehold interest with a term greater than three (3) years, lease-option contract, or by sale, assignment, or transfer or any uncollicial interest in or to any land trust holding title to the Real Estate, or by any other method of conveyance of a Real Estate interest. If any Grantor is a corporation or partnership, transfer also includes any change in ownership of more than twenty-five percent (25%) of the voting stock or partnership interests, as the case may be, of Grantor.

TAXES AND LIENS. The following provisions relating to the taxes and liens on the Real Estate are a part of this Mortgage:

Payment. Grantor shall pay when due (and in all events prior to delinquency) all taxes, payroll taxes, special taxes, assessments, water charges and sewer service charges levied against or on account of the Real Estate, and shall pay when due all claims for work done or for services rendered or material furnished to the Real Estate. Grantor shall maintain the Real Estate free of all liens having priority over or equal to the interest of Londer under this Morigage, except for the lien of taxes and assessments not due, and except as provided in the following paragraph.

Right to Contest. Grantor may withhold payment of any tax, assessment, or claim in connection with a good faith dispute over the obligation to pay, so long as Lendor's interestin the Real Estate is not jeopardized. If a lien arises or is filled as aresult of nonpayment, Grantor shall within fifteen (15) days after the lien arises or, if a lien is filed, within fifteen (15) days after Grantor has notice of the filing, secure the discharge of the lien, or if requested by Lender, deposit with Lander cash or a sufficient corporate surely bond or other security satisfactory to Londer in an amount sufficient to discharge the lien plus any costs and attorneys' fees or other charges that could accrue as eresult of a foreclosure or sale under the lien. In any contest, Grantor shall defend itself and Lender and shall satisfy any adverse judgment before enforcement against the Real Estate. Grantor shall name Lender as an additional obligee under any surely bond furnished in the contest proceedings.

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Evidence of Payment. Grantor shall upon demand furnish to Lender satisfactory evidence of payment of the taxes or assessments and shall authorize the appropriate governmental official to deliver to Lender at any time a written statement of the taxes and assessments against the Real Estate.

Notice of Construction. Grantor shall notify Lender at least lifteen (15) days before any work is commenced, any services are turnished, or any materials are supplied to the Real Estate. If any mechanic's lien, materialmen's lien, or other lien could be asserted on account of the work, services, or materials. Grantor will upon request of Lender lumian to Lender advance assurances satisfactory to Lender that Grantor can and will pay the cost of such improvements.

PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE. The following provisions relating to insuring the Real Estate are a part of this Mortgage:

Maintenance of Insurance. Grantor shall procure and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable value covering all improvements on the Real Estate in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a standard mortgage clause in favor of Lender. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Lender. Grantor shall refer to Lender certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or shall she without a minimum of ten (10) days' prior written notice to Lender and not containing any disclaimer of the insurer's mubility for failure to give such notice. Should the Real Estate at any time become located in an area designated by the Direct of the Federal Emergency Management Agency as a special flood hazard area, Grantor agrees to obtain and maintain Formal Flood insurance, to the extent such insurance is required and is or becomes available, for the term of the foan and for a federal principal balance of the loan, or the maximum limit of coverage that is available, whichever is less.

Application of Price ids. Grantor shall promptly notify Lender of any loss or damage to theReat Estate. Lender may make proof of loss if Granto Islis to do so within little-ni15) days of the casualty. Whether or not Lender's security is impaired, Lender may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the indebteriness, payment of any lien affecting the Real Estate, or the restoration and repair of the Real Estate. If Lender elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repair, Grantor shall repair or replace the Amaged or destroyed improvements in a manner satisfactory to Lender. Lender shall upon satisfactory proof of such expenditure, pay or reimburse Grantor from the proceeds for the reasonable cost of repair or restoration if Grantor is not in default hereunder. Any proceeds which have not been disbursed within 180 days after their receipt and which Lender has not committee to the repair or restoration of the Real Estate shall be used first to pay any amount owing to Lender under this Mortgate, and the remainder, if any, shall be applied to the principal balance of the indebtedness. If Lender holds any proceeds after the full of the indebtedness, such proceeds shall be paid to Grantor

Unexpired insurance at Sate. Any unexpired insurance shall inure to the benefit of, and pass to, the purchaser of the Real Estate covered by this Mortgage at any sale hell under the provisions of this Mortgage, or at any foreclosure sale of such Real Estate.

EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. If Grantor fails to comply with any provides of this Mortgage, or it any action or proceeding is commenced that would materially affect Lender's interests in the Real Estate, Lender on Grantor's behalf may, but shall not be required to, take any action that Lender deems appropriate. Any amount that Lender expends is a doing shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and the interest thereon at a rate equivalent to the Event of Default rate set forth in the Note securing this Mortgage. The rights provided for in this paragraph shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Lender may be entitled on account of the default. Any such action by Lender shall not be construed as curing the default so as to bar Lender from any remedy that it otherwise would have had.

WARRANTY; DEFENSE OF TITLE. The following provisions relating to ownership of the Real Estate are a part of this Mortgage:

Title, Grantor warrants that: (a) Grantor holds good and marketable title of record to the Reat Setale in fee simple, tree and older of all flens and enoumbrances other than those set forth in the Reat Setale description or my this insurance policy, title report, or final title opinion issued in favor of, and accepted by, Lender in connection with this Mort age, and (b) Grantor has the full right, power, and authority to execute and deliver this Mortpage to Lender.

Defense of Title. Subject to the exception in the paragraph above. Grantor warrants and will forever defend the title to the Real Estate against the tawful claims of all persons. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's title or the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, Grantor shall defend the action at Grantor's expense. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of Lender's own choice, and Grantor will deliver, or cause to be delivered, to Lender such instruments as Lender may request from time to time to permit such participation.

Compliance With Laws. Grantor warrants that the Real Estate and Grantor's use of the Real Estate complies with all existing applicable laws, ordinances, and regulations of government authorities.

CONDEMNATION. The following provisions relating to condemnation of the Real Estate are a part of this Mortgage:

Application of Net Proceeds. If all or any part of the Heal Estate is condemned by eminent domain proceedings or by any proceeding or purchase in lieu of condemnation, Lendermay at its election require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the sward be applied to the indebtedness or the repair or restoration of the Real Estate. The net proceeds of the award after payment of all reasonable costs, expenses, and attorney's fees incurred by Lender in connection with the condemnation.

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Proceedings. If any proceeding in condemnation is filed, Grantor shall promptly notify Lender in writing, and Grantor shall promptly take such steps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the award. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice, and Grantor will deliver or cause to be delivered to Lender such instruments as may be requested by it from time to time to permit such participation.

FULL PERFORMANCE. If Grantor pays all the indebtedness when due, and otherwise performs all the obligations imposed upon Grantor under this Mortgage, Lender shall execute and deliver to Grantor a suitable satisfaction or release of this Mortgage. Grantor will pay any reasonable release fee as determined by Lender from time to time

DEFAULT. Each of the following, at the option of Lender, shall constitute an event of default ("Event of Default") under this Mortgage:

Default on Indebtedness, Failure of Grantor to make any payment when due on the indebtedness.

Default on Other Payments. Failure of Grantor within the time required by this Mortgage to make any payment for taxes or insurance, or any other payment necessary to prevent filling of or to effect discharge of any lien.

Compliance Default. Failure to comply with any other term, obligation, covenant or condition contained in this Mortgage, the Note or in any of the Related Documents.

Breaches. Your varranty, representation or statement made or furnished to Lender by or on behalf of Grantor under this Mortgage, the Notice the Related Documents is, or at the time made or furnished was, false in any material respect.

Insolvency. The insolvercy of Grantor, appointment of a receiver for any part of Grantor's property, any assignment for the benefit of creditors, the commencement of any proceeding under any bankruptcy or insolvency laws by or against Grantor, or the dissolution or termination of Grantor's existence as a going business (if Grantor is a business).

Foreclosure, Forfetture, etc. Commencement of foreclosure or forfeiture proceedings, whether by judicial proceeding, self-help, repossession or any other inathod, by any creditor of Grantor or by any governmental agency against the Fleat Estate. However, this subsection shall not apply in the event of a good faith dispute by Grantor as to the validity or reasonableness of the claim which is the hard of the foreclosure or forfeiture proceeding, provided that Grantor gives Lender written notice of such claim and furnishes reserver, or a surety bond for the claim satisfactory to Lender.

Breach of Other Agreement. Any breach by Grantur inder the terms of any other agreement between Grantor and Lender that is not remedied within any grace period privided therein, including without fimiliation any agreement concerning any indebtedness or other obligation of Grantor to Lender, whather now or flareafter existing.

Events Affecting Guarantor. Any of the preceding events occurs with respect to any Guarantor of any of the indebtedness or such Guarantor dies or bocomes incompetent.

RIGHTS AND REMEDIES ON DEFAULT. Upon the occurrence of any Event of Carault and at any time thereafter, Lender, at its option, may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies in addition to any one or remedies provided by law:

Accelerate Indebtedness. Lender shall have the right at its option without notice to Grantor to declare the entire indebtedness immediately due and payable, including any prepayment ponalty which Crantor would be required to pay.

Coffect Rents. Lender shall have the right, without notice to Grantor, to take possession if the Real Estate and collect the Rents, including amounts past due and unpaid, and apply the net proceeds, over and above Lender's costs, against the indebtedness in furtherance of this right. Lender may require any tenant or other user of the Real Estate to make payments of rent or user less directly to Lender. If the Rents are collected by Lender, then Grantor irrevocally de lignates Lender as Grantor's attorney-in-fact to endorse instruments received in payment thereof in the name of Grantor and to negotiate the same and collect the proceeds. Payments by tenants or other users to Lender in response to Lender's deriand shall satisfy the obligations for which the payments are made, whether or not any proper grounds for the demand exister', Lender may exercise its rights under this subparagraph either in person, by agent, or through a receiver.

Mortgages in Possession. Lendershall have the right to be placed as mortgages in possession or to have a receiver appointed to take possession of all or any part of the Real Estate, with the power to protect and preserve the Real Estate, to operate the Real Estate preceding loreclosure or sale, and to collect the Rents from the Real Estate and apply the proceeds, over and above the cost of the receivership, against the indebtedness. The mortgages in possession or receiver may serve without bond. Lender's right to the appointment of a receiver shall exist whether or not the apparent value of the Real Estate exceeds the indebtedness by a substantial amount. Employment by Lender shall not disquality a person from serving as a receiver

Judicial Forectosure. Lender may obtain a judicial decree foreclosing Grantor's interest in all or any part of the Real Estate

Deficiency Judgment. Lender may obtain a judgment for any deficiency remaining in the indebtedness due to Lender after application of all amounts received from the exercise of the rights provided in this section.

Other Remedies. Lender shall have all other rights and remedies provided in this Mortgage or the Note available at law or in equity.

Sale of the Property. In exercising its rights and remedies, Lender shall be free to sell all or any part of the Real Estate together or separately, in one sale or by separate sales. Lender shall be entitled to bid at any public sale on all or any portion of the Real Estate.

Waiver; Election of Remedies. A waiver by any party of a breach of a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's rights otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. Election by Lender to pursue any remedy shall not exclude pursuit of any other remedy, and an election to make expenditures or take action to perform an obligation of Grantor under this Mortgage after failure of Grantor to perform shall not affect Lender's right to declare a default and exercise its remedies under this Mortgage.

Attorneys' fees; Expenses. If Lenderinstitutes any suit or action to enforce any of the terms of this Mortgage, Lender shall be entitled to recover such sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as attorney's fees, at trial and on any appeal. Whether or not any court action is involved, all mesonable expenses incurred by Lender that in Lender's opinion are necessary at any time for the protection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the indebtedness payable un demand and shall bear interest from the date of expenditure until repaid at the Note rate. Expenses covered by this paragraph include, without limitation, Lender's attorneys' fees and Lender's legal expenses whether or not ther. Is a lawsuit, including attorneys' fees for bankruptcy proceedings (including efforts to modify or vacate any automatic stay or injunction), appeals and any anticipated post-judgment collection services, the cost of searching records, obtaining title rezion's (including foreclosure reports), surveyors'reports, and appraisal fees, and title insurance. Grantor size will pay any opur covite, in addition to all other sums provided by faw.

NOTICES TO GRANTON AND OTHER PARTIES. Any notice under this Mortgage, including without limitation any notice of default and any notice of eale to Crance, shall be in writing and shall be effective when actually delivered or.
