## Section 3-4 of the Illinois Statutory Short Form Power of Attorney for Property Law

Section 3-4. Explanation of powers granted in the statutory short form power of altorney for property. This best on defines each category of powers listed in the statutory short form power of altorney for property and the effect of granting powers to an agent. When the title of any of the following categories is retained (no) struck out) in a statutory property power form, the effect will be to grant the agent all of the principal's rights, powers and discretions will inspect to the types of property and transactions covered by the retained category, subject to any limitations on the granted powers that appear on the lace of the form. - (c) Stock and band transactions. The opent is authorized to: buy and sell all types of securities (which term includes, without limitation, stocks, bands, mutual lunds and all other types of investment securities and liminated instruments); collect, hold and safekeep off dividends, interest, eathings, proceeds of sale, distributions, shares, certificates and other evidences of awnership paid or distributed with respect to securities; exercise all voting rights with respect to securities in person or by praxy, enter into voting trusts and consent to limitations on the right to value and its necessity enter in a contributed with respect to securities.

- (e) Sale deposit box transactions. The agent is authorized to: open, continue and have access to all sole deposit boxes; sign, renew, release or terminate any sale deposit contract; drill or surrender any sale deposit box; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to sale deposit matters which the principal could it present and under no disability.
- (f) Insurance and annulty transactions. The agent is authorized to: procure, acquire, continue, renew, terminate or alherwise deal with any type of insurance or annulty contract (which terms include, without limitation, life, accident, lealth, disability, automobile casualty, property or liability insurance); pay premiums or assessments on or surrender and collect all distributions, proceeds or benefits payable under any insurance or annulty contract; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to insurance and annulty contracts which the principal could if present and under no disability.

The agent is authorized to: buy, sell, exchange, assign, convey, settle and exercise commodities futures contracts and call and put options on stocks and stock indices traded on a regulated options exchange and collect and receipt for all proceeds of any such transactions; establish or continue option occounts for the principal with any securities or futures broker; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to commodities and options which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- (i) Business operations.
