AFFIDAVIT

I, JOSEPH J. DOUGHNEY, being duly sworn on oath, depose and say as follows:

1. I am the duly appointed Director of Code Enforcement of the City of Chicago Heights, a Municipal Corporation of the State of Illinois;

2. That pursuant to Sections 11-22 and 11-26 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Chicago Heights, determination was made on January 9, 1996 that the real estate legally described as:

Lot's 12 & 13 in the Resubdivision of Block 66 (except the East 110 ft. of the South 368.32 ft. and except the North 66 ft. of the West 17.07 ft. thereof) in Chicago Heights, being a Subdivision in the Southwest 1/4 of Section 21, Township 35 North, Range 14, East of the Third Principal Meridian in Cook County, Illinois.
