ORDINANCE NO. 1998-3

ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION OF SANITARY SEWERS IN PORTIONS OF DANMAR TRAIL, FOX LANE, FOX LANE NORTH, FOX LANE SOUTH, HUNTLEIGH ROAD, McCARTHY ROAD (123RD STREET), MEADOW ROAD, MISTY HARBOUR LANE, OAK LANE, OLD CREEK ROAD, OLD TIMBER LANE, POST ROAD, RAIL LANE, RAMSGATE DRIVE, ROMIGA LANE, SUNNYSLOPE ROAD, WILDWOOD TRAIL, WOLF ROAD, 123RD PLACE, 127TH STREET, 129TH COURT, 110TH AVENUE, 114TH AVENUE, 115TH AVENUE, 116TH AVENUE AND IN EASEMENTS
(SPECIAL ASSESSMENT NUMBER 13B)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Council of the Village of Palos Park, Cook County,

Illinois as follows:

Section 1: A local improvement shall be constructed in the Village of Palos Park consisting

of:

A Sanitary Sewer System Expansion which shall extend sanitary sewer service into that portion of the Village of Palos Park now being primarily serviced by individual septic systems of private residences. The Project service area includes the far western portion of the Village located east and west of Wolf Road between McCarthy Road (123rd Street) and just south of Partridge Lane (129th Street). Generally the new watermains will be installed adjacent to streets including: Wolf Road, Fox Lane, Post Road, Rail Lane, Romiga Lane, Wildwood Trail, Old Timber Lane, Huntleigh Road, Partridge Lane, Danmar Trail, Old Creek Road, Oak Lane, Meadow Road, Ramsgate Drive, 123rd Place, 113th Avenue and 114th Avenue

The Project consists of all things necessary for furnishing, coordinating, installing, testing and placing into operation the Sanitary Sewer System Expansion which is described in detail on the Project Drawings and in the Project Specifications. The Project generally consists of sanitary sewer collector system improvements including (but not limited to) the following major items:

- A. Connections to existing sanitary manholes;
- B. Four (4) sanitary lift stations;
- C. Approximately 4710 feet of 4-inch ductile iron forcemain piping;
- D. Approximately 29,170 feet of 8-inch sanitary sewer piping;
- E. Approximately 5,800 feet of 10-inch sanitary sewer piping;
- F. One hundred forty (140) standard sanitary manholes;
- G. Steel casing pip for augered sanitary sewer piping;
- H. Sanitary sewer stubs including laterals and risers and related facilities;

- I. The costs associated with the upgrade of Orland Park's Venture Lift Station and Forcemain Improvements as required by the Intergovernmental Sanitary Sewer Service Agreement (dated 8/25/97);
- J. The costs which exceed the remaining IEPA Build Illinois Grant Funds for construction of the Wolf Road/131st Street Sanitary Interceptor Sewer;
- K. Complete restoration of roads, driveways, culverts and drainage paths, and parkways effected by Project construction.

The construction of the proposed local improvement also requires the taking or acquiring or a dedication of the property described in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made part hereof, for sanitary sewer easement purposes.

Section 2: All materials of every kind and character to be used in the construction of this improvement will be first class quality, suitable for the purpose for which they are to be used, and subject to the inspection and approval of the Village of Palos Park.

All work shall be constructed in a workmanlike manner.

The quantities and types of materials to be used are as set forth in the plans and specifications for the project and are incorporated herein by reference as if fully set forth herein and are approved

All construction methods and materials used in construction of the improvements herein provided for shall conform with the requirements of the Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, issued by the State of Illinois Department of Transportation, adopted January 1, 1997, and the most recent edition of the Standard Specifications for Water and Sewer Main Construction in Illinois, published by the Illinois Society of Professional Engineers, copies of which are on file with the Village Clerk in the Village of Palos Park.

Section 3: The quantities and types of materials to be used are as set forth in the Estimate of Cost, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference

Section 4 The Recommendation of the Board of Local Improvements, the Estimate of Cost thereof and the plans all hereto attached and incorporated herein by reference, be and the same are hereby approved.

Section 5 That said improvement shall be made and the cost thereof, which is estimated to be \$4,474,648.74, shall be paid for by special assessment in accordance with Article 9, Division 2, of Chapter 65 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes; an amount not exceeding \$268,478.92 is hereby provided for to apply towards the payment of all lawful costs and expenses incurred in making, levying and collecting the assessment for said improvement.

Section 6: The aggregate amount herein ordered to be assessed and each individual assessment shall be divided into twenty (20) installments which shall bear interest at the rate of nine percent (9%) per annum until paid, all in the manner and in accordance with the provisions of the aforesaid Article 9, Division 2, of Chapter 65 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, as amended by the Special Assessment Supplemental Bond and Procedure Act (Public Act 90-480), which the Village hereby elects to be applicable to this Special Assessment.

Section 7: For the purposes of anticipating the collection of the second and succeeding installments of said assessment for said improvement, vouchers and/or bonds shall be issued payable out of said installments, bearing interest at the rate of not to exceed nine percent (9%) per annum, payable annually, and signed by the Mayor of the Village and attested by the Village Clerk, under the corporate seal of the Village. The bonds shall be issued in accordance with, and shall in all respects conform to, the provisions of Article 9, Division 2, of Chapter 65 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, as amended by Public Act 90-480, aforesaid.

Section 8 PATRICIA L. JONES, Village Administrator for the Village of Palos Park, is designated as the person to file a petition in the Circuit Court of Cook County, Illinois, as provided by law in the name of the Village, praying that steps may be taken to levy a special assessment for

said improvement in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance and in the manner prescribed by law.

This Ordinance, having been previously published in accordance with law, shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval.

I submit herein an Opinion of the Probable Construction Cost for a Local Improvement in the Village of Palos Park identified as Special Assessment No. 13B. The local improvement consists of the expansion of the sanitary sewer system which is shown in detail on the Project Drawings and described generally herein. The Opinion of Probable Construction Cost, excluding the cost of lands to be taken for easements, includes: the cost of labor and material, complete and in place; the cost of Engineering and Construction Observation; and the cost of making, levying and collecting the Assessment therefor, as provided by Law, in the Village of Palos Park, Cook County, Illinois.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT**

The Sanitary Sewer System Expansion shall extend sanitary sewer service into that portion of the Village of Palos Park now being primarily serviced by individual septic systems of private residences. The Project service area includes the far western portion of the Village located east and west of Wolf Road between McCarthy Road (123rd Street) and just south of Partridge Lane (129th Street).
