ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS AND LEASES

THIS ASSIGNMENT is made this 29th day of January, 1998 by and between Capitol Bank and Trust not personally, but solely as trustee under Trust Agreement dated April 5, 1979 and known as Trust No. 1752 (the "Assignor"), and First American Bank, an Illinois banking corporation (the "Assignee").

 - 1. Assignor warrants, covenants, and agrees with Assignee as follows:

- (a) Assignor is the sole owner of the entire lessor's interest in the Leages, Assignor has not and shall not execute any other assignment of any of the Leages or the rents, income and profits accruing from the Premises, and Assignor has not and shall not perform any acts or execute any other instruments which might prevent Assignee from fully exercising its rights under any of the terms, covenants and conditions of this Assignment.
- (b) The Leases are valid and enforceable in accordance with their terms and have not been altered, modified, amended, terminated, renewed nor have any of the terms and conditions thereof been waived in any manner whatsoever except as approved in writing by Assignee, and shall not be altered, modified, amended, terminated, renewed nor shall any term or condition thereof be waived without the prior written approval of Assignee.
- (c) There are no default; now existing under any of the Leases and there exists no state of facts which, with the giving of notice or lapse of time or both, would constitute a default under any of the Leases. Assignor will fulfill or perform each and every condition and covenant of each of the Leases by lessor to be fulfilled or performed, give prompt notice to Assignee of any notice of default by Assignor under any of the Leases received by Assignor together with a complete copy of any such notice. Assignor shall, at the sole cost and expense of Assignor, enforce, short of termination of any Lease, the performance or observance of each and every towerant and condition of all such Leases by the lessee(s) to be performed or observed.
- (d) Assignor has not and shall not collect, or accept payment of, rent under any of the Leases more than one month in advance.
- (e) Assignor shall not, without the prior written conscol of Assignee, enter into any other leases of all or any part of the Premises.
- (f) Assignor shall and does hereby assign and transfer to the Assignee any and all subsequent leases upon all or any part of the Premises and shall execute and deliver at the request of Assignee all such further assurances and assignments as Assignee shall from time to time require or deem necessary.
- 2. This Assignment is absolute and is effective immediately. Notwithstanding the foregoing, until notified by the Assignee in writing that a default has occurred under the terms and conditions of the Note or Mortgage or any other instrument constituting security for the Note, Assignor may receive, collect and enjoy the rents, income and profits accruing from the Premises.
- 3. In the event of any default in the Note or Mortgage or any other instrument constituting security for the Note, Assignee may, at its option.

receive and collect all such rents, income and profits as they become due, from such Premises and under any and all beases of all or any part of the Premises. Assigned shall thereafter continue to receive and collect all such rents, income and profits, as long as such default or defaults shall exist, and during the pendency of any foreclosure proceedings, and if there is a deficiency, during any redemption period.

- Assignor hereby appoints Assignee its true and lawful attorney with full power of substitution and with power for Assignee in its own name, and capacity or in the name and capacity of Assignor to demand, collect, receive and give complete acquittances for any and all rents, income and profits accruing from the Fremises. and at Assignee's discretion to file any claims or take any other actron or proceeding and make any settlement of any claims, either in its own name or in the name of Assignor or otherwise, which Assignee may deem necessary or desirable in order to collect and enforce the payment of the rents, income and profits. Lessees of the Premises are hereby expressly authorized and directed to pay any and all amounts due Assignor pursuant to the Lesses to Assignee or such nomines as Assignee may designate in writing delivered to and received by such lessee, who are expressly relieved of any and all duty, liability or obligation to Assignor in respect to all payments so made.
- Assignee is hereby vested with full power to use all measures, legal and equitable, deemed by it necessary or proper to enforce this Assignment and to collect the rents, income and profits assigned hereunder, including the right of Assignee or its designee to inter upon the Premises, or any part thereof, with or without force and with or without process of law, and take possession of all or any part of the Fremises together with all personal property, fixtures, documents, books, records, papers and accounts of Assignor relating thereto, and may exclude the Assignor, its agents or servants, wholly Assignor hereby grants full power and authority to Assignee to exercise all rights, privileges and powers herein graved at any and all times hereafter, without notice to Assignor with full power to ass and apply all of the rents and other income herein assigned to the payment or the costs of managing and operating the Premises and of any indebtedness or liablity of Assignor to Assignee, including but not limited to the payment of taxes, special assessments, insurance premiums, damage claims, the costs of maintaining repairing, rebuilding and restoring the improvements on the Premises or of making same rentable, attorneys' fees incurred in connection with the enforcement of this Assignment, and of principal and interest payments due from Assignor to Assignee on the Note, all in such order as Assignee may determine. Assignee shall be under no obligation to exercise or prosecute any of the rights or claims assigned to it hereunder or to perform or carry out any of the obligations of the lessor under any of the Leases and does not assume any of the liabilities in connection with or arising or growing out of the covenants and agreements of Assignor in the Leases.
