#### AMENDED FINAL JUDGMENT ORDER

This matter coming on to be heard on the Complaint For Condemnation of Plaintiff (E)ARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, STATE OF ILLINOIS, For and On Behalf of the People of the State of Illinois, for the ascertainment of the just compensation for the taking by Plaintiff of property sought to be taken for public purposes, as set forth in the Complaint For Condemnation, the First Amendment to Complaint for Condemnation, and on Plaintiff's Motion For Entry Of Final Judgment Order By Stipulation;

And Plaintiff DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, STATE OF ILLINOIS, appearing by James E. Ryan, Attorney General of the State of Illinois, and Mark A. Spadoro, Special Assistant Attorney General;

And Defendants THE UNO-VEN COMPANY, an Illinois general partnership, and PDV MIDWEST REFINING, L.L.C., a Delaware limited liability company, by attorney Arthur N. Christie of Burke and Ryan;

And it appearing to the Court that all Defendants to this proceeding have been served by process as provided by statute, have entered their appearances, and that the Court has jurisdiction of the subject matter of this proceeding and of all parties thereto;

And it further appearing to the Court that due notice of this hearing has been given, and that the demand for trial by jury has been waited by the Plaintiff and all Defendants hereto, and the Court having considered the Stipulation Of Settlement And For Entry Of Final Judgment Order, the Complaint For Condemnation, the First Amendment to Complaint for Condemnation, the record, and being fully advised in the premises, finds and adjudges the just compensation for the property taken and damaged as follows:

To the owner or owners of and party or parties interested in Parcel OC2 0012 and Parcel OC2 0012TE, legally described in Exhibit "A" and Exhibit "B" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, as full and final just compensation for the fee simple title to said Parcel OC2 0012 and as foll and final just compensation for the temporary easement to said Parcel OC2 0012TE, for the taking and uses and purposes set forth in the Complaint For Condemnation, the First Amendment to Complaint For Condemnation, and for damages to the remainder, the total sum of \$59,900.00;

And it further appearing to the Court that by Order entered on June 24, 1998 upon hearing of Plaintiff's First Amended Motion For Immediate Vesting Of Title in Plaintiff to said Parcel OC2 0012 and Parcel OC2 0012TE, the amount of preliminary just compensation for the taking of fee simple title to said Parcel OC2 0012 and for the

taking of a temporary easement in Parcel OC2 0012TE was determined by this Court to be \$59,400.00; that on November 3, 1997, Plaintiff had deposited with the Cook County Treasurer the money preliminarily found by the Court to be just compensation under Plaintiff's first Motion For Immediate Vesting Of Title; that by Order Vesting Title entered on December 19, 1997, and a supplemental Order Vesting Title entered on July 15, 1998, Plaintiff vas vested with the fee simple title to said Parcel OC2 0012 and with a temporary easement not to exceed three years to said Parcel OC2 0012TE, and authorized to take immediate possession of said Parcel OC2 0012 and Parcel OC2 0012TE;

And it further appearing to the Court that by Stipulation of Settlement and for Entry of Final Judgment Order the parties have agreed that for the subject property and its existing improvements, of which Parcel OC2 0012 and Parcel OC2 0012TE are a part, the defendants' driveways shall match the existing driveways on Elmhurst Road and that the defendants shall have two driveways on Golf Road, as shown on Plaintiff's Plans for Proposed Federal Aid Highway, F.A.P. 344 and F.A.U. 2678, Section (N-7-A & 3025)RS-1 & N-7-5-BR, sheets 31 and 34, marked Exhibit "C" and attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

And it further appearing to the Court that the parties agree that the aforesaid driveway locations for the subject property and its existing improvements, of which Parcel OC2 0012 and Parcel OC2 0012TE are a part, on Elmhurst Road and Golf Road are subject to the rules, regulations, and specifications adopted by the

Department of Transportation, State of Illinois for exit and entrance driveways and its issuance of permit(s) therefor, and the Illinois Highway Code, 605 ILCS 5/4-210. Nothing contained in this stipulation shall constitute a waiver by Defendants THE UNO-VEN COMPANY, an Illinois general partnership, and PDV MIDWEST REFINING, L.L.C., a Delaware limited liability company of any future claim of damage in the event that Plaintiff's Plans for Proposed Federal Aid Highway, F.A.P. 344 and F.A.U. 2678, Section (N-7-A & 3025)RS-1 & N-7-5-BR, snee 31 and 34, marked Exhibit "C" are not followed, or a waiver by Plaintiff of any defense to any such claim by the aforesaid Defendants, wherefore:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the sum of FIFTY-NINE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$59,900.00) DOLLARS is the full and final just compensation to the owner or owners of and party or parties interested in said Parcel OC2 0012 and Parcel OC2 0012TE, and the remainder of the tract of land of which said Parcel OC2 0012 and Parcel OC2 0012TE are a part, for the fee simple title to said Parcel OC2 0012 and for the temporary easement to said Parcel OC2 0012TE, as legally described in Exhibit "A" and Exhibit "B" attached hereto, for the taking and damaging of said real property, and for damages to the remainder property, and judgment is hereby entered accordingly.

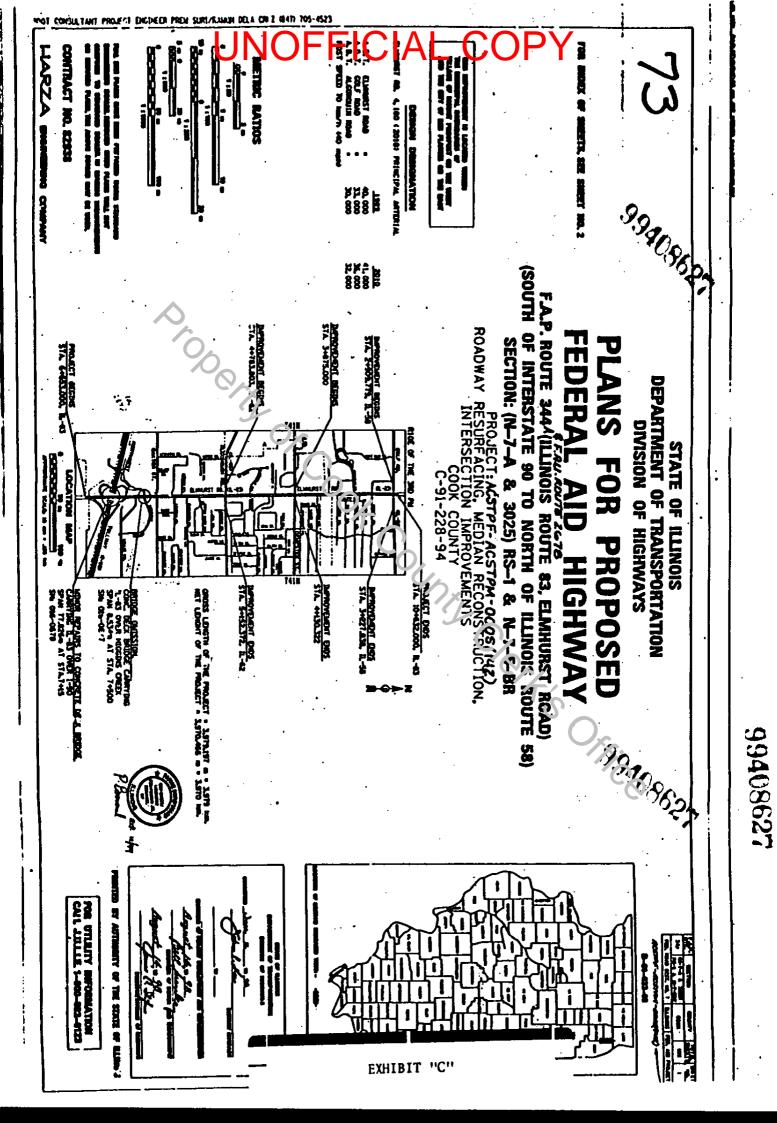
