#### AGREED ORDER

THIS CAUSE coming on to be heard upon status of mediation and for hearing on all remaining issues, the parties having reached agreement and the Court being fully advised in the premises:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

- 1. That the physical possession and physical custody of the minor child, ANDREW, is hereby transferred from THOMAS B. STEMPLE TO NANCY LEE BERNDT retroactive to July 6, 1995.
- 2. That NANCY LEE BERNDT and THOMAS J. STEMPLE shall communicate changes in visitation between the aselves and not through their spouses or children.
- J. That NANCY LEE BERNDT and THOMAS B. STEMPLE shall not place their children in the "middle" of any disagramment, discussion, or argument.
- 4. That NANCY LEE BERNDT and THOMAS B. STEMPLE shall not use their children as "messengers."
- 5. That NANCY LEE BERNDT and THOMAS B. STEMPLE shall not discuss adult issues with their children.
- 6. That ANDREW will have visitation with THOMAS B. STEMPLE every other weekend with a degree of flexibility as to two days or one day.
- 7. That the minor child, BARBARA, will visit with NANCY LEE BERNDT as often as the child's schedule allows, and THOMAS B. STEMPLE will encourage BARBARA to give sufficient notification to NANCY LEE BERNDT.

- 8. That the parties shall continue to share joint legal quetody of AMPSEN pursuant to the Judgment for Dissolution of Marriage entered on August 10, 1982.
- That THOMAS & STEMPLE shall pay to MARCY LEE BREEDT as and for child support for AMDREW the sum of \$45.00 per week commencing deptember 1, 1995. No periodic payments of support have been and thus there is a support amount due as or January 11, 1995 of \$983.57 which shall be paid in full to MARCY LEE BERNOT immediately upon entry of this agreed order. Support shall recommence in the amount of \$45.00 on February 1, 1996. NANCY LEE BERNOT shall pay no child support to TROMAS B. STEMPLE for PARSARA. Payments shall be by Order of Withholding.
- 10. That THOMAS B. STEMPLE shall continue to claim SARBABA every year for state and federal income tax dependency exception purposes and shall claim ANDREW for tax year 1995. MANCY LEE BERNOT shall blaim ANDREW for tax year 1996 and all subsequent years.
- 11. That each party shall pay his or her attorneys fees and costs in this matter.
- 13. That except as modified hereby, the terms and conditions of the Order of August 17, 1994 shall remain in full force and safect.
- 13. That each party has been tendered by his or her attorney, statements as to attorney's fees which may be due. Each party agrees with his or her attorney that the fees are reasonable and necessary for the work done. Judgment is entered in favor of Lais Kulinsky against Name, Lee Berndt in the amount of \$2.840.79. Judgment is entered in favor of Bush & Makes against Thomas B. Stemple in the amount of \$1.40.00.
