

RELEASE OF CLAIM FOR LIEN



The North 85 feet as measured along the West line thereof of that part of Lot 8 lying North of Archer Avenue in Circuit Court Partition in the South East 1/4 of Section 27, Township 38 North, Range 12 East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois, described as follows:
