TOGETHER with all improvements, tenements, casements, fixtures, and appurtenances thereto belonging, and all rents, issues and profits thereof for so long and outing all such times as First Party, its successors or assigns may be entitled thereto (which are pledged primarily and on a parity with said real estate and not secondarily), and all apparatus, equipment or articles now or hereafter thereir, or thereon used to supply heat, gas, air conditioning, water, light, power, refrigeration (whether single units or centrally controlled), and ventilation, including (without restricting the foregoing), screens, window shades, storm doors and windows, floor coverings, inador beds, awnings, stoves and water heaters. All of the foregoing are declared to be a part or said real estate whether physically attached thereto or not, and it is agreed that all similar apparatus, equipment or articles hereafter placed in the premises by First Party or its successors or assigns shall be considered as constituting part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the premises unto the said Trustee, its successors and assigns, forever, for the purposes, and upon the uses and trusts herein set forth.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT:

1. Until the indebtedness aforesaid shall be fully paid, and in case of the failure of Tirst Party, its successors or assigns to; (1) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvement now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (2) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's or other liens or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (3) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to Trustee or to holders of the notes; (4) complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (5) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (6) refrain from making material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance; (7) pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges. sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and upon written request, to furnish to Trustee or to holders of the note duplicate receipts therefor; (8) pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which First Party may desire to contest; (9) keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning or windstorm under policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of moneys sufficient either to pay the cost of replacing or repairing the same or to pay in full the indebtedness secured hereby, all in companies satisfactory to the holders of the note. under insurance policies payable, in case of loss or damage, to Trustee for the benefit of the holders of the note. such rights to be evidenced by the standard mortgage clause to be attached to each policy; and to deliver all policies. including additional and renewal policies, to holders of the note, and in the case of insurance about to expire, to deliver renewal policies not less than ten days prior to the respective dates of expiration; then Trustee or the holders of the note may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act herein before set forth in any manner deemed

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expedient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments or principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or forfeiture affecting said premises or contest any tax or assessment. All moneys paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorneys' fees, and any other moneys advanced by Trustee or the holders of the note to protect the mortgaged premises and the lien hereof, plus reasonable compensation to Trustee for each matter concerning which action herein authorized may be taken, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at the rate of seven percent per annum. Inaction of Trustee or holders of the note shall never be considered as a waiver of any right accruing to them on account of any of the provisions of this paragraph.

- 2. The Trustee or the holders of the note hereby secured making any payment hereby authorized relating to taxes or assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or title or claim thereof.
- 3. At the option of the holders of the note and without notice to First Party, its successors or assigns, all unpaid indebtedness secured by this trust deed shall, notwithstanding anything in the note or in this trust deed to the contrary, become due and payar!e (a) immediately in the case of default in making payment of any installment of principal or interest on the note, or (b) in the event of the failure of First Party or its successors or assigns to do any of the things specifically set forth in paragraph one hereof and such default shall continue for three days, said option to be exercised at any time after the expiration of said three day period. **See Attachment hereto
- 4. When the indebtedness hereby secured shall become due whether by acceleration or otherwise, holders of the note or Trustee shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof. In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional inaretedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Trustee or holders of the note for attorneys' fees, Trustee's fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographers' charges, publication costs and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches and examinations, guarantee policies, Torrens certificates, and similar data and assurances with respect to title as Trustee or holders of the note may deem to be reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such georee the true condition of the title to or the value of the premises. All expenditures and expenses of the nature in this paragraph mentioned shall become so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and immediately due and payable, with interest thereon at the rate of experient per annum, when paid or incurred by Trustee or holders of the hole in connection with (a) any proceeding, including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, to which either of them shall be a party, either as plaintiff, claimant or defendant, by reason of this trust deed or any indebtedness hereby secured; or (b) preparations for the commencement of any suit for the foreclosure hereof after accrual of such right to foreclose whather or not actually commenced; or (c) preparations for the defense of any threatened suit or proceeding which might affect the premises or the security hereof, whether or not actually commenced.
- 5. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraph hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the note, with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the note; fourth, any overplus to First Party, its legal expresentatives or assigns, as their rights-may appear:
- 6. Upon, or at any time after the filing of a bill to foreclose this trust deed, the court in which such bit is filled may appoint a receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency at the time of application for such receiver, of the person or persons, if any, liable for the payment of the indebtedness secured hereby, and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not and the Trustee hereunder may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have power to collect the rents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a sale and a deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further times when First Party, its successors or assigns, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the premises during the whole of said period. The court from time to time may authorize the receiver to apply the net income in his hands in payment in whole or in part of; (1) The indebtedness secured hereby, or by any decree foreclosing this trust deed, or any tax, special assessment or other lien which may be or become superior to the lien hereof or of such decree, provided such application is made prior to foreclosure sale; (2) the deficiency in case of a sale and deficiency.
- 7. Trustee or the holders of the note shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.

8. Trustee has no duty lo ha the little, location existence or condition of the premises, nor shall Trustee be obligated to record this trust deed or to exercise any power herein given unless expressly obligated by the terms hereof, nor be liable for any acts or omissions hereunder, except in case of its own gross negligence or misconduct or that of the agents or employees of Trustee, and it may require indemnities satisfactory to it before exercising any power herein given.

9. Trustee shall release this trust deed and the lien thereof by proper instrument upon presentation of satisfactory evidence that all indebtedness secured by this trust deed has been fully paid; and Trustee may execute and deliver a release hereof to and at the request of any person who shall, either before or after maturity thereof, produce and exhibit to Trustee the note representing that all indebtedness hereby secured has been paid, which representation Trustee may accept as true without inquiry. Where a release is requested of a successor trustee, such successor trustee may accept as the genuine note herein described any note which bears a certificate of identification purporting to be executed by a prior trustee hereunder or which conforms in substance with the description herein contained of the note and which purports to be executed on behalf of First Party; and where the release is requested of the original trustee and it has never executed a certificate on any instrument identifying same as the note described herein, it may accept as the genuine note herein described any note which may be presented and which conforms in substance with the description herein contained of the note and which purports to be executed on behalf of First Party.

10. Trustee may resign by instrument in writing filed in the office of the Recorder or Registrar of Titles in which this instrument shall have been recorded or filed. In case of the resignation, inability or refusal to act of Trustee, the then Recorder of Deeds of the county in which the premises are situated shall be Successor in Trust. Any Successor in Trust hereunder shall have the identical title, powers and authority as are herein given Trustee, and any Trustee or successor shall be entitled to reasonable compensation for all acts performed hereunder. *

THIS TRUST DEED is executed by the Marquette National Bank , not personally but as Trustee as aforesaid in the exercise of the power and authority conferred upon and vested in it as such Trustee and it is expressly understood and agrees that nothing herein or in said note contained shall be construed as creating any liability on the said First Party or on said Marquette National Bank personally to pay the said note or any interest that may accrue thereon, or any indebtedness accruing hereunder, or to perform any covenant either express or implied hereir contained, all such liability, if any, being expressly waived by Trustee and by every person now or hereafter claiming any right or security hereunder, and that so far as the First Party and its successors and said Matquette National Rank personally are concerned, the legal holder of holders of said note and the owner or owners of any indebtedness accruing hereunder shall look solely to the premises hereby conveyed for the payment thereof, by the enforcement of the lien hereby created, in the manner herein and in said note provided or by action to enforce the personal liability of the guarantor, if any.

- 11. The principal of each of said instalments and of the final payment unless paid when due shall bear interest after maturity at the same rate as the post-maturity rate stated in the Note. Interest at the post-maturity rate as specified in the Note is to be charged monthly on all past due interest that is earned and unpaid and said past due interest and additional interest are to be added on the last day of each month to the unpaid principal balance of the Note that this Trust Deed secures. The undersigned shall pay to the holder or holders of the Note a late charge in an amount equal to TWO percent (2%) multiplied by the entire amount of any instalment (including principal and interest) not received by the holder or holders of the Note within TEN (10) days after the due date of that Instalment.
- 12. Taxes, assessments, insurance premiums, and other annual charges upon the real estate are to be paid monthly to the holder of the Note this Trust Deed secures as provided in said Note.
- 13. First Party covenants and agrees that this Trust Deed and the Note secured thereby are to be construed and governed by the laws of the State of Illinois, and that the entire proceeds of the Note shall be used for business purposes as defined in chapter 815 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes.
- 14. First Party hereby waives any and all rights of redemption from sale under any order or decree of foreclosure of this Trust Deed, on its own behalf and on behalf of each and every person, except decree or judgment creditors of First Party, acquiring any interest in or title to the premises subsequent to the date of this Trust Deed.
- 15. No action for the enforcement of the lien or any provision hereof shall be subject to any defense which would not be good and available to the party interposing same in an action at law upon the Note hereby secured.

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- 16. The rights and obligations of the Trustee or Mortgagee under this Trust Deed or Mortgage shall not be altered by the modification at any time of the Trust Deed or Mortgage and the Note secured thereby as to the rate of interest, or the amount of the monthly payment or the extension of the maturity date of said Trust Deed or Mortgage and Note.
- 17. Additional rayments of principal may be made in advance of maturity upon payment of a premium (which is to compensate the holder of the Note for the reduced yield it may suffer in reinvesting the proceeds in risk-free securities) equal to three months interest on the principal amount being prepaid. Such additional principal payments shall be applied to the final instalment of the Note until fully paid and thereafter on the instalments in the inverse order of their maturity.
