- 13. Notices. Any notice to 3c rower provided for in this Security Instrument shall be given by delivering it or by mailing it by first class mail unless applicable law requires use of another method. The notice shall be directed to the Property Address or any other address borrower designates by notice to Lender. Any notice to Lender shall be given by first class mail to Lender's address stated herein or any address Lender designates by notice to Borrower. Any notice provided for in this Security Instrument shall be deemed to have been given to Borrower or Lender when given as provided in this paragraph.
- 14. Governing Law; Severability. This Security instrument shall be governed by Federal law and the law of the jurisdiction in which the Property is located. In the event that any provision or clause of this Security Instrument or the Note conflicts with applicable law, such conflict shall not affect other provisions of this Security Instrument or the Note which can be given effect without the conflicting provision. To this end the provisions of this Security Instrument and the Note are declared to be severable.
  - 15. Borrower's Copy. Borrower shall be given one conformed cripy of the Note and of this Security Instrument.
- **16. Hazardous Substances.** Borrower shall not cause or permit the presence, use, disposal, storage, or release of any Hazardous Substances on or in the Property. Borrower shall not do, nor allow anyone else to do, anything affecting the Property that is in violation of any Environmental Law. The preceding two sentences shall not apply to the presence, use, or storage on the Property of small quantities of Hazardous Substances that are generally recognized to be appropriate to normal residential uses and to maintenance on the Property.

Borrower shall promptly give Lender written notice of any investigation, claim, deman 1, la vsuit or other action by any governmental or regulatory agency or private party involving the Property and any incerdous Substance or Environment Law of which Borrower has actual knowledge. If Borrower learns, or is notified by any governmental or regulatory authority, that any removal or other remediation of any Hazardous Substances affecting Property is necessary, Borrower shall promptly take all necessary remendial actions in accordance with Environmental Law.

As used in this paragraph 16, "Hazardous Substances" are those substances defined as toxic or hazardous substances by Environmental Law and the following substances: gasoline, kerosene, other flammable or toxic petroleum products, toxic pesticides and herbicides, volatile solvents, materials containing asbestos or formaldehyde, and radioactive materials. As used in the Paragraph 16, "Environmental Law" means federal laws and laws of the jurisdiction where the Property is located that relate to health, safety or environmental protection.

NON-UNIFORM COVENANTS. Borrower and Lender further covenant and agree as follows:

17. Assignment of Rents. Borrower unconditionally assigns and transfers to Lender all the rents and revenues of the Property. Borrower authorizes Lender or Lender's agents to collect the rents and revenues and hereby directs each tenant of the Property to pay the rents to Lender or Lender's agents. However, prior to Lender's notice to Borrower of Borrower's breach of any covenant or agreement in the Security Instrument, Borrower shall collect and receive all rents and revenues of the Property as trustee for the benefit of Lender and Borrower. This assignment of rents constitutes an absolute assignment and not an assignment for additional security only.

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If Lender gives notice of breach to Borrower: (a) all rents received by Borrower shall be held by Borrower satisfied to collect and receive all of the rents of the Property; and (c) each tenant of the Property shall pay all rents due and unpaid to Lender's agent on Lender's written demand to the tenant.

Borrower has not executed any prior assignment of the rents and has not and will not perform any act that would prevent Lender from exercising its rights under this paragraph 17.

Lender shall not be required to enter upon, take control of or maintain the Property before or after giving notice of breach to Borrower. However, Lender or a judicially appointed receiver may do so at any time there is a breach. Any application of rents shall not cure or waive any default or invalidate any other right or remedy of Lender. This assignment of rents of the Property shall terminate when the debt secured by the Security Instrument is paid in full.

18. Foreclosure Procedure. If Lender requires immediate payment in full under Paragraph 9, Lender may invoke the power of sale and any other remedies permitted by applicable law. Lender shall be entitled to collect all expenses incurred in pursuing the remedies provided in this Paragraph 18, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorney's fee and costs of title evidence.

If Lender invokes the power of sale, Lender shall give notice of sale to Borrower in the manner provided in Paragraph 13. Lender chall publish and post the notice of sale, and the Property shall be sold in the proceeds of the sale property at any sale. The proceeds of the sale shall be applicable faw. Lender or its designee may purchase the Property at any sale. The proceeds of the sale including, but not limited to, reasonable sale shall be applied in the following order: (a) to all expenses of the sale, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorney's fee; (b) to all sum: secured by this Security Instrument; and (c) any excess to the person or persons legally entitled to it.

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#### **ADJUSTABLE RATE RIDER**

THIS ADJUSTABLE RATE AFRER is made this 6TH day of AUGUST , 1999 , and is incorporated into and shall be deerned to amend and supplement the Mortgage, of even date herewith, given by the undersigned (Mortgagor) to secure Mortgagor's Adjustable Rate Note ("Note"), of even date herewith, to MIDAMERICA FEDERAL SAVINGS EARL ("Mortgagee"), covering the premises described in the Mortgage located

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary set forth in the Mortgage, Mortgagor and Mortgagee hereby agree to the following:

- 1. Under the Note, the initial stated interest rate of SIX AND ONE HALF per centum (6.500 %) per annum ("Initial Interest Rate") on the unpair, principal balance is subject to change, as hereinafter described. When the interest rate changes, the equal monthly installments of principal and interest also will be adjusted, as hereinafter provided, so that each installment will be in an amount necessary to fully amortize the unpaid principal balance of the Note, at the new adjusted interest rate, over the remaining term of the Note.
- 2. The first adjustment to the interest rate (if any adjustment is required) will be effective on the first day of SEPTEMBER, 2000, (which date will not be less than tivelve months nor more than eighteen months from the due date of the first installment payment under the Noce, and thereafter each adjustment to the interest rate will be made effective on that day of each succeeding year during the term of the Mortgage ("Change Date").
- 3. As of each Change Date, it will be determined whether or not an interest rate adjustment must be made, and the amount of the new adjusted interest rate, if any, as follows:
  - (a) The amount of the Index will be determined, using the most recently available figure, thirty (30) days before the Change Date ("Current Index").
  - (b) TWO AND ONE HALF percentage points ( 2.500 %; the "Margin") will be added to the Current Index and the sum of this addition will be rounded to the nearest one-eighth of one percentage point (0.125%). The rounded sum, of the Margin plus the Current Index, will be called the "Calculated Interest Rate" for each Change Date.

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- (c) The Calculated Interest Rate will be compared to the interest rate being earned immediately prior to the current Change Date (such interest rate being called the "Existing Interest Rate"). Then, the new adjusted interest rate, if any, will be determined as follows:
  - (i) If the Calculated Interest Rate is the same as the Existing Interest Rate, the Interest Rate will not change.
  - (ii) If the difference between the Calculated Interest Rate and the Existing Interest Rate is less than or equal to one percentage point, the new adjusted interest rate will be equal to the Calculated Interest Rate (subject to the maximum allowable change over the term of the Mortgage of five percentage points, in either direction, from the Initial Interest Rate, herein called "5% Cap").
  - (iii) If the Calculated Interest Rate exceeds the Existing Interest Rate by more than one percentage point, the new adjused interest rate will be equal to one percentage point higher than the Existing Interest Rate (subject to the 5% Cap).
  - (iv) If the Calculated Interest Rate is less than the Existing Interest Rate by more than one percentage point, the new adjusted interest rate will be equal to one percentage point less than the Existing Interest Rate (subject to the 5% Cap).
- (d) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Adjustable Rate Rider, in no event will any new adjusted interest rate be more than five percentage (5%) points nigher or lower than the Initial Interest Rate. If any increase or decrease in the Existing Interest Rate would cause he new adjusted interest rate to exceed the 5% Cap, the new adjusted interest rate will be limited to five percentage (5%) points higher or lower, whichever is applicable, than the Initial Interest Rate.
- (e) Mortgagee will perform the functions required under Subparagraphs 3(a), (b) and (c) to determine the amount of the new adjusted rate, if any. Any such new adjusted interest rate will become effective on the Change Date and thereafter will be deemed to be the Existing Interest Hate. The new Existing Interest Rate will remain in effect until the next Change Date on which the interest rate is adjusted.
- (f) If the index is no longer available, Mortgagee will be required to use any index prescribed by the Department of Housing and Urban Development. Mortgagee will notify Mortgagor in writing of any such substitute index (giving all necessary information for Mortgagor to obtain such index) and after the date of such notice the substitute index will be deemed to be the Index hereunder.
- 4. (a) If the Existing Interest Rate changes on any Change Date, Mortgagee will recalculate the monthly installment payments of principal and interest to determine the amount which would be necessary to repay in full, on the maturity date, the unpaid principal balance (which unpaid principal balance will be deemed to be the amount due on such Change Date assuming there has been no default in any payment on the Note but that all prepayments on the Note have been taken into account), at the new Existing Interest Rate, in equal monthly payments. At least 25 days before the date on which a monthly payment at the new level is due, Mortgagee will give Mortgagor written notice ("Adjustment Notice") of any change in the Existing Interest Rate and of the revised amount of the monthly installment payments of principal and interest, calculated as provided above. Each Adjustment Notice will set forth (i) the date the Adjustment Notice is given, (ii) the Change Date, (iii) the current interest rate, (iv) the new Existing Interest Rate as adjusted on the Change Date, (v) the amount of the adjusted monthly installment payments, calculated as provided above, (vi) the Current Index and the date it was published, (vii) the method of calculating the adjustment to the monthly installment payments, and (viii) any other information which may be required by law from time to time.

- (b) Mortgagor agrees to pay the adjusted monthly installment amount beginning on the first payment date which occurs at least twenty-five (25) days after Mortgagee has given the Adjustment Notice to Mortgagor. Mortgagor will continue to pay the adjusted monthly installment amount set forth in the last Adjustment Notice given by Mortgagee to Mortgagor until the first payment date which occurs at least twenty-five (25) days after Mortgagee has given a further Adjustment Notice to Mortgagor. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in this Adjustable Rate Rider or the Mortgage, Mortgagor will be relieved of any obligation to pay, and Mortgagee will have forfeited its right to collect, any increase in the monthly installment amount (caused by the recalculation of such amount under Subparagraph 4 (a)) for any payment date occurring less than twenty-five (25) days after Mortgagee has given the applicable Adjustment Notice to Mortgagor.
- (c) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Adjustable Rate Rider, in the event that (i) the Existing Interest Rate was reduced on a Change Date, and (ii) Mortgagee failed to give the Adjustment Notice when required, and (iii) Mortgagor, consequently, has made any monthly installment payments in excess of the amount which would have been set forth in such adjustment Notice ("Excess Payments"), then Mortgagor, at Mortgagor's sole option, may either (1) demand the return from Mortgagee (who for the purposes of this sentence will be deemed to be the mortgagee, or mortgagees, who received such Excess Payments, whether or not any such mortgagee subsequently assigned the Mortgage) of all or any portion of such Excess Payments, with interest thereon at a rate equal to the sum of the Margin and the Index on the Change Date when the Existing Interest Rate was so reduced, from the date each such Excess Payment was made by Mortgagor to repayment, or (2) request that all or any portion of such Excess Payments, together will all interest thereon calculated as provided above, be applied as payments against principal.
- 5. Nothing contained in this Adjustable Rate Rider will permit Mortgagee to accomplish an interest rate adjustment through an increase (or decrease) to the unpaid principal balance. Changes to the Existing Interest Rate may only be reflected through adjustment to Mortgagor's monthly installment payments of principal and interest, as provided for herein.
