You are hereby notified that on 12/15/98, Pursuant to Illinois Compiled Statutes, 65 ILCS 5/11-31-1(e) and Chapter 13-9 of the Chicago Municipal Code, Mary B. Richardson-Lowry, Building Commissioner, City of Chicago, has determined that the property located at:

and referred to by property index number 16-24-303-013

is VACANT AND OPEN AND IS AN IMMEDIATE AND CONTINUING HAZARD TO THE SURROUNDING COMMUNITY

If the building is not repaired, demolished or all accessible windows and doors are not securely boarded and kept boarded, and all garbage and debris removed from in and around the building within 30 days from the date of this notice, the City of Chicago will take action to eliminate the hazard.

You have the right to object to the City taking this action by filing legal action in a court of competent jurisdiction. If you do not pursue your right to object or do not board, repair or demolish the building, the City will proceed to board or demolish the building within 120 days from the date of this notice. A lien covering the cost of the City's actions will be recorded against the property and the city will seek recovery of its costs by foreclosing the lien.
