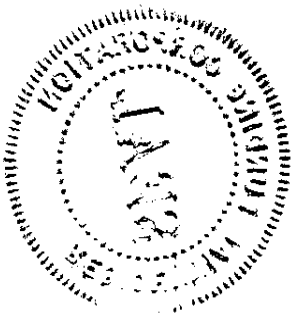

A part of the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 34, Township 41 North, Range 9, East of the Third Principal Meridian: Commencing at the southeast corner of Ettje Bauerman's land, thence running South 57.50 feet to a post, thence West parallel with the south line of Ettje Bauerman's land, 150.00 feet to a stake, thence North 57.50 feet to a stake and being the Southwest corner of said Ettje Bauerman's land, thence East along the South line of Ettje Bauerman's land, 150.00 feet to the place of beginning, (the foregoing described piece of land is a part of a six acre tract heretofore sold to Fred Waterman on July 5, 1901 by Fred Schueneman and Caroline Schueneman, described as follows, to wit: Commencing at the Northwest corner of the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of said Section 34, thence running Easterly along the South line of the Village Plat of Bartlett and being the North line of said Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 34, Township 41 North, Range 9, 49.85 rods, to the Hagedorn land, thence Southeasterly along the line of the Hagedorn land (as conveyed to John Bulk), 19 rods and 1 foot, thence Westerly parallel with said North line of the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 34, Township 41 North, Range 9, and 19 rods and 1 foot distance therefrom, to the West line of said Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 34, being about 50.90 rods, thence North along said West line of the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 34, to the place of beginning, containing 6 acres of land, in Cook County, Illinois.
