## RELEASE OF LIS PENDENS

with the Cook County Recorder of Deeds on October 8, 1996, as Document No. 96765581, giving notice of the pendency of a forfeiture action in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division entitled United States v. Palumbo Brothers, Inc., et al., Criminal Case No. 96 CR 0613, is hereby release and discharged.
