SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND RELEASE



THIS SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT entered into this day of January 1996, among Plaintiff, CHICAGO GLASS BLOCK & WINDOW, a division of PETER BEYER & SON, INC., a corporation licensed to do business in the State of Illinois, its officers, directors, shareholders, agents, representatives, employees, successors, assigns, individual and corporate affiliates, and attorneys ("Plaintiff"); Defendant, ERNIE LOBERG CONSTRUCTION CO., INC., an Illinois corporation, its officers, directors, shareholders, agents, representatives, employees, assigns, successors, individual and corporate affiliates and attorneys ("Ernie Loberg"); Defendant Burnham Park Animal Hospital, Ltd., an Illinois Corporation, its officers, directors, shareholders, agents, representatives, successors, individual and employees, assigns, corporate affiliates, ("Burnham Park").

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, Plaintiff filed a Complaint in the lawsuit known as Chicago Glass Block & Window v. Ernie Loberg Construction Co., Inc. and Defendant Burnham Park Animal Hospital, Ltd., filed in the Circuit Court of Cook County, Illinois, Municipal Department, First District, Case No. 95 M1 124511 (the "Litigation");

WHEREAS, Ernie Loberg filed an Answer and Cross Complaint on June 12, 1995;

WHEREAS, Burnham Park filed an Answer and Affirmative Defense on October 2, 1995;

WHEREAS, the parties to this Agreement have decided to

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compromise and settle the Litigation, in order to avoid the burden and expense of protracted litigation.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing Recitals which are incorporated into this Agreement by reference, and the mutual premises set forth herein, the parties agree as follows:

AGREEMENT:

- 1. <u>DISMISSAL OF LAWSUIT</u>. Simultaneous with the execution and delivery of this Agreement, the parties shall execute and deliver a Stipulation To Dismiss The Lawsuit and, within seven (7) days after the execution and delivery of this Agreement, present the Stipulation To Dismiss to the Court with a motion asking the Court to enter an order dismissing the lawsuit as follows:
- a. All of Plaintiff's claims against Ernie Loberg and Burnham Park are dismissed with prejudice.
- b. All of Ernie Loberg's cross-laims against Burnham Park are dismissed without prejudice, and with full rights to pursue a set-off for the amount paid by Ernie Loberg pursuant to this Agreement, in the related lawsuit known as Inland Mechanical Service Corp., an Illinois Corporation, v. Ernie Loberg Construction Co., an Illinois Corporation, River Forest State Bank & Trust Co., as Trustee Under Trust #4013, and Madison Bank Trust Co., Case Number 95 CH 4093 filed in the Circuit Court of Cook County, County Department, Chancery Division, Mechanics' Lien Section.

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- Loberg are dismissed without prejudice, and with full rights to pursue a set-off for the amount paid by Burnham Park pursuant to this Agreement, in the related lawsuit known as Inland Mechanical
 Service Corp., an Illinois Corporation, v. Ernie Loberg Construction Co., an Illinois Corporation, River Forest State Bank & Trust Co., as Trustee Under Trust #4013, and Madison Bank Trust Co., Case Number 95 CH 4093 filed in the Circuit Court of Cook County, County Department, Chancery Division, Mechanics' Lien Section.
- 2. Upon execution of this Agreement, Ernie Loberg will pay to Plaintiff the sum of \$1,500.00, in the form of a check.
- 3. Upon execution of this Agreement, Burnham Park will pay to Plaintiff the sum of \$1,500.0%, in the form of a check.
- 4. RELEASE OF ERNIE LOBERG CONSTRUCTION AND BURNHAM PARK BY
 CHICAGO GLASS BLOCK. Plaintiff hereby releases and discharges
 Ernie Loberg, its shareholders, officers, directors, agents,
 employees and individual and corporate affiliates, and Burnham
 Park, its shareholders, officers, directors, agents employees and
 individual and corporate affiliates, of and from any and all
 claims, demands, damages, actions, causes of action, debts, sums of
 money and accounts, of every kind and nature, whether foreseen or
 unforeseen, contingent or actual, known or unknown, which Plaintiff
 has or may have arising from or relating to any matter whatsoever,
 including but not limited all matters alleged or which could have
 been alleged in the Litigation, provided, however, that nothing

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contained herein shall be deemed a release of the obligations of Ernie Loberg and Burnham Park respectively as set forth in paragraphs 2 and 3 above.

- 5. REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES: The parties hereto represent and warrant that they have the authority to enter into this Agreement on behalf of the person or entity on whose behalf they sign.
- 6. This Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement among the parties, and all prior negotiations and agreements are merged herewith.
- 7. This Settlement Agreement may be executed in multiple counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original.
