5. The Parties shall submit to the Court an Agreed Judgment for entry by the Court in the form attached as Exhibit A, or in such other form acceptable to the Court, awarding judgment in favor of Plaintiff and against Defendants, W.E.T. 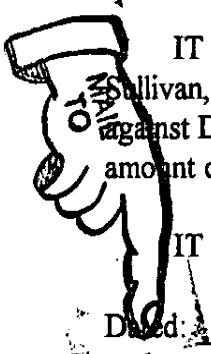
