1. That this court has jurisdiction of the parties hereto and of the subject matter hereof.



maintained a domicile in the State of Illinois for more than one year next preceding the making of the findings.

3. That the parties were married on May 6, 1950, in Chicago, Illinois, and that said marriage was registered at Cook County, Illinois.

4. That four children were born to the parties as a result of said marriage, namely, FREDERICK, JR., age 29 years, GARY, age 26 years, KAREN, age 24 years, and GAIL, age 19 years, and each child is self-supporting and emancipated. That the Petitioner is not now pregnant.

5. That the Respondent has been guilty of extreme and repeated mental cruelty according to the Illinois Revised Statutes, Chapter 40, Section 401, without cause or provocation on the part of the Petitioner.

6. That the Petitioner has established by competent, material and relevant proof, all of the allegations and charges contained in her Petition for Dissolution of Marriage, and the equities of the case are with the Petitioner.

7. That the court having considered all the statutory factors concerning the division of marital property and non-marital property of the parties, as hereinafter set forth, further finds:

A. That the Petitioner acquired the following non-marital property as her sole property:

4. Gold Coin Bracelet;
5. Wife's Diamond Rings, including her wedding & engagement rings;
6. Gold Charm with Hawaiian Gold Piece.

8. That the jewelry and silverware and gold coin bracelet, shall be the sole property of the Petitioner;
9. That the 1977 - 98 Oldsmobile shall be the sole property of the Respondent;
10. That the Petitioner's personal clothes and property shall be the sole property of the Petitioner, and the Respondent's personal clothes and property shall be the sole property of the Respondent.

8. That the Petitioner is employed as a Secretary and earns \$175.00 per week and waives her rights to maintenance, now and forever and should be barred from same.

9. That the Respondent is a self-employed real estate appraiser and earns approximately \$30,000.00 yearly, and should be barred from maintenance.


IV. That the Petitioner is now and forever barred from maintenance.

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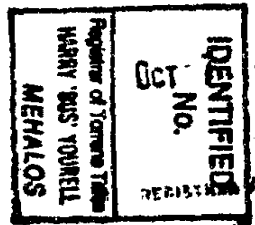
