- 6. That the Petitioner has proved by substantial and competent evidence adduced, that the purchase of the family marital residence was secured through the financial efforts of Petitioner solely without contribution by Respondent, and with the debt retirement made entirely through the efforts of Petitioner with Respondent receiving a joint interest merely as a convenience.
