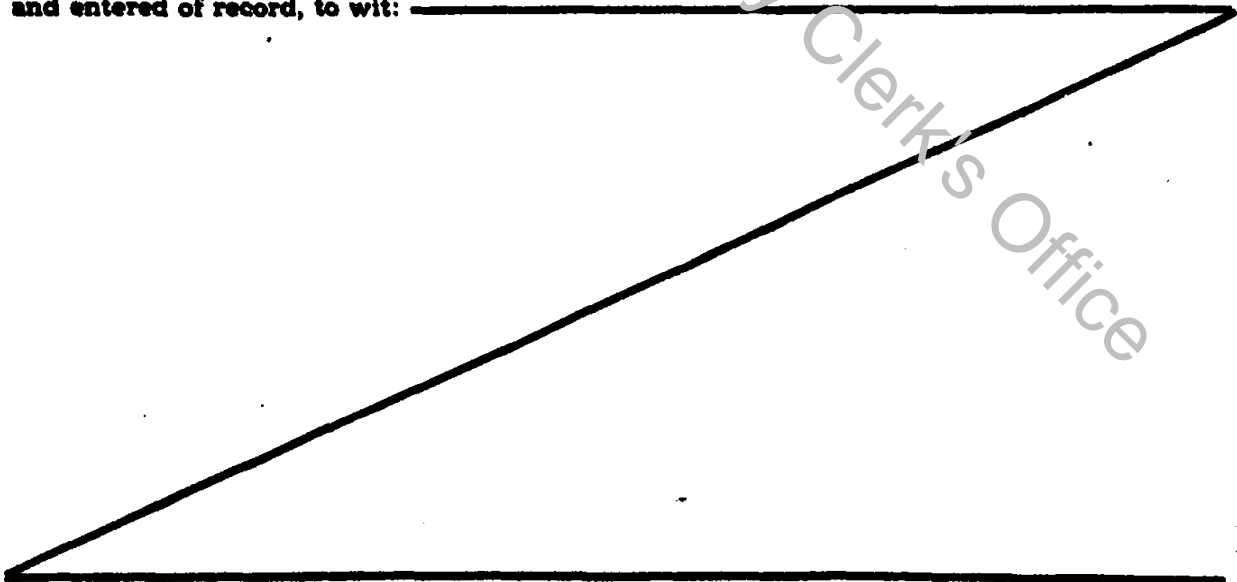

LEE NEWELL, JR., as her attorney, and the Defendant not appearing in Court, and the Court having heard the evidence testimony in open Court and the Plaintiff offering proof and support of the allegations and charges in her Petition for Dissolution of Marriage and the Court considering all the evidence now being fully advised in the premises;

FINDS:

1. That this Court has jurisdiction of the parties hereto.
2. That at the commencement of the within action, the Plaintiff was domiciled in the State of Illinois and has maintained

said domicile for at least 90 days preceding the entry of the within Judgment for Dissolution of Marriage, and next preceding the making of the findings.

3. The parties were married on February 28, 1957, and said marriage was registered in Bedford, Indiana, County of Lawrence

4. That there were three (3) children born to the parties as a result of this marriage; namely: JUDY M. HARRISON, GLENN T. HARRISON, and BARBARA R. HARRISON, who is the only minor child of the parties hereto. No children were adopted by the parties and the Plaintiff is not presently pregnant.

5. Without cause or provocation by the Plaintiff, the Defendant has been guilty of extreme and repeated mental cruelty toward the Plaintiff.

6. The Plaintiff has proven the material allegations of her Petition for Dissolution of Marriage by substantial, competent, and relevant proof, and that a Judgment for Dissolution of Marriage should be entered herein.

7. The parties have entered into a Property Settlement Agreement dated October 27th, 1981, concerning the questions of the maintenance of the Plaintiff, custody and support of the minor child, the respective rights of each party in and to the property, income or estate which either of them now owns or may hereafter acquire, including a division of all marital property and other

WHEREAS, without any collusion as to any Petition for
Dissolution of Marriage proceedings between the parties hereto, the
parties consider it in their best interests to settle between
themselves the question of maintenance and support of the Wife, and
to forever finally and fully settle and adjust the respective rights
of the parties and any and all other rights growing out of the
marital relationship, and

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and of
the mutual and several covenants herein contained and for other
good and valuable consideration by each to the other delivered, the
receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the

parties do hereby freely and voluntarily agree by and between themselves as follows:

1. That the Wife shall be awarded all funds in the joint savings account.

2. That the house located at 335 Pulaski Road, Calumet City, Illinois, shall be awarded to the Wife and husband shall execute a Quit Claim Deed upon entry of Judgment for Dissolution of Marriage.

3. That the Wife shall be awarded all the household furniture and furnishings now located in the marital home.

4. That the wife, REGENA G. HARRISON, shall be awarded the sole care, custody and education of the minor child of the parties, namely: BARBARA R. HARRISON, and that the husband shall pay to wife the sum of \$200.00 per week as and for child support for the minor child and husband shall have reasonable rights of visitation with said minor child.

5. That husband shall be responsible for the outstanding repair bill in the sum of \$275.00.

6. That husband will be permitted to use the garage at the marital premises with the permission of GLENN T. HARRISON.

7. All of the provisions set forth herein are based on Wife's promise not to initiate any criminal charges against husband for occurrences or events that have occurred prior to October 20, 1981. In the event Wife shall institute any criminal charges or in any way harrass husband for occurrences or events that have taken place prior to October 20, 1981, then upon proper petition to this Court by Respondent, wife shall be obligated to pay husband the sum of \$30,000.00, which represents 1/2 of value of all assets owned by parties.

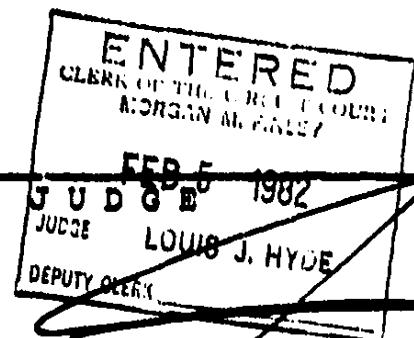

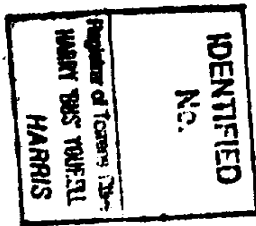
