Any deficiency in the amount of any such aggregate monthly payment shall, unless made good by the Mortgagor priod to the due date of the next such payment, constitute an event of default under this mortgage. The Mortgagee may collect a "late charge" not to exceed four cents (4c) for each doller (\$1) for each payment more than fifteen (15) days in arrears, to cover the extra expense in olded in handling delinquent payments.

This option may not be exercised by the Mortgagee when the ineligi'il'ry for insurance under the National Housing Act is due to the Mortgagee's failure to comit the mortgage insurance premium to the Department of Housing and Urban Development.
