TOGETHER with all awards and other compensation
herebefore or hereafter to be made to the present and all
subsequent owners of the Premises for any taking by eminent
domain, either permanent or temporary, of all or any part of the
Premises or any easement or appurtenance thereof, including
severance and consequential damage and change in grade of
streets, which said awards and compensation are hereby assigned
to Mortgagee, and Mortgagee hereby designates Mortgagee as its
agent and directs and empowers Mortgagee, at the option of the
Mortgagee, on behalf of Mortgagee, or the successors or assigns
of Mortgagee, to adjust or compromise the claim for any award
and to collect and receive the proceeds thereof, to give proper
receipts and acquittances therefor, and, after deducting expenses
of collection, to apply the net proceeds as a credit upon any
portion, as selected by Mortgagee, of the indebtedness hereby
Secured, notwithstanding the fact that the amount owing thereon
may now then be due and payable or that the indebtedness is
otherwise adequately secured, all subject to the provisions of
Paragraph 10 hereof.

TOGETHER with all right, title, estate and interest of
the Mortgagor in and to the Premises, property, improvements,
furniture, furnishing, apparatus and fixtures hereby conveyed,
assigned, pledged and hypothecated, or intended so to be, and
all right to retain possession of the Premises after default in
payment or breach of any covenant herein contained; and

Notwithstanding the agreement and declaration hereinabove
expressed that certain articles of property form a part of the
realty covered by this Mortgage and be appropriated to its use
and deemed to be realty, to the extent that such agreement and
declaration may not be effective and that any of said articles
may constitute goods (as said term is used in the Uniform
Commercial Code), this instrument shall constitute a security
agreement, creating a security interest in such goods as
collateral, in Mortgagee as a secured party, all in accordance
with said Illinois Uniform Commercial Code as more particularly
set forth in Paragraph 17 hereof.

PROVIDED, NEVERTHELESS, that if the Mortgagor shall pay when due the indebtedness hereby secured and all duly and timely perform and observe all of the terms, provisions, covenants and agreements herein provided to be performed and observed by the Mortgagor, then this Mortgage and the estate, right and interest of the Mortgagee in the Premises shall cease and become void and of no effect, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

THE MORTGAGOR COVENANTS AND AGREES AS FOLLOWS:

1. Payment of Indebtedness. The Mortgagor shall pay when due (a) the principal of and interest and premium, if any, on the indebtedness evidenced by the Note, and (b) all other indebtedness hereby secured; and the Mortgagor shall duly and punctually perform and observe all of the terms, provisions, conditions, covenants and agreements on the Mortgagor's part to be performed and observed as provided herein and in the Note; and this Mortgage shall secure such payment, performance and observance.

2. Maintenance, Repair, Restoration, Liens, etc. The Mortgagor shall (a) pay promptly repair, restore or rebuild any building or improvement now or hereafter included within the definition of premises which may become damaged or be destroyed whether or not proceeds of insurance are available or sufficient for the purpose; (b) keep the premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's, materialmen's or like liens or claims or other liens or claims for lien; (c) pay, when due, any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises junior to the lien hereof and, upon request, exhibit to the Mortgagee satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such lien; (d) complete within a reasonable time, any building or buildings or other improvements now or at any time in the process of erection upon the premises; (e) comply with all requirements of law, municipal ordinances or restrictions and covenants of record with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (f) make or permit no material alterations in the premises except as required by law or ordinance without the prior written consent of the Mortgagee; (g) suffer or permit no change in the general nature of the occupancy of the premises; (h) initiate or acquiesce in no zoning reclassification with respect to the premises; (i) suffer or permit no unlawful use of, or nuisance to exist upon, the premises, and (j) cause the premises to be managed in a competent and professional manner.

3. Other Liens. Except as otherwise expressly provided herein, the Mortgagor shall not create or suffer to permit any mortgage, lien, charge or encumbrance to attach to the premises, whether such lien or encumbrance is inferior or superior to the lien of this Mortgage, excepting only the lien of real estate taxes and assessments not due or delinquent.

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4. Taxes. The Mortgagor shall pay before any penalty attaches, all general and special taxes, assessments, water charges, sewer charges, and other fees, taxes, charges and assessments of every kind and nature whatsoever (all herein generally called "Taxes"), whether or not assessed against the Mortgagor, if applicable to the Premises or any interest therein, or the Indebtedness Hereby Secured, or any obligation or agreement secured hereby; and Mortgagor shall, upon written request, furnish to the Mortgagor duplicate receipts therefor. The Mortgagor shall pay in full under protest in the manner provided by statute, any Taxes which the Mortgagor may desire to contest; provided, however, that if determination of payment of any such Taxes is required to conduct any contest or review, the Mortgagor shall deposit with the Mortgagor the full amount thereof, together with an amount equal to the estimated interest and penalties thereon during the period of contest, and in any event, shall pay such Taxes, notwithstanding such contest, if in the opinion of the Mortgagor the Premises shall be in jeopardy or in danger of being forfeited or foreclosed; and if the Mortgagor shall not pay the same when required so to do, the Mortgagor may do so and may apply such deposit for the purpose. In the event that any law or court decree has the effect of deducting from the value of the land for the purpose of taxation any lien thereon, or imposing upon the Mortgagor the payment of the whole or any part of the Taxes or liens herein required to be paid by the Mortgagor, or changing in any way the laws relating to the taxation of mortgages or debts secured by mortgages or the interest of the Mortgagor in the Premises, or the manner of collection of Taxes, so as to affect this Mortgage or the Indebtedness Hereby Secured or the Mortgagor, then, and in any such event, the Mortgagor, upon demand by the Mortgagor, shall pay such Taxes, or reimburse the Mortgagor therefor on demand, unless such payment or reimbursement by Mortgagor is unlawful, in which event the Indebtedness Hereby Secured shall be due and payable within thirty (30) days after written demand by Mortgagor to Mortgagor. Nothing in this paragraph 4 contained shall require the Mortgagor to pay any income, franchise or excise tax imposed upon the Mortgagor, excepting only such which may be levied against such income expressly as and for a specific substitute for Taxes pertaining to the Premises, and then only in an amount computed as if the Mortgage derived no income from any source other than its interest hereunder.

5. Insurance Coverage. The Mortgagor at its own expense will insure and keep insured all of the buildings and improvements now or hereafter included within the Premises, and each and every part and parcel thereof against such perils and hazards as the Mortgagor may from time to time require, and in any event including:

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(a) Insurance against loss by fire, risks covered by the so-called extended coverage endorsement and other risks as the Mortgagee may reasonably require, in amounts equal to not less than one hundred (100%) percent of the full replacement value of the Premises;

(b) Public liability against bodily injury and property damage with such limits as the Mortgagee may require;

(c) Rental or business interruption insurance in amounts sufficient to pay during any period of up to one (1) year in which the Premises may be damaged or destroyed, all amounts required herein to be paid by the Mortgagee;

(d) Steam boiler, machinery and other insurance of the types and in amounts as the Mortgagee may require, but in any event not less than customarily carried by persons owning or operating like properties.

6. Insurance Policies. All policies of insurance to be maintained and provided as required by Paragraph 5 hereof shall be with companies, and in form and amounts satisfactory to the Mortgagee and all policies of casualty insurance shall have attached thereto mortgage clauses or endorsements in favor of and with loss payable to and in form satisfactory to the Mortgagee and shall provide that such insurance may not be cancelled or altered as to Mortgagee without at least 10 days prior written notice to Mortgagee. The Mortgagee will deliver all policies and certificates of insurance, including additional and renewal policies to the Mortgagee and, in case of insurance policies about to expire, the Mortgagee will deliver renewal policies not less than ten (10) days prior to the respective dates of expiration.

7. Deposits for Taxes and Insurance Premiums. In order to assure the payment of taxes and insurance premiums payable with respect to the Premises as and when the same shall become due and payable:

(a) The Mortgagee shall, if hereinafter required by Mortgagee, deposit with the Mortgagee on the first day of each and every month, commencing with the date the first payment of interest and/or principal and interest shall become due on the Independence Secured hereby, an amount equal to:

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(c) The Mortgagee will, out of the Tax and Insurance Deposits, upon the presentation to the Mortgagee by the Mortgageor of the bills therefor, pay the Insurance premiums and Taxes or will, upon the presentation of receipts bills therefor, reimburse the Mortgageor for such payments made by the Mortgageor. (b) The aggregate of the monthly Tax and Insurance Deposits, together with monthly payments of interest and/or principal and interest payable on the Note shall be paid in a single payment each month, to be applied prior to default to the following items in the order stated:

provided that the amount of such deposits (herein generally called "Tax and Insurance Deposits") shall be based upon Mortgagee's reasonable estimate as to the amount of Taxes and Insurance premiums next to be payable; and (2) Taxes and Insurance Deposits shall be held by the Mortgagee without any allowance of interest thereon.

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(a) In case of loss covered by policies of insurance, the Mortgagee (or, after entry of decree of foreclosure, the purchaser at the foreclosure sale or decree creditor, as the case may be) is hereby authorized at its option either (i) to settle and adjust any claim under such policies without the consent of the Mortgagee, or (ii) allow the Mortgagee to agree with the insurance company or companies on the amount to be paid upon the loss; provided that the Mortgagee may itself adjust losses aggregating not in excess of TEN THOUSAND UNITED STATES DOLLARS (\$10,000) if such

8. Proceeds of Insurance. The Mortgagee will give the Mortgagee prompt notice of any damage to or destruction of the premises, and

(e) Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, the Mortgagee, and its loan servicing agent, or their successors and assigns, shall not be liable for any failure to apply to the payment of Taxes and insurance premiums any amounts deposited as Tax and Insurance Deposits unless the Mortgagee, while no default exists hereunder, shall have requested the Mortgagee in writing to make application of such Deposits on hand to the payment of the particular Taxes or insurance premiums for the payment of which such deposits were made, accompanied by the bills thereof.

(d) In the event of a default in any of the provisions contained in this Mortgage or in the Note, the Mortgagee may, at its option, without being required so to do, apply any Tax and Insurance Deposits on hand to any of the Indebtedness Hereby Secured, in such order and manner as the Mortgagee may elect. When the Indebtedness Hereby Secured has been fully paid, then any remaining Tax and Insurance Deposits shall be paid to the Mortgagee. All Tax and Insurance Deposits are hereby pledged as additional security for the Indebtedness Hereby Secured, and shall be held by the Mortgagee to be irrevocably applied for the purposes for which made as herein provided, and shall not be subject to the direction or control of the Mortgagee.

Tax and Insurance Deposits on hand shall not be sufficient to pay all of the Taxes and insurance premiums when the same shall become due, then the Mortgagee shall pay to the Mortgagee on demand any amount necessary to make up the deficiency. If the total of such Deposits exceeds the amount required to pay the Taxes and insurance premiums, such excess shall be credited on subsequent payments to be made for such Deposits.

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(d) In the event that proceeds of insurance, if any, shall be made available to the Mortgagee for the restoring, repairing, replacing or rebuilding of the Premises, the Mortgagee hereby covenants to restore, repair, replace or rebuild the same, to be of at least equal value and of substantially the same character as prior to such damage or destruction, all to be effected in accordance with plans and specifications to be first submitted to and approved by the Mortgagee.

(c) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this Paragraph 8, the Mortgagee may apply the proceeds of insurance consequent upon any Insured Casualty upon the indebtedness hereby secured, in such order or manner as the Mortgagee may elect; provided, however, that such application of proceeds shall not be considered a voluntary prepayment of the Note which would require the payment of any prepayment premium or penalty.

(b) In the event of any insured damage to or destruction of the Premises or any part thereof (herein called an "Insured Casualty"), and if, in the reasonable judgment of the Mortgagee, the Premises can be restored to an economic unit not less valuable than the same was prior to the Insured Casualty and adequately securing the outstanding balance of the Indebtedness Hereby Secured, then, if no Event of Default, as hereinafter defined, shall have occurred and be then continuing and the Mortgagee shall not be in default hereunder, the proceeds of insurance shall be applied to reimburse the Mortgagee for the cost of restoring, repairing, replacing or rebuilding the Premises or part thereof subject to Insured Casualty, as provided for in Paragraph 9 hereof; and the Mortgagee hereby covenants and agrees forthwith to commence and diligently to prosecute such restoring, repairing, replacing or rebuilding; provided, always, that the Mortgagee shall pay all costs of such restoring, repairing, replacing or rebuilding in excess of the net proceeds of insurance made available pursuant to the terms hereof.

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10. Condemnation. The Mortgagee hereby assigns, transfers and sets over unto the Mortgagee the entire proceeds of any award or claim for damages for any of the Premises taken or damaged under the power of eminent domain or by condemnation including any payments made in lieu of or in settlement of a claim or threat of condemnation. The Mortgagee may elect to apply the proceeds of the award upon or in reduction of the indebtedness hereby secured then most favorably to be paid, whether due or not, or require the Mortgagee to restore or rebuild the Premises, in which event the proceeds shall be held by the Mortgagee and used to reimburse the Mortgagee for the cost of such rebuilding or restoring. If, in the reasonable judgment of the Mortgagee, the Premises can be restored to an economic unit not less valuable than the same was prior to the condemnation and adequately securing the outstanding balance of the Indebtedness Hereby Secured, the award shall be used to reimburse the Mortgagee for

9. Disbursement of Insurance Proceeds. In the event the Mortgagee is entitled to reimbursement out of insurance proceeds held by the Mortgagee, such proceeds shall be disbursed from time to time upon the Mortgagee being furnished with (i) evidence satisfactory to it of the estimated cost of completion of the restoration, repair, replacement and rebuilding, (ii) funds (or assurances satisfactory to the Mortgagee that such funds are available) sufficient in addition to the proceeds of insurance to complete the proposed restoration, repair, replacement and rebuilding, and (iii) such architect's certificates, waivers of lien, contractor's sworn statements, title insurance endorsements, plats or survey and such other evidences of cost, payment and performance as the Mortgagee may reasonably require and approve; and the Mortgagee may, in any event, require that all plans and specifications for such restoration, repair, replacement and rebuilding be submitted to and approved by the Mortgagee prior to commencement of work. No payment made prior to the final completion of the restoration, repair, replacement and rebuilding shall exceed twenty (20%) percent of the value of the work performed from time to time; funds other than proceeds of insurance shall be disbursed prior to disbursement of such proceeds) and at all times the undisbursed balance of such proceeds remaining in the hands of the Mortgagee, together with funds deposited for the purpose or irrevocably committed to the satisfaction of the Mortgagee to pay for the cost of completion of the restoration, repair, replacement or rebuilding, free and clear of all liens or claims for lien. Any surplus which may remain out of insurance proceeds held by the Mortgagee after payment of such costs of restoration, repair, replacement or rebuilding shall, at the option of Mortgagee, be applied on account of the indebtedness hereby secured then most favorably to be paid, or be paid to any other party entitled thereto. No increase shall be allowed to the Mortgagee on account of any proceeds of insurance or other funds held in the hands of the Mortgagee.

13. Effect of Extensions of Time and Amendments on Junior Liens and Others. If the payment of the indebtedness Hereby secured, or any part thereof, be extended or varied, or if any part of the security therefor be released, all persons now or at any time hereafter liable therefor, or interested in the premises, shall be held to assent to such extension, variation or release, and their liability, and the lien, and all provisions hereof, shall continue in full force and effect; the right of recourse against all such persons being expressly reserved by the Mortgagee, notwithstanding any such extension, variation or release. Any person, firm or corporation taking a junior mortgage, or other lien upon the premises or any interest therein, shall take the said lien subject to the rights of the Mortgagee to amend, modify and supplement this Mortgage, the Note and the Assignments herein referred to, and to extend the maturity of the Indebtedness Hereby Secured, in each and every case without obtaining the consent of the holder of such junior lien and without the lien of this Mortgage losing its priority over the rights of any such junior lien.

12. Prepayment Privilege. At such time as the Mortgagee is not in default under the terms of the Note, or under the terms of this Mortgage, the Mortgagee shall have the privilege of making a prepayment of a portion of or the entire unpaid principal balance of the Note (in addition to the required payments thereunder) in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the Note, but not otherwise.

11. Stamp Tax. If, by the laws of the United States of America, or of any state or municipality having jurisdiction over the Mortgagee or the premises, any tax is used or becomes due in respect of the issuance of the Note, the Mortgagee shall pay such tax in the manner required by such law.

the cost of restoration and rebuilding; provided, always, that Mortgagee is not in default hereunder and that no event of Default has occurred and is then continuing. 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14. Mortgagee's Performance of Mortgagor's Obligations. In case of default herein, the Mortgagee, either before or after acceleration of the Indebtedness Hereby Secured or the foreclosure of the lien hereof and during the period of redemption, if any, may, but shall not be required to, make any payment or perform any act herein required of the Mortgagor (whether or not the Mortgagor is personally liable therefor) in any form and manner deemed expedient to the Mortgagee; and the Mortgagee may, but shall not be required to, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or foreclosure affecting the premises or contest any tax or assessment, and may, but shall not be required to, complete construction, furnishing and equipping of the improvements upon the premises and rent, operate and manage the premises and such improvements and pay operating costs and expenses, including management fees, of every kind and nature in connection therewith, so that the premises and improvements shall be operational and usable for their intended purposes. All monies paid for any of the purposes herein authorized, and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorneys' fees and other monies advanced by the Mortgagee to protect the premises and the lien hereof, or to complete construction, furnishing and equipping or to rent, operate and manage the premises and such improvements or to pay any such operating costs and expenses thereof or to keep the premises and improvements operational and usable for its intended purpose, shall be so much additional Indebtedness Hereby Secured, whether or not they exceed the face amount of the Note, and shall become immediately due and payable without notice, and with interest thereon at the Default Rate, as defined in the Note. Inaction of the Mortgagee shall never be considered as a waiver of any right accruing to it on account of any default on the part of the Mortgagor. The Mortgagee, in making any payment hereby authorized (a) relating to taxes and assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate, without inquiry into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or title or claim thereof; (b) for the purchase, discharge, compromise or settlement of any other prior lien, may do so without inquiry as to the validity or amount of any claim for lien which may be asserted; or (c) in connection with the completion of construction, furnishing or equipping of the improvements or the rental, operation or management of the premises or the payment of operating costs and expenses thereof, Mortgagee may do so in such amounts and to such persons as Mortgagee may deem appropriate and may enter into such contracts therefor as Mortgagee may deem appropriate or may perform the same itself.

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(b) The Collateral is to be used by the Mortgagee solely for business purposes, pursuant to the Master Plan, being installed upon the Premises for Mortgagee's own use or as the equipment and furnishings furnished by Mortgagee, as landlord, to tenants of the Premises.

(a) The Mortgagee (being the Debtor as that term is used in the Code) is and will be the true and lawful owner of the Collateral, subject to no liens, charges or encumbrances.

17. Illinois Uniform Commercial Code. This Mortgage constitutes a Security Agreement under the Illinois Uniform Commercial Code (herein called the "Code") with respect to any part of the Premises which may or might now or hereafter be or be deemed to be personal property, fixtures or property other than real estate (all for the purposes of this Paragraph 17 called "Collateral"); all of the terms, provisions, conditions and agreements contained in this Mortgage pertain and apply to the Collateral as fully and to the same extent as to any other property comprising the Premises, and the following provisions of this Paragraph 17 shall not limit the generality or applicability of any other provision of this Mortgage but shall be in addition thereto:

16. Financial Statements. If required by the Mortgagee, the Mortgagee will, within ninety (90) days after the end of each fiscal year of Mortgagee, furnish to the Mortgagee financial and operating statements of the Premises for such fiscal year, including, but without limitation, a balance sheet and supporting schedules, detailed statement of income and expenditures and supporting schedules, detailed statement of income and expenditures and supporting schedules, all in reasonable detail. Such financial and operating statements shall be prepared and certified at the expense of Mortgagee in such manner as may be acceptable to the Mortgagee, and the Mortgagee may, by notice in writing to the Mortgagee, require that the same be prepared and certified, pursuant to audit, by a firm of independent certified public accountants satisfactory to Mortgagee.

15. Inspection of Premises and Records. The Mortgagee shall have the right to inspect the Premises and all books, records and documents relating thereto at all reasonable times, and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.

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(f) Upon any event of default hereunder and at any time thereafter, the Mortgagee at its option may declare the indebtedness hereby secured immediately due and payable, all as more fully set forth in Paragraph 19 hereof, and thereupon Mortgagee shall have the remedies of a secured party under the Code, including, but without limitation, the right to take immediate and exclusive possession of the Collateral, or any part thereof, and for that purpose may, so far as the Mortgagee can give authority herefor, with or without judicial process, enter (if this can be done without breach of the peace) upon any place which the Collateral or any part thereof may be situated and remove the same therefrom (provided that if the Collateral is affixed to real estate, such removal shall be subject to the conditions stated in the Code); and the Mortgagee

(g) The Collateral will be kept at the real estate comprised within the Premises, and will not be removed therefrom without the consent of the Mortgagee (being the Secured Party as that term is used in the Code) or any other person and the Collateral may be affixed to such real estate but will not be affixed to any other real estate.

(d) The only persons having any interest in the Premises are the Mortgagee, the Mortgagee and permitted tenants and users thereof.

(e) No financing statement covering any of the Collateral or any proceeds thereof is on file in any public office; and Mortgagee will at its own cost and expenses, upon demand, furnish to the Mortgagee such further information and will execute and deliver to the Mortgagee such financing statements and other documents in form satisfactory to the Mortgagee and will do all such acts and things as the Mortgagee may at any time or from time to time reasonably request or as may be necessary or appropriate to establish and maintain a perfected security interest in the Collateral as security for the indebtedness hereby secured, subject to no adverse liens or encumbrances and the Mortgagee will pay the cost of filing the same or filing or recording such financing statements or other documents, and this instrument, in all public offices wherever filing or recording is deemed by the Mortgagee to be necessary or desirable.

shall be entitled to hold, maintain, preserve and pre-
 pare the collateral for sale, until disposed of, or may
 propose to retain the collateral subject to Mortgagor's
 right of redemption in satisfaction of the Mortgagor's
 obligations as provided in the Code. The Mortgagor
 without removal may render the collateral unusable and
 dispose of the collateral on the premises. The Mortga-
 gae may require the Mortgagor to assemble the collateral

 Mortgagor will give Mortgagor at least five (5) days
 notice of the time and place of any public sale thereof

 be held as part of and in conjunction with any foreclos-
 ure sale of the real estate comprised within the
 premises, the collateral and real estate to be sold as
 one lot if Mortgagor so elects. The net proceeds
 realized upon any such disposition, after deduction for
 the expenses of retaking, holding, preparing for sale,
 selling or the like and the reasonable attorney's fees
 and legal expenses incurred by Mortgagor, shall be
 applied against the indebtedness hereby secured. The
 Mortgagor will account to the Mortgagor for any surplus
 realized on such disposition.

(g) The remedies of the Mortgagor hereunder are
 cumulative and the exercise of any one or more of the
 remedies provided for herein or under the Code shall
 not be construed as a waiver of any of the other
 remedies of the Mortgagor, including having the
 collateral deemed part of the realty upon any
 foreclosure thereof so long as any part of the
 indebtedness hereby secured remains unsatisfied.

(h) The terms and provisions contained in this
 Paragraph 17 shall, unless the context otherwise
 requires, have the meanings and be construed as
 provided in the Code.

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(i) This Mortgage is intended to be a financing statement within the purview of Section 9-402(6) of the Code with respect to the collateral and the goods described at the beginning of this Mortgage, which goods are or are to become fixtures relating to the Premises. The addresses of the Mortgagor (Debtor) and Mortgagee (Secured Party) are set forth in Paragraph 36 hereof. This Mortgage is to be filed for record with the Recorder of Deeds of the County or Counties where the Premises are located. The Mortgagor is the record owner of the Premises.

18. Restrictions on Transfer. It shall be an Event of Default hereunder if, without the prior written consent of the Mortgagee, any one or more of the following shall occur:

(a) If the Mortgagor shall create, effect or consent to or shall suffer or permit any conveyance, sale, assignment, transfer, lien, pledge, mortgage, security interest or other encumbrance or alienation of the Premises or any part thereof or interest therein, excepting only sales or other dispositions of collateral (herein called "Obsolete Collateral") no longer useful in connection with the operation of the Premises, provided that prior to the sale or other disposition thereof, such Obsolete Collateral has been replaced by collateral, subject to the first and prior lien hereof, of at least equal value and utility;

(b) If the Mortgagor is a Trustee, then if any beneficiary of the Mortgage shall create, effect or consent to, or shall suffer or permit any sale, assignment, transfer, lien pledge, mortgage, security interest or other encumbrance or alienation of all or any portion of such beneficiary's beneficial interest in the Mortgagor;

(c) If the Mortgagor is a corporation, or if any corporation is a beneficiary of a trustee mortgagor, then if any shareholder of such corporation shall create, effect or consent to or shall suffer or permit any sale, assignment, transfer, lien, pledge, mortgage, security interest or other encumbrance or alienation of any such shareholder's shares in such corporation; provided that if such corporation is a corporation whose stock is publicly traded on a national securities exchange or on the "Over the Counter" market, then this subparagraph 18(c) shall be inapplicable;

(c) If demand be made on the Guarantor and shall not be paid within five days of demand or

(b) If default be made and shall continue for five (5) days in the due and punctual payment of demand Loan Note, or any installment thereof, either principal or interest, as when and the same is due and payable, or if default be made and shall continue for five (5) days in the making of any payment of monies required to be made hereunder or under the Note; or

(a) If default be made and shall continue for five (5) days in the due and punctual payment of the Note or any installment thereof, either principal or interest, as and when the same is due and payable, or if default be made and shall continue for five (5) days in the making of any payment of monies required to be made hereunder or under the Note; or

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19. Events of Default. If one or more of the following events (herein called "Events of Default") shall occur:

In each case whether any such conveyance, sale, assignment, transfer, lien, pledge, mortgage, security interest, encumbrance or alienation is effected directly, indirectly, voluntarily or involuntarily, by operation of law or otherwise; provided that the foregoing provisions of this Paragraph 18 shall not apply to (i) liens securing the indebtedness hereby secured, (ii) the lien of current taxes and assessments not in default, and (iii) any transfers of the Premises, or part thereof, or interest therein, or any beneficial interests, or shares of stock or partnership or joint venture interests, as the case may be, in the Mortgagee or any beneficiary of a trustee mortgagee or on behalf of an owner thereof who is deceased or declared judicially incompetent, to such owner's heirs, legatees, devisees, executors, administrators, estate, personal representatives and/or committee. The provisions of this Paragraph 18 shall be operative with respect to, and shall be binding upon, any persons who, in accordance with the terms hereof or otherwise shall acquire any part of or interest in or encumbrance upon the Premises, or such beneficial interest in, shares of stock of, or partnership or joint venture interest in, the Mortgagee or any beneficiary of a trustee mortgagee.

(d) If the Mortgagee is a partnership or joint venture, or if any beneficiary of a trustee mortgagee is a partnership or joint venture, then if any partner or joint venturer in such partnership or joint venture shall create, effect or consent to or shall suffer or permit any sale, assignment, transfer, lien, pledge, mortgage, security interest or other encumbrance or alienation of all or any part of the partnership interest or joint venture interest, as the case may be, of such partner or joint venturer;

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(iv) Mortgagor shall be adjudged a bankrupt, or a trustee or receiver shall be appointed for the mortgagor for all or a material part of the mortgagor's property or the premises,

(iii) Within thirty (30) days after the filing against mortgagor of any involuntary proceeding under the federal bankruptcy code or similar law for the relief of debtors, such proceedings shall not have been vacated or stayed,

(ii) Mortgagor shall file an answer admitting insolvency or inability to pay its debts, or

(i) Mortgagor shall file a petition in voluntary bankruptcy under any chapter of the federal bankruptcy code, or any similar law for the relief of debtors, state or federal, now or hereafter in effect, or

(1) If (and for the purpose of this subsection (1) of this paragraph is only, the term mortgagor shall mean and include not only mortgagor but any beneficiary of a trustee mortgagor and each person who, as guarantor, co-maker or otherwise, shall be or become liable for or obligated upon all or any part of the indebtedness hereby secured or any of the covenants or agreements contained herein),

(a) If default be made in the delivery to the mortgagee of the financial statements required pursuant to Paragraph 16 hereof and be continuing ten (10) days after notice thereof by mortgagee to the mortgagor,

(b) If an event of default pursuant to Paragraph 18 hereof shall occur and be continuing without notice or period of grace of any kind; or

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20. Possession by Mortgagee. When the Indebtedness Hereby Secured shall become due, whether by acceleration or otherwise, the Mortgagee shall, if applicable law permits, have the right to enter into and upon the Premises and take possession thereof or to appoint an agent or trustee for the collection of the rents, issues and profits of the Premises; and the net income, after allowing a reasonable fee for the collection thereof and for the management of the Premises, may be applied to the payment of Taxes, Insurance premiums and other charges applicable to the Premises, or in reduction of the Indebtedness Hereby Secured; and the rents, issues and profits of and from the Premises are hereby specifically pledged to the payment of the Indebtedness Hereby Secured.

When the Mortgagee is hereby authorized and empowered, at its option, and without affecting the lien hereby created or the priority of said lien or any right of the Mortgagee hereunder to declare, without further notice, all Indebtedness Hereby Secured to be immediately due and payable, whether or not such default be thereafter remedied by the Mortgagee, and the Mortgagee may immediately proceed to foreclose this Mortgage or to exercise any right, power or remedy provided by this Mortgage, the Note, the Assignments or by law or in equity conferred.

(g) If the premises shall be abandoned;

(f) If default shall continue for ten (10) days after notice thereof by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagee in the due and punctual performance or observance of any other agreement or conditions herein or in the Note; or

(e) If any default shall exist under the provisions of Paragraph 20 hereof or under the Assignments referred to in said Paragraph; or)

(v) Mortgagee shall make an assignment for the benefit of creditors or shall admit in writing its inability to pay its debts generally as they become due or shall consent to the appointment of a receiver or trustee or liquidator of all or a material part of its property, or the Premises; or

in any involuntary proceeding, or any court shall have taken jurisdiction of all or the major part of the Mortgagee's property or the Premises in any involuntary proceeding for the reorganization, dissolution, liquidation or winding up of the Mortgagee, and such trustee or receiver shall not be discharged or such jurisdiction relinquished or vacated or stayed on appeal or otherwise stayed within thirty (30) days, or

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21. Foreclosure. When the Indebtedness Hereby Secured, or any part thereof, shall become due, whether by acceleration or otherwise, the Mortgagee shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof for such Indebtedness or part thereof. In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional Indebtedness in the decree of sale, all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of the Mortgagee for attorneys' fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographer's charges, publication costs and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches and examinations, title insurance policies and similar data and assurance with respect to title, as the Mortgagee may deem reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at sales which may be had pursuant to such decree, the true conditions of the title to or the value of the Premises. All expenditures and expenses of the nature mentioned in this paragraph, and such other expenses and fees as may be incurred in the protection of the Premises and the maintenance of the lien of this Mortgage, including the fees of any attorney employed by the Mortgagee in any litigation or proceedings affecting this Mortgage, the Note or the Premises, including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, or in preparation of the commencement or defense of any proceedings or threatened suit or proceeding, shall be so much additional Indebtedness Hereby Secured and shall be immediately due and payable by the Mortgagee, with interest thereon at the Default Rate per annum until paid.

22. Receiver. Upon, or at any time after, the filing of a complaint to foreclose this Mortgage, the Court in which such complaint is filed may appoint a receiver of the Premises, without regard to solvency or insolvency of the Mortgagee at the time of application for such receiver, and without regard to the then value of the Premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not; and the Mortgagee hereunder or any employee or agent thereof may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have the power to collect the rents, issues and profits of the Premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a sale and deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, if any, whether there be a redemption or not, as well as during any further times when the Mortgagee, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collection of such rents, issues and profits and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the Premises during the whole of said period. The court may, from time to time, authorize the receiver to apply the net income from the Premises in his hands in payment in whole or in part of:

21. Foreclosure. All expenditures and expenses of the nature mentioned in this paragraph, and such other expenses and fees as may be incurred in the protection of the Premises and the maintenance of the lien of this Mortgage, including the fees of any attorney employed by the Mortgagee in any litigation or proceedings affecting this Mortgage, the Note or the Premises, including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, or in preparation of the commencement or defense of any proceedings or threatened suit or proceeding, shall be so much additional Indebtedness Hereby Secured and shall be immediately due and payable by the Mortgagee, with interest thereon at the Default Rate per annum until paid.

22. Receiver. Upon, or at any time after, the filing of a complaint to foreclose this Mortgage, the Court in which such complaint is filed may appoint a receiver of the Premises, without regard to solvency or insolvency of the Mortgagee at the time of application for such receiver, and without regard to the then value of the Premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not; and the Mortgagee hereunder or any employee or agent thereof may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have the power to collect the rents, issues and profits of the Premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a sale and deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, if any, whether there be a redemption or not, as well as during any further times when the Mortgagee, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collection of such rents, issues and profits and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the Premises during the whole of said period. The court may, from time to time, authorize the receiver to apply the net income from the Premises in his hands in payment in whole or in part of:

24. Insurance Upon Foreclosure. In case of an insured loss after foreclosure proceedings have been instituted, the proceeds of any insurance policy or policies, if not applied in rebuilding or restoring the buildings or improvements as aforesaid, shall be used to pay the amount due in accordance with any decree of foreclosure that may be entered in any such proceeding, and the balance, if any, shall be paid as the court may direct. In the case of foreclosure of this Mortgage, the court, in its decree, may provide that the mortgage's clause attached to each of the casualty insurance policies may be cancelled and that the decree creditor may cause a new loss clause to be attached to each of said casualty insurance policies making the loss thereunder payable to said decree creditor, and any such foreclosure decree may further provide that in case of one or more redemptions under said decree, pursuant to the statutes in such case made and provided, then in every such case, each and every successive redeemer may cause the preceding loss clause attached to each casualty insurance policy to be cancelled and a new loss clause to be attached thereto, making the loss thereunder payable to such redeemer. In the event of foreclosure of the Mortgage, the Mortgage is hereby authorized, without the consent of the Mortgagee, to assign any and all insurance policies to the Mortgagee at the sale, or to take such other steps as the Mortgagee may deem advisable to cause the interest of such purchaser to be protected by any of the said insurance policies without credit or allowance to Mortgagee for prepaid premiums thereon.

23. Proceeds of Foreclosure Sale. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the Premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in Paragraph 21 hereof; Second, all other items which, under the terms hereof, constitute Indebtedness Hereby Secured additional to that evidenced by the Note, with interest on such items as herein provided; Third, to interest remaining unpaid upon the Note; Fourth, to the principal remaining unpaid upon the Note; and Fifth, any overage to the Mortgagee and its successors or assigns, as their rights may appear.

- (a) The Indebtedness Hereby Secured or the Mortgage, or any tax, special assessment, or other lien which may be or become superior to the lien hereof or of such decree, provided such application is made prior to the foreclosure sale; or
- (b) The deficiency in case of a sale and deficiency.

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26. Assignment. As further security for the indebtedness Hereby Secured, the Mortgagee has, concurrently herewith, executed and delivered to the Mortgagee a separate instrument (herein called the "Assignment") dated as of the date hereof, wherein and whereby, among other things, the Mortgagee has assigned to the Mortgagee, pursuant to the Assignment, all of the rents, issues and profits with respect to the Premises, and any and all leases now or hereafter executed by the Mortgagee, as lessor or landlord, with respect to the Premises. All of the terms and conditions of said Assignment are hereby incorporated herein by reference as fully and with the same effect as if set forth herein at length. The Mortgagee agrees that it will duly perform and observe all of the terms and provisions on its part to be performed and observed under the Assignment. Nothing herein contained shall be deemed to obligate the Mortgagee to perform or discharge any obligation, duty or liability of Mortgagee under the Assignment, and the Mortgagee shall and does hereby indemnify and hold the Mortgagee harmless from any and all liability, loss or damage which the Mortgagee may or might incur by reason of the Assignment; and any and all such liability, loss or damage incurred by the Mortgagee, together with the costs and expenses,

25. Waiver. The Mortgagee hereby covenants and agrees that it will not at any time insist upon or plead, or in any manner whatsoever claim or take any advantage of, any stay, exemption or extension law or so-called "Moratorium Law" now or at any time hereafter in force, nor claim, take or insist upon any benefit or advantage of or from any law now or hereafter in force providing for the valuation or appraisal of the Premises, or any part thereof, prior to any sale or sales thereof to be made pursuant to any provisions herein contained, or to any decree, judgment or other of any court of competent jurisdiction; or after such sale or sales claim or exercise any rights under any statute now or hereafter in force to redeem the property so sold, or any part thereof, or relating to the marshalling thereof, upon foreclosure sale or other enforcement hereof. The Mortgagee hereby expressly waives any and all rights of redemption from sale under any order or decree of foreclosure of this Mortgage, on its own behalf and on behalf of each and every person acquiring any interest in or title to the Premises subsequent to the date hereof, it being the intent hereof that any and all such rights of redemption of the Mortgagee and of all other persons, are and shall be deemed to be hereby waived to the full extent permitted by the provisions of Illinois Revised Statutes, Chapter 77, Sections 18(a) and 18 (b), and any statute enacted in replacement or substitution thereof. The Mortgagee will not invoke or utilize any such law or laws or otherwise hinder, delay or impede the exercise of any right, power or remedy herein or otherwise granted or delegated to the Mortgagee, but will suffer and permit the exercise of every such right, power and remedy as though no such law or laws have been made or enacted.

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31. Successors and Assigns. This Mortgage and each and every covenant, agreement and other provision hereof shall be binding upon the Mortgagor and its successors and assigns (including, without limitation, each and every record owner from time to time of the premises or any other person having an interest therein), and shall inure to the benefit of the Mortgagor and its successors and assigns. Wherever herein the

30. Rights Cumulative. Each right, power and remedy herein conferred upon the Mortgagor is cumulative and in addition to every other right, power or remedy, express or implied, given now or hereafter existing, at law or in equity, and each and every right, power and remedy herein set forth or otherwise so existing may be exercised from time to time as often and in such order as may be deemed expedient to the Mortgagor and the exercise or the beginning of the exercise of one right, power or remedy shall not be a waiver of the right to exercise at the same time or thereafter any other right, power or remedy; and no delay or omission of the Mortgagor in the exercise of any right, power or remedy accruing hereunder or arising otherwise shall impair any such right, power or remedy, or be construed to be a waiver of any default or acquiescence therein.

29. Mortgagor's Successors. In the event that the ownership of the premises becomes vested in a person or persons other than the Mortgagor, the Mortgagor may, without notice to the Mortgagor, deal with such successor or successors in interest of the Mortgagor with reference to this Mortgage and the Indentment Hereby Secured in the same manner as with the Mortgagor. The Mortgagor will give immediate written notice to the Mortgagor of any conveyance, transfer or change of ownership of the premises, but nothing in this paragraph 30 shall vary or negate the provisions of paragraph 18 hereof.

28. Further Assurances.
