The Mortgagor Further Agree (that should this mortgage and the note secured hereby not be eligible for insurance under the National Housing Act, within The DAYS from the date hereof (written statement of any officer of the Department of Housing and Urban Development of authorized agent of the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development dated subsequent to the time from the date of this mortgage, declining to insure said note and this mortgage being deemed conclusive proof of such ineligibility), the Mortgagee or the holder of the note may at its option, declare all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable. Notwithstanding the foregoing, this option may not be exercised by the Mortgagee when the ineligibility for insurance under the National Housing Act is due to the Mortgagee's failure to remit the mortgage insurance premium to the Department of Housing and Urban Development.

In the Event of default in making any monthly payment provided for herein and in the note secured hereby for a period of thirty (30) days after the due date thereof, or in case of a breach of any other covenant or agreement herein stipulated, then the whole of said principal sum remaining unpaid together with accrued interest thereon, shall, at the election of the Mortgagee, without notice, become immediately due and payable.

This rider attached to and made part of the Mortgage between ROBERT G. BENNETT AND

JANET C. BENNETT, HIS WIFE MOTTEMENT, and FLEET MORTGAGE CORP. revises said Mortgage as follows:

Page 2, the fourth covenant of the Hortgage is amended to read:

That, together with, and in addition to, the monthly payments of principal and interest payable under the terms of the note secured hereby, the Mortgagor will pay to the Mortgagoe, on the first day of each month until the said note is fully paid, the following sums:

- A sum equal to the ground rents, if any, next due, plus the premiums that will next become due and payable on policies of fire and other hazard insurance covering the mortgaged property, plus taxes and assessments next due on the mortgaged property (all as estimated by the Mortgagee) less all sums already paid therefor divided by the number of months to elapse before one month prior to the date when such ground rents, premiums, taxes and assessments will become delinquent, such sums to be held by Mortgagee in trust to pay said ground rents, premiums, taxes and special assessments; and
- (b) All payments mentioned in the two preceding subsections of this paragraph and all payments to be made under the note secured hereby shall be added together and the aggregate amount thereof shall be maid by the Mortgagor each month in a single payment to be applied by the Mortgagoe to the following items in the order set forth:
