THIS PROPERTY SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 4 day of fine 12980, by and between NANCY PENN MORGAN, of Lexington, Fayette County, Kentucky, hereinafter known as Wife, and WILLIAM H. MORGAN, of Bourbon County, Kentucky, hereinafter known as Husband;

#### WITNESSETH:

WARREAS, the parties are husband and wife; and WHEREAS, unfortunate differences have arisen making it impossible for them to hereafter live together as husband and wife; and

WHEREAS, they are now separated and living apart; and WHEREAS, they desire to enter into a settlement agreement fixing the rights of each of the parties irrespective of whether or not a dissolution of the marriage is granted;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), and other good and valuable considerations, including the mutual covenants contained herein, the receipt of all of which is hereby acknowledged, it is agreed by and between the parties as follows, to-wit:

1. That Wife does hereby waive, release and relinquish unto Husband, his heirs and assigns forever, all of her right, title and interest in and to all property now owned or hereafter acquired by Husband, including the right of dower, and does waive, release and relinquish all claims for future support or maintenance that she may have against Husband, except as hereinafter set out in this contract.

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- 2. That Husband does hereby waive, release and relinquish unto Wife, her heirs and assigns forever, all of his right, title and interest in and to all property now owned or hereafter acquired by Wife, including the right of curtesy, except as hereinafter set out in this contract.
- 3. That as a division of marital property, the Wife shall receive as her own all horses which are presently registered in her name and their produce. Husband shall receive all horses registered in ris name and their produce.
- 4. That Busband shall receive the property known as the Ruddles Mill Farm in Bourbon County, Kentucky, subject to the mortgage indebtedness thereon which he assumes and agrees to pay according to the terms thereof, and further agrees to hold Wife harmless from any and all liability as a result of having signed the note and mortgage on said farm. Wife, in turn, agrees to execute any and all documents necessary to effect the transfer of all of her interest in said farm to said Husband.
- 5.
