The Note has an initial Interest Rate of 8.250 %. Beginning on the date of the Note, the Borrower will pay interest at the Initial Interest Rate until the first Change Date. The Note interest rate may be changed on the 1st day of the month beginning un OCTOBER 1, 1987 and on that day of the month every 12 months thereafter. Each date on which the rate of interest may change is called a Change Date.

Changes in the interest rate are governed by changes in an interest rate index called the "Index". The Index is the Federal Home Loan Bank Board Montn'y Hational Median Annualized Cost of Funds for FSLIC-insured savings and loan associations.

To set the new interest rate, before each interest Change Date, the Note Holder will first add TWO AND ONE QUARTER PERCENT (2.25%) to the Current Index. The Current Index is the most recent index figure available 45 days prior to each Change Date. The Note Holder will then round the result of this addition to the nearest one-eighth of one percentage point (0.125%). This rounded amount will be the new rate of interest until the next interest Change Date provided that on any Change Date the rate of interest will not be increased or decreased by more than percentage points (2%) . At no time during the term of the Note shall the interest rate be less than 2.250 per annum nor more than 13.500 per annum.

The first twelve monthly payments due under the Note will each be in the amount of \$726.47 Beginning with the 13th payment, the amount of the monthly payments will be determined in accordance with the terms of the Note and will always be sufficient to repay the unpaid principal calence in full in substantially equal payments by the final payment date.

A. FIXED IN ALLEST RATE OPTION

The Note provides for the Borrower's option to convert from an adjustable interest rate to a fixed interest rate, as follows:

1. Option to Corver. to Fixed Rate

I have a Conversion (pt.on which I can exercise unless I am in default or this Section A1 or Section A3 below will not permit me to do so. The "Conversion Option" is my option to convert the interest rate I am required to pay by the Note from an adjustable rate to a fixed rate.

My new, fixed interest rate will be equal to the Federal National Mortgage Association's required net yield for 30-year, fixed rate mortgages covered by 30-day mandatory delivery commitments in effect as of the date 15 days before the Conversion Date, plus five-eighths of one percent (.625%). If this required net yield is not available, the Note Holder will determine my interest rate by using a comparable fig.ire.

3. Reduction of Principal Balance Before Conversion; Appraisal

The result of this calculation will be the new amount of my monthly payment. Beginning with my first monthly payment after the Conversion Date, I will pay the new amount as my monthly payment until the final payment date.
