#### SUDGMENT FOR DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

THIS CAUSE coming on to be heard as a contested matter on the Petition for Dissolution of Marriage of the plaintiff, DUSAN RADOYEVICH, and he appearing in open Court in his own proper person and by his attorney, WILLIAM M. FREEMAN, and the defendant, SOPHIE RADOYEVICH, appearing in open Court in her own proper person and by her attorney, JAMES E. LAND, and the Court having heard the evidence and testimony of the parties and expert witnesses, all duly sworn and examined in open Court, and the Court considering all of the evidence and now being fully advised in the premises, DOTH FIND:

- 1. That the Court has jurisdiction of the parties hereto and of the subject matter hereof.
- 2. That the plaintiff, DUSAN RADOYEVICH, is 65 years of age; the defendant, SOPHIE RADOYEVICH, is 68 years of age and both have been residents of Cook County, Illinois for many years, and more particularly that the plaintiff at the time of filing his Petition was domiciled in the State of Illinois, Cook County, and said domicile has been maintained for more than ninety (90) days prior to the making of the findings herein.

- 3. That the parties were married on January 10, 1976 in Chicago, Illinois and said marriage is registered in Cook County, Illinois; that this is the second marriage for each of the parties; that no children were born or adopted of this marriage, and the defendant is not presently pregnant.
- 4. That without cause or provocation by the plaintiff, the defendent has been guilty of extreme and repeated mental cruelty toward the plaintiff.
- 5. Plaintiff is unemployed and presently receives the sum of \$552.00 per month as Social Security benefits. Defendant is unemployed and presently receives the sum of \$323.00 per month as Social Security benefits.
- 6. Plaintiff was imployed at Republic Steel Corporation for 32.083 years and retired on June 30, 1982. He received the sum of \$115,888.00 as a lump sum payment of his pension at Republic Steel, having received said sum in two payments; to-wit, \$7,284.00 in June, 1982 and \$108,604.00 in October, 1982. He also received the sum of \$1,710.00 as a lump sum payment earned vader an earlier pension plan. At the time of plaintiff's retirement, he had been married to defendant for 6.5 years.
- 7. In January, 1985, following plaintiff's retirement in June of 1982, plaintiff received the sum of \$42,777.00 from his employee savings plan at Republic Steel. Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars of this sum had been accumulated by him prior to his marriage to defendant. The balance of \$37,777.00 was accumulated after the marriage. Of the \$42,777.00 some \$26,695.00 was contributed by the employer and this portion of the funds was "rolled over" into an IRA account with A. G. Edwards & Co. The balance, \$16,082.00, was

placed in an A. G. Edwards & Co. money market account. Subsequently, this \$16,082.00 was transferred to a Talman Certificate of Deposit and a Talman money market account, both in the joint names of the parties. In December, 1983, \$5,000.00 was transferred from the A. G. Edwards & Co. IRA to the Talman money market account and in December of 1984, another \$5,000.00 was similarly transferred. 1983 and 1984, approximately \$28,000.00 of these funds, and the accumulated interest and dividends, was used to supplement the parties Social Security benefits to pay their ordinary living expenses.

- Defendant was employed as a checker at Jewel Tea Company for approximately 10 years following the death of her first husband until her marriage to plaintiff. She worked 23 hours a week and earned approximately \$8.00 per hour. Defendant has not been employed during her marriage to plainting.
- Plaintiff supported himself and defendant from his salary earned at Republic Steel until he retired in June of 1982.

  After his retirement, the parties income consisted of their respective of Social Security payments and the interest and dividends received from the investments of plaintiff's savings and lump sum pension.
- The parties purchased a home, in joint tenancy, in April of 1978, commonly known as 2309 207th Street, Lynyopd, Cook County, Illinois, and legally described as follows:

"LOT TWENTY-FIVE (25) IN SANDRIDGE SUBDIVISION UNIT NO. 2, being a Subdivision of part of the Southeast Quarter (1) of Section 13, Township 35 North, Range 14, East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois, as per Plat of Subdivision registered as Document 2976594 in the Office of the Registrar of Titles in Cook County, Illinois, on October 25, 1977."

  - c. \$1,710.00 being a distribution of plaintiff's pension plan earned entirely prior to his marriage to the defendant. Said sum presently is part of the A. G. Edwards & Co. IRA account.
  - D. \$26,366.00 being interest earned and accumulated on the plaintiff's non-marital assets described in sub-paragraphs 12 A., 12 B., and 12 C. above.

  - F. A piano owned by plaintiff prior to his marriage to the defendant.

- 13. That plaintiff has proved the material allegations of his Petition for Dissolution of Marriage by substantial, competent and relevant evidence; and that a Judgment for Dissolution of Marriage should be entered herein.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED as follows:

- A. That the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the plaintiff, DUSAN RADOYEVICH, and the defendant, SOPHIE RADOYEVICH, be dissolved and the marriage is accordingly dissolved as to both parties.
- B. That both plaintiff and defendant are barred from any claim or right to support or maintenance from the other, past, present or future.
- C. The defendant, SOPHIE RADOYEVICH, is awarded as her sole and separate property, free and clear of any and all interest or claim therein by plaintiff, the following described property:

Defendant shall indemnify and hold the plaintiff harmless from any and all liability upon said mortgage obligation. Plaintiff shall forthwith execute and deliver a Quit Claim Deed conveying said premises to defendant.
  - 2. All of the household furniture and furnishings owned by the parties and presently or heretofore located in the marital home with the exception of a certain piano owned by plaintiff prior to the parties' marriage.
  - 3. The 1980 Oldsmobile Omega automobile described in paragraph 11 F. above.
  - 4. \$8,300.00 cash presently in possession of the defendant, described in paragraph 11 D. above.

  - 4. The \$26,366.00 being the interest and dividends as described in paragraph 12 D. above.
  - 5. The \$8,200.00 being the LTV Credit Union account described in paragraph 12 E. above.
    - 6. The piano described in paragraph 12 7. above.
    - 7. The coin collection described in paragraph 12 G. above.
  - 8. The 12 U.S. Savings Bonds described in paragraph 12 H. above.
  - 9. The 1980 Chevy Citation automobile described in paragraph 11 E. above.
  - 10. The \$11,845.00 being the interest and dividends described in paragraph 11 C. above.

Each of the parties hereto further covenants and agrees for himself and herself
