#### JUDGMENT FOR DIVORCE

This cause coming on to be heard on the Complaint for Divorce of the plaintiff and the deferdant having filed his pro so appearance and the matter coming on for immediate hearing upon the Stipulation of the parties that this cause be set for hearing as a default and uncontested matter, and the defendant failing to file his answer to the Complaint filed herein, and an Order of default being entered against him, and the plaintiff appearing in open court by her attorneys, FRIEND AND STEPONATE, by FRANK T. STEPONATE, and the court hearing the testimony of the witnesses duly sworn and examined in open court (a certificate of evidence of said testimony being filled herein) and the court considering all of the avidence and new being fully advised in the orraises. FINDs:

- Plaintiff and defendant are now and for more than one year last past, continuously, immediately preceding the filing of the Complaint for Divorce, have been residents of the State of Illinois.
- 2. Plaintiff and defendant were lawfully married on May 8, 1965, at Chicago, allinois and from said date until on or about July 1970, lived : and cohabited together as husband and wife, that always during said period plaintiff remained a true, loving and faithful wife.

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- 3. That there were no children born or adopted by the parties hereto of this marriage.
- 4. Defendant has been guilty of extreme and repeated mental cruelty toward the plaintiff during the marriage without cause or provocation thereon, to-wit: as set forth in plaintiff's Complaint for Diverce.

  Plaintiff has lived separate and apart from the defendant since on to-wit: July 1970.
- 5. That plaintiff and defendant on April 1, 1971, entered into a written agreement providing for settlement of their property rights and support. Said agreement has been presented to this Court for its consideration and is to become part and parcel of this Decree for Divorce.
- 6. The court having considered said Agreement and the circumstances of the parties finds that the said Agreement was entered into by the parties, and the court should approve the agreement.
- 7. The Court further finds that the plaintiff has established by competent, material and relevant proof all of the allegations and charges contained in her Complaint for Divorce, the equities of the case are with the plaintiff, and that this court has jurisdiction of the parties to this cause and the subject matter thereof.

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Court by virtue of the power and authority therein vested and the Statutes in such case made and provided, DOTH ORDER, ADJUDGE AND DECREE AS NOLLOWS:

- A. That the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between FRANCES M. BAER and GORDON A. BAER, be and the same are hereby dissolved.
- B. That each of the parties shall do and perfrom each and every act and thing by him and her undertaken by the provisions of the written agreement, heretofore entered herein on the lat day of April 1971, by and between the parties hereto, which said Agreement is in words and figures as follows:

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#### SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This Agreement, made and entered into this lot day of prof.

1971, by and between FRANCES M. BABR, hereinafter referred to as " wife " and GORDON A. BABR, hereinafter referred to as " Husband ".

Whereas, the parties hereto were married to each other on May 8, 1965, and there were no children born to the parties hereto.

Wieness, the parties are desirous of having this divorce matter between them mard as an uncontested default matter, and have been estranged from each other, since on or about January 10, 1971, and

Whereas, without in any manner colluding, the parties consider it to their best interests to settle between themselves now and forever, the respective rights of property, dower rights, homestead rights, and any and all other rights or property or otherwise growing out of the marital relationship, now or previously existing between them, and which either of them now has of may hereaster claim to have against the other, and all rights of every kind, nature and description, which either of them now has or may hereafter have, or claim to have against the other, or every kind, nature and description, whether real, personal or mixed, now owned or which may hereafter be acquired by either of them, and

Whereas, each party has made full disclosure to the other of all properties owned by him or her, and are fully advised as to their rights and premises fully understand and comprehend the nature and import of this Agreement, and

Whereas, the wife has filed a suit for Divorce against the husband in the Circuit Court of Cook County, Illinois, Case Number 71 D 3814.

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NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises of the parties, and for other good and valuable consideration, the parties hereto, covenant and agree as follows:

- 1. That the wife is to have the sole possession of the marital home, located at 1809 Evergreen Road, Homewood, Illinois, husband will execute any and all documents necessary to transfer a quit-claim deed, his title, right and interest in said home and the wife will hold the husband harmless for payment of said mortgage on said marital home.
- 2. Trat the husband is to have as his sole property, free and clear from any claim from the wife, the 1908 Pontiac presently in his possession.
- 3. That the husband agrees that the cats shall be the sole property of the wife.
- 4. That the husband agrees that the wife shall have the sole possession of all the furniture in the marital home excepting a reclining chair and some tools which shall be considered the personal property of the husband.
- 5. All other possessions now in the possession of the husband and wife are to be their own respective property.
- 6. Husband agrees that savings accounts held in the joint names of the parties shall be the sole property of the wife.
  - 7. That the wife agrees to waive alimony, past, present and future.
- 8. That the wife agrees to be solely responsible for her attorney's fees and court costs, holding the husband harmless for payment of same.

The parties both mutually agree that they will at any time hereafter execute any and all instruments and documents that are necessary to
carry out the aforementioned provisions of this Agreement, relating to the
property, both real and personal.

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This Agreement, if approved by the Court, in the above entitled action, shall become effective upon the entry of a Judgment for Divorce in the said action and only in that event, and shall be physically incorporated in such Judgment for Divorce.

Each of the parties agree, that this Settlement Agreement shall act as a full, complete, and final sattlement, natisfaction, and discharge of any and all legal rights, claims, or demands, of either party against the other for support, maintenance, alimony or other interest or money demand, which might otherwise than for this Agraement, be asserted by either party hereto agains: the other or the estate of the other.

This Settlement Agreement negotiated and prepared by FRIEND AND STEPONATE, attorney for FRANCES M. BAER, and having rdvised and informed GORDON A. BAER, that they acted solely as counsel for FRANCES M. BAER, and do not advise or represent GORDON A. BAER in this settlement Agreement. FRIEND AND STEPONATE have advised GORDON A. BAER to secure connect to represent him in this matter but GORDON A. BAER has refused to do so, has carefully read the Agreement, fully understands the terms and willingly signed it.
