of loss if not made promptly by Mortgagor, and each insurance company concerned is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for such loss directly to the Mortgagee instead of to the Mortgagor and the Mortgagee jointly, and the insurance proceeds, or any part thereof, may be applied by the Mortgagee at its option either to the reduction of the indebtedness hereby secured or to the restoration or repair of the property damaged. In event of fore closure of this mortgage or other transfer of title to the mortgaged property in extinguishment of the indebtedness secured hereby, all right, title and interest of the Mortgagor in and to any insurance policies then in force shall pass to the purchaser or grantee.

That if the premises, or any part thereof, be condemned under any power of eminent domain, or acquired for a public use, the damages, proceeds, and the consideration for such acquisition, to the extent of the full amount of indebtedness upon this Mortgage, and the Note secured be eby remaining unpaid, are hereby assigned by the Mortgager to the Mortgager and shall be paid forthwith to the Mortgager to be applied by it on account of the indebtedness secured hereby, whether due or not.

The Mortgagor Further Agrees that should this mortgage and the note secured hereby not be eligible for insurance under the rig National Housing Act, within from the date hereof (written statement of pay officer of the Department of Housing and Urban Development or authorized agent of the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development dated subsequent to the time from the date of this mortgage, declining to insure sold note and this mortgage being deemed conclusive proof of such ineligibility), the Mortgagee or the holder of the note may, at its option, declare all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable. Notwithstanding the foregoing, this option may not be exercised by the Mortgagee when the ineligibility for insurance under the National Housing Act is due to the Mortgagee's failure to remit the mortgage insurance premium to the Department of Housing and Urban Development.

In the Event of default in making any monthly payment provided for herein and in the note secured hereby for a period of thirty (30) days after the due date thereof, or in case of a breach of any other covenant or agreement herein stipulated, then the whole of said principal sum remaining unpaid together with accrued interest thereon, shall, at the election of the Mortgagee, without notice, become immediately due and payable.

And In The Event that the whole of said debt is declared to be due, the Mortgagee shall have the right immediately to foreclose this mortgage, and upon the filing of any bill for that purpose, the court in which such bill is filed may at any time thereafter, either before or after sale, and without notice to the said Mortgagor, or any party claiming under said Mortgagor, and without regard to the solvency or insolvency of the person or persons liable for the payment of the indebtedness secured hereby, at the time of such applications for appointment of a receiver, or for an order to place Mortgagee in possession of the premises and without regard to the value of said premises or whether the same shall be then occupied by the owner of the equity of redemption, as a homestead, enter an order placing the Mortgagee in possession of the premises, or appoint a receiver for the benefit of the Mortgagee with power to collect the rents, issues, and profits of the said premises during the pendency of such foreelosure suit and, in case of sale and a deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, and such rents, issues, and profits when collected may be applied toward the payment of the indebtedness, costs, taxes, insurance, and other
