JUDGMENT FOR DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

THIS CAUSE coming to be heard off the regular contested calendar call on the Petition for Dissolution of Marriage of the Petitioner, GARY E. SWANSON, and upon the Response thereto of the Respondent, LINDA JAN SWANSON, said cause having been assigned for trial to the HONORABLE JOHN W. GUSTAFSON; the Petitioner appearing in open Court in his own proper person and by his attorney, HERBERT A. GLIEBERMAN, of the law offices of HERBERT A. GLIEBERMAN AND ASSOCIATES, on behalf of the Petitioner, and the Respondent appearing in open Court in her own proper person and by her attorney, DENNIS CARLSON, on behalf of the Respondent, and hearing on the grounds of said cause having been heard on March 13, 1987, and ruled on that day; and further trial on the remaining issues having been heard on March 13, 16, 17, 20 and 31, 1987 and all remaining issues having been ruled on April 8, 1987, including but not limited to the question of maintenance and support, distribution of marital and non-marital property and attorney's fees and court costs. The Court having heard the sworn testimony of both the Petitioner and the Respondent, having heard all the wit-

nesses for the Petitioner and the Respondent, having considered all the relevant evidence and exhibits submitted by both parties and heard the arguments of counsel for the Petitioner and the Respondent;

F I N D S:

1. That this Court has jurisdiction of the parties hereto and of the subject matter hereof.

2. That the Petitioner was a resident of the State of Illinois at the time that the Petition for Dissolution of Marriage was commenced, and has maintained a residence in the State of Illinois for more than ninety (90) days next preceding the making of these findings.

3. That the parties were married to each other on July 27, 1974, at Urbana, Illinois, and that said marriage was registered at Champaign County, Illinois, and the parties separated in July of 1984.

4. That irreconcilable differences have arisen between the Respondent and the Petitioner which have caused the irretrievable breakdown of the marriage; that efforts at reconciliation have failed and that future attempts at reconciliation would be impracticable and not in the best interest of the parties hereto.

5. That no children were born to or adopted by the parties hereto as issue of their marriage, and that the Respondent is not now pregnant.

6. That the parties are possessed of marital and non-marital property, both real and personal, including all the furniture, furnishings and effects acquired by them during their marriage which is found to be marital property, as hereinafter set forth.

7. That this Court has considered all the relevant factors set forth in Chapter 40 of the Illinois Revised Statutes including, but not limited to Sections 503, 504 and 508 thereof.

ON MOTION OF THE COURT, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

A. That the parties are awarded a Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage and that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Petitioner and the Respondent be and the same are hereby dissolved.

B. That all prior restraining orders and temporary injunctions entered in this cause are hereby vacated and set aside.

C. That neither party is in need of or entitled to maintenance and both parties are hereby forever barred and foreclosed from seeking maintenance, heretofore known as alimony, from the other.

D. That the Court has considered the contribution or dissipation of each party in the acquisition, preservation or depreciation or appreciation in value of the marital and non-marital property, including the contribution of a spouse as a homemaker to the family unit as set forth in Chapter 40 §502 and finds:

1. That the Petitioner shall have as his sole and separate property, free and clear of any interest that the Respondent may have therein, the following:

- a. The entire NBC Pension and Profit Sharing Plan.
- b. The individual retirement account in the name of GARY E. SWANSON.
- c. One gold Krugerrand.
- d. The 1986 Chevrolet Corvette, and he shall be solely responsible for any and all payments on the purchase price of same.

e. 1984 BMW Motorcycle.

f. The following stocks:

i. Genentec	25 shares
ii. Intel	20 shares

vii. Minnetonka	65 shares

g. The following bonds:

- i. 8 1/2 bonds with a face value of \$200.00 per bond

h. Any and all of his family's heirlooms remaining in the marital home, as well as any and all items that are listed as being awarded to the Respondent in the attached list marked as Exhibit A.

i. The marital home, subject to the balance of the first mortgage and payment to the Respondent for her interest as hereinafter provided; and the Respondent shall, upon the entry of the Judgment, execute a quit claim deed or assignment of beneficial interest, releasing all of her interest in said property to the Petitioner, free and clear of any debts or liens of her making and standing against said property, other than the first mortgage which both parties executed. If subsequently there are found to be any liens, judgments, encumbrances, assessments of a special or general nature outstanding against said property of the Respondent's making, upon being notified of the same, the Respondent shall immediately arrange to pay and discharge said liens, judgments, encumbrances or assessments and hold the Petitioner harmless from the payment of same. If it becomes necessary to bring this issue before the Court for settlement due to Respondent's failure to satisfy liens which she has created, then the Respondent shall pay all of the Petitioner's attorney's fees and court costs incurred to litigate this matter.

2. That the Respondent shall have as her sole and separate property, free and clear of any interest that the Petitioner may have therein, the following:

a. The 1981 Plymouth Horizon that is in her possession and shall be solely responsible for any and all payments due on the purchase price of same.

- b. Any and all of her family's heirlooms remaining in the marital home, the RCA video cassette recorder, model 650, and the items listed under her name in the attached list marked as Exhibit A.
- c. One gold Krugerrand.
- d. The Pension and Profit Sharing Plan Petitioner has received through her employment with Abbott Laboratories.
- e. Two individual retirement accounts valued at \$1,500.00 in total.
- f. The following stocks:
 - i. Genentec - 25 shares
 - ii. Intel - 20 shares
 - iii. Abbott Laboratories - 172 shares
- g. The following bonds:
 - i. 13 1/2 bonds with a face value of \$200.00 per bond
 - ii. 16 bonds with a face value of \$500.00 per bond
- h. The 1984 Honda Accord purchased by the Respondent on which there is no indebtedness.

E. That the Petitioner, GARY E. SWANSON, shall purchase the interest of LINDA JAN SWANSON in the marital home for TWENTY-THREE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED (\$23,400.00) DOLLARS, and shall pay her that sum within sixty (60) days of the entry of this Judgment or as soon thereafter as the loan arrangements are completed with the Petitioner's lending institution enabling Petitioner to secure the funds to complete the purchase.

F. That each party shall be solely responsible for any and all debts and obligations they individually incurred during their marriage, and subsequent to their separation and shall hold the other party harmless from payment of same.

G. That the Respondent shall be solely responsible for the TWENTY TWO HUNDRED (\$2,200.00) DOLLAR tax debt she has incurred, and shall indemnify and hold the Petitioner harmless from the payment of same.

H. The Petitioner shall be solely responsible for the loan from his profit sharing and pension plan of SEVEN THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED AND FORTY THREE (\$7,443.00) DOLLARS and he shall indemnify and hold the Respondent harmless from the payment of same.

I. That each of the parties shall be solely responsible for the payment of all of their own attorney's fees and court costs incurred in these proceedings and shall indemnify and hold the other harmless from the payment of same.

J. Each of the parties hereto is barred from any and all rights to act as administrator-with-the-will-annexed of the other party; each of the parties shall further relinquish all right to inherit by intestate succession any of the property of which the other party may die seized or possessed, and should either of the parties hereto die intestate, this Judgment shall operate as a relinquishment of all right of the surviving party hereafter to apply for letters of administration in any form, and the estate of such deceased party, if he or she dies intestate, shall descend to the heirs at law of such deceased party, in the same manner as though the parties hereto had never been married, each of the parties hereto shall reserve the right to dispose, by testament or otherwise, of his or her

respective property in any way he or she may see fit, without restriction or limitation whatsoever, except as otherwise provided herein.

K. Except as herein provided in this Judgment, each party is barred from any and all maintenance heretofore known as alimony, any and all rights and claims against the other party and his or her agents, attorneys and servants, and each of the parties is further barred from all other rights, titles, claims, interests and estates as Husband and Wife, widow or widower, or otherwise, by reason of the marital relationship existing between said parties hereto, under any present or future law, or which he or she otherwise has or might have or be entitled to claim in, to or against the property, life insurance or other assets of the other, real, personal or mixed, whether marital or non-marital, or his or her estate, whether now owned or hereafter in expectancy and whether vested or contingent.

L. That each of the parties hereto, shall execute and acknowledge, good and sufficient instruments necessary or proper to vest the titles and estates in the respective parties hereto, as hereinbefore provided, and hereafter, at any time and from time to time, to execute and acknowledge any and all documents which may be necessary or proper to carry out the purposes of this Judgment and to establish of record the sole and separate properties of said parties in the manner herein provided. If either party hereto for any reason shall fail or refuse to execute any such documents, then this Judgment shall, and it is hereby expressly declared to, constitute a full and present transfer, assignment and conveyance of all rights hereinbefore designated to be transferred, assigned and conveyed and a full, present and effective relinquishment and waiver of all rights hereinbefore designated to be terminated and relinquished by each party.

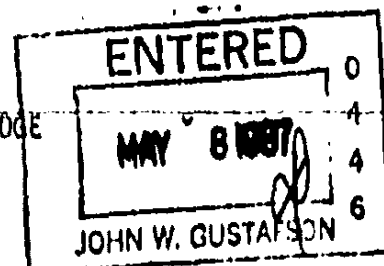

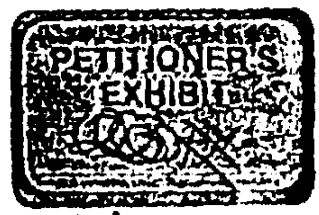

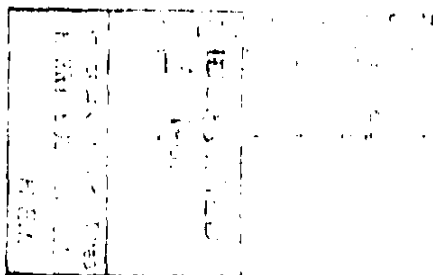
