SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

REAL ESTATE

1. The parties agree that the wife will be awarded the sole and exclusive right, title, ownership and interest in and to the condominium commonly known as 3925 Triumvera Drive, Unit 12-C in Glenview, Illinois and legally described in accordance with Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof. Wife shall assume and pay and save the bushand harmless from the mortgage, taxes, homeowner's insurance, condominium assessments. Husband agrees that he will assign his interest in the real estate tax escrow account and will further sign an homeowner's insurance assignment.

BANK ACCOUNTS
