JUDGMENT FOR DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

This cause coming on to be heard upon the Petition for Dissolution of Marriage of the Petitioner, JULIE KATZ, the Petitioner appearing in her own proper person and by her attorney, WILLIAM C. COUGHLIN, and the Respondent, LOUIS KATZ, appearing in his own proper person and by his attorney, LYLE COHEN, and stipulating that the matter be heard as in cases of default; and the Court having heard testimony of the Petitioner duly sworn and examined in open Court, and offering proof in support of the allegations and charges contained in her Petition for Dissolution of Marriage (a certificate of which evidence is filed herein), and the Respondent interposing no defense to said allegations and charges; and the Court being fully advised in the premises FINDS;

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- 1. That it has jurisdiction of the parties hereto and the subject matter hereof.
- 2. That the Petitioner at the time of filing of said
 Petition was domiciled in the State of Illinois and has maintained said domicile for at least ninety (90) days prior to the
 findings herein.
- 3. That the parties hereto were lawfully married on July 1, 1984, in Chicago, Illinois, and said marriage was registered in Cook County. Illinois; that no children were born as a result of this marriage. That no children were adopted by the parties as a result of this marriage and that the Petitioner is not now currently pregnant.
- 4. That the Petitioner has proved by competent evidence that the Petitioner and Respondent have suffered irreconcilable differences which has caused the irretrievable breakdown of their marriage.
- 5. That the parties hereto have entered into an oral property settlement agreement to dispose of and settle between themselves all questions and matters in dispute between them. Those terms are as follows:
- A. That the parties are joint owners of a condominium unit located at 1425 Sandpebble, Unit 231, Wheeling, Illinois. It is the parties agreement that the Petitioner, JULIE KATZ, shall convey any and all interest she has in said condominium unit to LOUIS KATZ, upon the effective date of this Agreement. Further,

she will execute a Quit Claim Deed conveying said interest to LOUIS KATZ upon the effective date of this order. In return, the Rusband will pay the Wife as and for her intrest in this condominium unit the sum of FIVE THOUSAND and no/100 DOLLARS (\$5,000.00) payable upon the effective date of this order. From the effective date of this order the Husband shall be responsible for any and all expenses related to said condominium, including but not limited to all mortgage payments, real estate takes and repair bills.

- B. That the parties shall keep as their sole and exclusive property the Individual Retirement Accounts of TWO THOUSAND and no/100 DOLLARS (\$2,000.00) currently in each of their names.
- C. That the Husband small keep as his sole and exclusive personal property the following.
 - 1. All furniture presently located in the condominium unit described above.
 - 2. The Mazda automobile currently in his possession, and he shall be solely responsible and hold the Wife harmless from any and all loan payments due on said automobile.
- D. That the Wife shall keep as her sole and exclusive personal property the following:
 - 1. The diamond wedding ring currently in her possession.
 - 2. All wedding and shower gifts received by her as a result of this marriage.
 - 3. The Chevrolet Camaro presently in her possession.
- E. That the parties shall split the outstanding Visa bill in the approximate amount of \$3,750.00 as follows: Husband shall

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be responsible for two-thirds of said bill and the Wife shall be responsible for one-third of said bill.

- F. That upon the effective date of this agreement the Wife shall resume the use of her maiden name, to-wit: JULIE RUBENSTEIN.
- G. That upon the effective date of this agreemnt, each party agrees to waive maintenance from each other and each shall be forever parred from ascertaining same against the other.
- H. Each of the parties, his or her heirs, executors or administrators, upon demand of the other, shall execute and deliver to the other party, any and all instruments and documents as may be designated herein or as may be reasonably necessary to make effective the provisions of this agreement or to release his or her respective interests in any property, real or personal, belonging to or awarded to the other, the intention being that the property settlement provided for in this Judgment shall constitute a complete adjustment of the property rights of the parties hereto.
- I. Except as otherwise provided herein, each of the parties hereto shall hereby forever relinquish, release, will we and quit claim to the other party hereto all rights of dower and homestead and all property rights and claims which he or she now has or may hereafter have as husband, wife, widow, widower or otherwise, or by reason of the marital relations having existed between the parties hereto or by virtue of any present or future law of any state of the United States of America or any other country, in or to, or against the property of the other party or his or her estate,

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whether now owned or hereafter acquired by such other party.

Each of the parties hereto further covenants and agrees for himself and herself and his or her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, that he or she will never at any time hereafter sue the other party or his or her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, for the purpose of enforcing any of the rights relinquished herein.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, and this

Court by virtue of the power and authority therein vested and

the statute in such cases made and provided, DOES ORDER, ADJUDGE

AND DECREE that:

- A. The Petitioner's Petition for Dissolution of Marriage is granted and the parties are awarded a dissolution of marriage; that the marriage heretofore existing between the parties be and is hereby dissolved.
- B. The agreement between the Petitioner, JULIE KATZ, and the Respondent, LOUIS KATZ, hereinbefore set forth in full, be and is hereby made a part of this Judgment for Dissolution of Marriage, and all of the provisions of said agreement be and are expressly ratified, confirmed, approved and adopted as the Order of the Court to the same extent and with the same force and effect as if said provisions were in this paragraph set forth verbatim as the judgment of this Court.
- C. Petitioner and Respondent shall execute, acknowledge and deliver any and all documents, including Quit Claim Deeds, which

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may be necessary or proper to carry out the undertakings and purposes of the aforesaid agreement and any of the provisions of the Judgment.

- D. That the Petitioner shall resume the use of her maiden name, to-wit: JULIE RUBENSTEIN.
- E. This Court shall retain jurisdiction of this cause for the purpose of carrying out and enforcing the terms and provisions of this Judgment and the entry of such other and further orders as this Court shall deem proper.
