JUDGMENT FOR DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

K. HERRON'S 'Petition for Dissolution of Marriage", with the Respondent, SAMUEL HERRON, having filed his Pro Se Appearance and waiving his fight to respond hereto, and the "Stipulation" of the Parties to have this matter heard as an uncontested matter, with the Petitioner appearing in open Court represented by MELVIN J. COLE of the Lew Firm of COLE & VICTOR, and the Court having heard the testimony and being fully advised in the premises, FINDS:

- A. Petitioner and Respondent were domiciled in the County of Cook, State of Illinois at the time this action was commenced and that domicile has been maintained for more than ninety (90) days next preceding the making of the findings herein, and this Court has jurisdiction of the Parties hereto and the subject matter hereof.
- B. Petitioner and Respondent were lawfully joined in marriage on September 17th, 1964, said marriage being registered in the County of Cook, State of Illinois.
- C. One (1) child was born to the Parties and none were adopted during the course of their marriage, namely: JEROME MAJOR, born July 8th, 1971; and that Petitioner is not now pregnant.

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- D. Subsequent to the marriage of the Parties, the Respondent has been guilty of extreme and repeated mental cruelty without cause or provocation on the part of the said Petitioner.
- Marital Settlement Agreement, after having revealed all of their assets and liabilities to each other, which Agreement this Court finds to be fair, equitable and not unconscionable, the terms of which have been approved by this Court. The Agreement has been presented to the Court and is set forth hereinafter as the Judgment of this Court, the terms of said Agreement being as follows:
- 1. That Petitioner will retain custody of the Parties one (1) minor child, with the Respondent having all rights of reasonable visitation with said child at all reasonable times and places, upon giving her 48 hours notice.
- 2. a) That Respondent will pay Petitioner the sum of \$125.00 twice a month as and for support of their minor child, based upon his net earnings of \$561.00 twice a month; but that the child support will increase 's \$150.00 twice a month when Respondent has completed continuous payments of his bills set forth on Schedule "A" attached hereto; Said support payments to be made through the Clerk of the Circuit Court of County.

 b) Petitioner will take their said minor child as

her Federal and State income tax exemption.

- c) Respondent will be responsible for the extraordinary medical expenses for their minor child, and retain his present medical insurance for said child;
- d) Respondent will retain said minor child as his irrevocable beneficiary on his present life insurance listed on Schedule "A" attached hereto.
- Both Parties right to past, present or future maintenance will be barred, they having waived said right to main-

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The Parties are presently the joint owners of their real estate, being the marital residence located at 9109 S. Saginaw, Chicago, Illinois, and legally described as follows:

"SEE SCHEDULE "A" ATTACHED HERETO

Respondent will convey his interest in said real estate to Peticioner so that she will be the sole owner; and that she will be solely responsible for payment of the mortgage, and maintenance costs for said real estate.

- b) Petitioner will retain their furniture and furnishings presently located in their said marital residence as her sole property
- Each Party will be responsible for the payment of their own debts, except that Respondent will be solely responsible for the payment of their joint debts to the Steele City and balance due Internal Kevenue Service for 1979 Taxes, Bank, and he will hold Petitioner harmless from any payment thereon.
- 6. The Parties will retain their own pension and saving accounts or credit union plans now in their possession, and each Party hereto will release any interest each may have in the other's pension, savings account and credit unions.
- Each Party will be responsible for the payment of 7. their own Attorneys' fees.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED and ADJUDGED as follows:

Figure and That the Parties hereto are awarded a "Judgment of Dissolution of Manriage", and the bonds of matrix only existing between the Petitioner, BARBARA K. HERRON, and the Respondent, SAMUEL HERRON, are hereby dissolved and the same are dissolved accordingly, and the Parties are no longer macried to one another.

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- C. Each of the Parties hereto will, promptly upon demand by the other Party, execute any and all documents that may be necessary to effectuate and fulfill the terms of this Judgment.
- This Court expressly retains jurisdiction of this cause for the purpose of enforcing all the terms of this "Judgment for Dissolution of Marriage", including all the terms of the Oral Marital Settlement Agreement entered into between the Parties hereto as hereingove set forth
