#### JUDOMENT FOR DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

VERIFIED
This cause coming on to be heard on the Petition For Dissolution of Marriage filed herein by Petitioner, Fannie Johnson, and the Default for failure to plead or appear after personal service of Respondent, Andrew L. Johnson, the Petitioner appearing in open court by her attorney Nicholas C. Avgerin, of Cordell and Avgerin; and the Court having jurisdiction of the parties and the subject-matter FINDS:

- 1. That at the commencement of the within action, Petitioner was domiciled in the State of Illinois and has maintained said domicile for more than 90 days preceding the entry of the within Judgment For Dissolution of Marriage.
- 2. That the parties were lawfully married on June 5, 1956 and that said marriage was registered at Corinth, Mississippi.
- 3. That four (4) children were born to the parties hereto as issue of their marriage, to-wit:
  - a. Derrick Johnson, a Minor age 15, born December
- b. Carol Johnson, age 19, employed and emancipated;
  c. Linda Johnson, age 21, employed and emancipated;
  d. Albert Johnson, age 22, employed and emancipated.
  That no children were adopted by the parties hereto and that the Petitioner is not now pregnant.
- 4. That the Respondent has been guilty of extreme and repeated Mental Oruelty as against the Petitioner Fannie Johnson, without cause or provocation on her part.

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- 5. That Petitioner is a fit and proper person to have the care, custody and control of education of the minor child, Derrick Johnson.
- 6. That the parties have been separated since on or about July 12, 1979 and that Petitioner moved from the marital residence at 2106 W. 119th Street, Chicago, Illinois in fear for her life and safety because of the actions and threats of the Respondent, Andrew L. Johnson.
- 7. That Petitioner has proved all of the material allegations of her Petition For Dissolution of Marriage by circumstantial, competent and relevant evidence and that a Judgment For Dissolution of Marriage should be entered herein.
- 8. That the marital residence at 2106 W. 119th Street, Chicago, Illinois is logally described as follows:

The East 3.4 feet of Lot 15 (as measured along the Northerly Line) and all of Lot 16 in Subdivision of Lots 10 to 14 both inclusive of Block 101 and of Lots 10 to 12 in Block 102 of Washington Heights, being a resublivision in Southwest a of Section 19, Township 37 North, Range 14, West of Pros pect Avenue East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois.

- 9. That on July 24, 1979 a Petition For a Temporary Restraining Order against the Respondent, restraining him, his agents and servants from molesting, harassing, annoying, threatening or injuring the Petitioner, was entered by Judge Robert 2. Cusack of this Court.
- 10. That the Respondent, Andrew L. Johnson be ordered and directed to vacate the marital premises at 2106 W. 119th Street Chicago, Illinois.
- 11. That Petitioner shall be awarded the marital residence as her sole and exclusive property, subject to the existing first (lst) mortgage thereon, in lieu of any additional or future support and maintenance to her.
- 12. That Petitioner be awarded permanent custody of the Minor child herein, Derrick Johnson.

  - .14. That Petitioner is entitled attorneys fees from the

the Respondent, Andrew L. Johnson.

15. That Petitioner is entitled to one-half (1) of the 1978 Income Tax Refund heretofore wholly retained by Respondent.

WHEREFORE, on motion of Nicholas C. Avgerin, attorney for Petitioner, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

A. That the Petitioner Fannie Johnson's Petition For Dissolution Of Marriage is granted and the parties are awarded a Dissolution of Marriage and the marriage bonds heretofore existing between the parties be and the same are hereby dissolved.

B. That the Petitioner be awarded permanent custody of the Minor child Derrick Johnson, with reasonable visitation privileges to the Respondent, Andrew L. Johnson.

C. That Respondent, Albert L. Johnson, shall pay as and for child support, to Famile Johnson, Petitioner, the sum of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars per week based on Petitioners income of \$9,000.00 to \$10,000.00 per year and Respondent's \$19,000.00 salary per year.

D. That sole and exclusive citle to the marital residence of the parties, legally described above, at 2106 W. 119th Street, Chicago, Illinois, be and is hereby awarded to the Petitioner, Fannie Johnson.

E. That Respondent shall execute all necessary documents in order to effect clear title solely in Petitioner Fennie Johnson's name, and shall Respondent Andrew L. Johnson, fail or refuse to execute said documents, the Associate Judge of the Land Title Division of the Circuit Court of Cook County shall execute a satisfactory document, at Respondent's cost.

F. That Respondent, Andrew L. Johnson is further Ordered to vacate the said marital premises at 2108 W. 119th Street, Chicago, Illinois, on or before Thirty (30) days from the date of entry of this Judgment For Dissolution Of Marriage.

H. That Respondent shall pay to the Petitioner Fannie Johnson, the sum of Five Hundred Fifty (\$550.00) Dollars as her fifty (50%) percent share of the Joint Income Tax refund for 1978, heretorore collected and withheld by said Respondent.

I. That this Court shall retain jurisdiction of this cause for the purpose of enforcing all and sundry the various provisions of this Judgment For Dissolution of Marriage.
