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## TRUST DEED

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THE ABOVE SPACE FOR RECORDER'S USE ONLY

THIS INDENTURE, made September 23, 1987, between SAMUEL HARRISON and ETHEL HARRISON, his wife

herein referred to as "Mortgagors," and CHICAGO TITLE AND TRUST COMPANY

an Illinois corporation doing business in Chicago, Illinois, herein referred to as TRUSTEE, witnesseth:

THAT, WHEREAS the Mortgagors are justly indebted to the legal holder or holders of the Instalment Note hereinafter described, said legal holder or holders being herein referred to as Holders of the Note, in the principal sum of EIGHT THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FORTY SEVEN AND 16/100s \$8,247.16 Dollars, evidenced by one certain Instalment Note of the Mortgagors of even date herewith, made payable to THE ORDER OF BEARER RUSSELL M. JOHNSON and JEANETTE JOHNSON, his wife and delivered, in and by which said Note the Mortgagors promise to pay the said principal sum and interest from October 1, 1987 on the balance of principal remaining from time to time unpaid at the rate of thirteen (13%) per cent per annum in instalments (including principal and interest) as follows:

All such payments on account of the indebtedness evidenced by said note to be first applied to interest on the unpaid principal balance and the remainder to principal; provided that the principal of each instalment unless paid when due shall bear interest at the rate of seven per annum, and all of said principal and interest being made payable at such banking house or trust company in Riverdale Illinois, as the holders of the note may, from time to time, in writing appoint, and in absence of such appointment, then at the office of RUSSELL M. JOHNSON and JEANETTE JOHNSON in said City, Riverdale, Illinois, County of Cook.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Mortgagors to secure the payment of said principal sum of money and said interest in accordance with the terms, provisions and limitations of this trust deed, and the performance of the covenants and agreements herein contained, by the Mortgagors to be performed, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents CONVEY and WARRANT unto the Trustee, its successors and assigns, the following described Real Estate and all of their estate, right, title and interest therein, situate, lying and being in the

TOGETHER with all improvements, tenements, easements, fixtures, and appurtenances thereto belonging, and all rents, issues and profits therefrom for so long and during all such times as Mortgagors may be entitled thereto (which are pledged primarily and on a parity with said real estate and not secondarily) and all apparatus, equipment or articles now or hereafter therein or thereon used to supply heat, gas, air conditioning, water, light, power, refrigeration (whether single units or centrally controlled), and ventilation, including (without restricting the foregoing), screens, window shades, storm doors and windows, floor coverings, indoor beds, awnings, stoves and water heaters. All of the foregoing are declared to be a part of said real estate whether physically attached thereto or not, and it is agreed that all similar apparatus, equipment or articles hereafter placed in the premises by the mortgagors or their successors or assigns shall be considered as constituting part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the premises unto the said Trustee, its successors and assigns, forever, for the purposes, and upon the uses and trusts herein set forth, free from all rights and benefits under and by virtue of the Homestead Exemption Laws of the State of Illinois, which said rights and benefits the Mortgagors do hereby expressly release and waive.
