If this required net yield is not available, the Note Holder will determine my interest rate by using a comparable figure.

### 3. Reduction of Principal Balance Before Conversion; Appraisal

If the unpaid principal I am expected to owe on the Conversion Date will be greater than the original principal amount of my loan, the Note Holder may require an appraisal report on the value of the property described in the Security Instrument.
