CATTLOF CHICAGO

WHEREAS, The City of Chicago (the "City") a home rule unit of government under Section 6(a), Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, has heretofore found that there exists within the City an abundance of vacated abandoned properties owned by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("H.U.D."); and

WHEREAS, The City has determined that the continued existence of these properties in their current state is harmful to the health, prosperity and economic stability and general welfare of the City; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 810 of the Federal Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, the Secretary of H.U.D. is authorized to transfer properties without monetary consideration, for use in Urban Homestead Programs, to local municipalities; and

WHEREAS, The City and Its United States of America heretofore entered into an agreement on July 27, 1979 entitled, "The Urban Homesteading Agreement", and such agreement, having been periodically renewed with the most recent renewal having been executed on January 25, 1985, provides for an Urban Homesteading Program in which H.U.D. would convey property located in the City of Chicago to the City which in turn would reconvey said property to "Homesteaders" with certain conditions and obligations to renovate said property; and

WHEREAS, The City, through its Department of Housing ("D.O.H.") in order to facilitate the renovation of the aforementioned H.U.D. conveyed properties, has been allocated \$313,612 in Section 312 Loan funds from H.U.D. to be used in addition to a previously programmed \$775,000 in Year X C.D.B.G. funds for the making of low interest loans to qualified Homesteaders, under the Urban Homestead Program; and

WHEREAS, The City, by regulations established by H.U.D. for the 312 Loan program and by agreement with H.U.D., is required to specifically obligate Section 312 Loan funds prior to August 30, 1985, or risk losing same; and

WHEREAS, D.O.H. has established a pool of potentially qualified Homestenders, including alternates, said pool being made up of 197 persons selected from a list of Citywide applicants at a lottery held by D.O.H. on June 1, 1985, (with a copy of said list attached as Exhibit A made a part hereof), said lottery having established the specific order of selection for conveyance of properties to Homestenders; and

WHEREAS, D.O.H. has established specific rules and guidelines for notifying the Aldermen whose wards contain H.U.D.-owned properties prior to the reconveyance of those properties to qualified Homestenders from the heretofore mentioned list; now, therefore,

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. The Commissioner of the Department of Housing is authorized to accept the conveyance of properties from H.U.D. which are specifically identified for use in the Urban Homestead Program, and is hereby authorized to execute any contract, deed, or other documents necessary to accomplish said conveyance.

SECTION 2. The Commissioner of the Department of Housing is hereby authorized to reconvey said properties to responsible "Homesteaders" (from the qualified lottery list attached as Exhibit A) who will reside in and rehabilitate said properties in accordance with the building codes of the City of Chicago within designated periods of time, in accordance with conditions as provided in detail in the aforementioned agreement entitled "The Urban Homestead Agreement" and in accordance with conditions and requirements specified in Section 810 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974.

SECTION 3 This ordinance shall be in full force and effect by and from the date of its passage.
