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AN ORDINANCE VACATING CERTAIN PUBLIC ALLEYS

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of Arlington Heights have determined that the public interest would be subserved by vacating certain public alleys described below in the Village of Arlington Heights; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of Arlington Heights have determined that the nature and extent of the public use and the public interest to be subserved is such as to warrant the vacation of certain public alleys as described below;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ARLINGTON HEIGHTS:

SECTION ONE: That certain public alleys, being legally described as:

Alleys in Scarsdale, being a subdivision of part of the West 1/2 of the East 1/2 and part of the East 1/2 of the West 1/2 of Section 32, Township 42 North, Range 11 East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

In the block bounded by Arlington Heights Road, Rockwell Street, Pine Avenue and Fairview Street;

In the block bounded by Arlington Heights Road, Fairview Street, Pine Avenue and Park Street;

In the block bounded by Arlington Heights Road, Park Street, Pine Avenue and the North lines of Lots 64 and 65, and said North lot lines extended, in said Scarsdale,

be and they are hereby vacated. The public alleys herein vacated are designated "hereby vacated" on the plat of vacation which is attached hereto and made part of this ordinance.

SECTION TWO: That there is hereby reserved to the Village of Arlington Heights or to any public utility owning

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public service facilities in such alleys, all rights of way and easements as are necessary and desirable for the continuation of public service by means of such facilities and for the maintenance, renewal and reconstruction thereof.


SECTION THREE: That upon approval of the easement as hereinabove required, the Village Clerk of the Village of Arlington Heights is hereby directed to file a true and correct copy of this ordinance, together with the plat of vacation, in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of Cook County.

SECTION FOUR: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.



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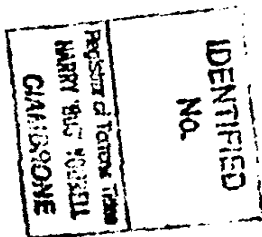


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
