To liave and to Hold the above described premises, with the appurtenances and fixtures, unto the said Mortgages, its successors and assigns, forever, for the purposes and uses herein set forth, free from all rights and benefits under and by virtue of the Homestead Exemption Laws of the State of Illinois, which said rights and benefits to said Mortgagor does hereby expressly release and waive.

To keep said promises in good repair, and not to do, or permit to be done, upon said promises, anything that may impair the value thereof, or of the security intended to be effected by virtue of this instrument; not to suffer any lien of mechanics men or material men to attach to said promises; to pay to the Mortgages, as heroinafter provided, until said note is fully paid, (1) a sum sufficient to pay all taxes and assessments on said promises, or any tax or assessment that may be levied by authority of the State of Illinois, or of the county, town, village, or city in which the said land is situate, upon the Mortgager on account of the ownership thereof; (2) a sum sufficient to keep all buildings that may at any time be on said promises, during the continuance of said indebtedness, insured for the ownership, as may be required by the Mortgagee.

In case of the refusal or neglect of the Morigagor to make such payments, or to satisfy any prior lien or en our brance other than that for laxes or assessments on said premises or to keep said premises in good repair, the Morigages may pay such takes, assessments, and insurance premiums, when due, and may make such repairs to the property herein morigaged as in its distriction it may deem necessary for the proper preservation thereof, and any moneys so paid or expended shall become so much additional indebtedness, secured by this morigage, to be paid out of proceeds of the sale of the morigaged premises, it not otherwise paid by the Morigagor.

And the said Morigagor further covenants and agrees as follows:

. That, together with, and in addition to, the monthly payments of principal and interest payable under the terms of the note secured hereby, the Mortgagor will pay to the Mortgages, on the lirst day of each month until the said note is fully paid, the following sums:

(a) A sum equal to the ground rents, it any, next due, plus the premiums that will next become due and payable on policies of fire and other hazard insurance covering the mortgaged property, plus taxes and assessments next due on the mortgaged property (all as estimated by the filority of months to elapse before one month prior to the date when such ground rents, premiums, taxes and assessments will become delinquent, such sums to be held by Mortgages in trust to pay said ground rents, premiums, taxes and apecial assessments; and

(b) All payments mentioned in the preceding subsection of this paragraph and all payments to be made under the note secured hereby shall be added together and the aggregate amount thereof shall be paid by the Mortgagor each month in a single payment to be applied by the Mortgagoe to the following items in the order set forth:

(i) ground rents, if any, taxes, special assessments, tire, and other hazard insurance premiums;

(II) interest on the note secured hereby;

(iii) amortization of the principal of the said note; and

(iv) Intecharges

Any deficiency in the amount of any such aggregate monthly payment shall, unless made good by the Morigagor prior to the due date of the next such payment, constitute an event of default under this mortgage. The Morigages may collect a "late charge" not to exceed four cents (4¢) for each dollar (\$1) for each payment more than lifteen (15) days in arrears, to cover the extra expense involved in handling delinquent payments.

If the total of the payments made by the Morigagor under subsection (a) of the preceding paragraph shall exceed the amount of the payments actually made by the Morigagee for ground rents, taxes, and assessments, or insurance premiums, as the case may be, such excess, if the loan is current, at the option of the Morigagor, whall be credited on subsequent payments to be made by the Mortgagor, or refunded to the Mortgagor. If, however, the monthly payments made by the Mortgagor under subsection (a) of the preceding paragraph shall not be sufficient to pay ground rents. taxes, and assessments, or insurance premiums, as the case may be, when the same shall become due and payable, then the Morigagor shall pay to the Morigagee any amount necessary to make up the deficiency, on or before the date when payment of such ground rents, taxes, assessments, or insurance premiums shall be due.
