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ASSUMPTION RIDER

- Funding Fre. If the assumer fails to pay 'his fee at the time of transfer, the fee shall constitute an additional Lebt to that already secured by this instrument, shall bear interest at the rate herein provided, and, at the option of the payee of the indebtruness hereby secured or any transferee thereof, shall be immediately due and payable. This fee is automatically waived if the assumer is exempt under the provisions of 38 U.S.C. 1829 (b)."
- b. Processing Charge. "Upon polication for approval to allow assumption of this loan, a processing for may be charged by the loan holder or its authorized agent for determining the creditworthiness of the assumer and subsequently revising the holder's ownership records when an approved transfer is completed. The amount of this charge shall not exceed the maximum established by the Veterans' Administration for a loan to which section 1817A of Chapter 37, title 37, United States Code applies."
- c. Indemnity Liability. "If this obligation is assumed, then the assumer hereby agrees to assume all of the obligations of the veteran under the terms of the instruments creating and securing the loan, including the obligation of the veteran to indemnify the Veterans Administration to the extent of any claim payment arising from the guaranty or insurance of the indebtedness created by this instrument."

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above-described premises, with the appurtenances and fixtures, unto the said Mortgages, its successors and assigns, forever, for the purpose and uses herein set forth, free from all rights and benefits under and by virtue of the Homestead Exemption Laws of the State of Illinois, which said rights and benefits the said Mortgager does hereby expressly release and waive.

AND SAID MORTGASOR covenants and agrees:

Said note or notes shall be secured hereby on a parity with and as fully as if the advance evidenced thereby were included in the note first described above. Said supplemental note or notes shall bear interest at the rate provided for in the principal indebtedness and shall be payable in agreezimately equal monthly payments for such period as may be agreed upon by the creditor and debter. Failing to agree on the maturity, the whole of the sum or sums so advanced shall be due and payable thirty (30) days after demand by the creditor. It is expressly provided, however (all other provisions of this mortgage to the contrary notwithstanding), that the Mortgagee shall not be required nor shall it have the right to pay, discharge, or remote any tax, assessment, or tax lien upon or against the premises described herein or any part thereof or the improvements situated thereon, so long as the Mortgagor shall, in good faith, contest the same or the validity thereof by appropriate legal proceedings brought in a court of competent jurisdiction, which shall operate to prevent the collection of the tax, assessments, or lien so contested and the sale or forfeiture of the said premises or any part thereof to satisfy the same.

AND the said Mortgagor further covenants and agrees as follows:

Privilege is reserved to prepay at any time, without premium or fee, the entire indebtedness or any part thereof not less than the amount of one installment, or one hundred deflars (\$100.00), whichever is less. Prepayment in full shall be credited on the date received. Partial prepayment, other than on an installment due date, need not be credited until the next following due date or thirty days after such prepayment, whichever is earlier.

Together with, and in addition to, the monthly payments of principal and interest payable under the terms of the note secured hereby, the Mortgager will pay to the Mortgager as Trustee under the terms of this trust as bereinafter stated, on the first day of each month until the said note is fully paid, the following sums:

(a) A sum equal to the ground rents, if any, next due, plus the premiums that will next become due and payable on policies of fire and other hazard insurance covering the mortgaged property, plus taxes and assessments next due on the mortgaged property (all as estimated by the Mortgagee, and of which the Mortgagor is notified) less all sums already paid therefor divided by the number of months to elapse before one month prior to the date when such ground rents, premiums, taxes and assessments will become delinquent, such sums to be held by Mortgagee in trust to pay said ground

rents, premiums, taxes and assessments.

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- (b) 'The aggregate of the amounts payable pursuant to the subparagraph (a) and those payable on the note secured hereby, shall be paid in a single payment each month, to be applied to the following items in the order stated:
 - I. ground rents, if any, taxes, assessments, fire, and other hazard insurance premiums;
 - II. Interest on the note secured hereby; and
 - III. amortization of the principal of the said note.

Any deficiency in the amount of any such aggregate monthly payment shall, unless made good prior to the due date of the next payment, constitute an event of default under this Mortgage. At Mortgage's option, Mortgager will pay a "late charge" not exceeding four per centum (4%) of any installment when paid more than fifteen (15) days after the due date thereof to cover the extra expense involved in handling delinquent payments, but such "late charge" shall not be payable out of the proceeds of any sale made to satisfy the indebtedness secured hereby, unless such proceeds are sufficient to discharge the entire indebtedness and all proper costs and expenses secured hereby.

If the total of the payments made by the Mortgagor under subparagraph (a) of the preceding paragraph shall exceed the amount of payments actually made by the Mortgagee as Trustee for ground rents, taxes, and assessments, or insurance premiums, as the case may be, such excess shall be credited on subsequent payments to be made by the Mortgagor for such items or, at the Mortgagoe's option as Trustee, shall be refunded to the Mortgagor. If however, such monthly payments shall not be sufficient to pay such items when the same shall become dosand payable, the Mortgagor shall pay to the Mortgagee as Trustee any amount necessary to make up the deliziency. Such payments shall be made within thirty (30) days after written notice from the Mortgagee staticg the amount of the deficiency, which notice may be given by mail. If at any time the Mortgagor shall tender to the Mortgagoe, in accordance with the provisions of the note secured hereby, full payment of the entire in sebtedness represented thereby, the Mortgagee as Trustee shall, in computing the amount of such indebted one redit to the account of the Mortgagor any credit balance remaining under the provisions of subparagraph (e) of the preceding paragraph. If there shall be a default under any of the provisions of this mortgage, resulting in a public sale of the premises covered hereby, or if the Mortgagee acquires the property otherwise after difficult, the Mortgagee as Trustee shall apply, at the time of the commencement of such proceedings or at the time the property is otherwise acquired, the amount then remaining to credit of Mortgagor under said subparrigraph (a) as a credit on the interest accrued and unpaid and the balance to the principal then remaining unpaid under said note.

All insurance shall be carried in companies approved by the Mortgagee and the policies and renewals thereof shall be held by the Mortgagee and have attached thereto loss vayable clauses in favor of and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee.
