

C. The Petitioner is awarded the marital residence located at 10046 South Peoria, Chicago, Illinois, as her sole property. The Respondent is awarded him one-half interest in the residence located at 53 West 103rd Place, Chicago, Illinois, as his sole property.

D. The parties shall retain the personal property currently in their respective possessions, including any and all motor vehicles.

E. The Respondent shall pay to the Petitioner the sum of Two Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$280.00) semi-monthly as and for child support. Said sum represents Forty Percent (40%) of the Respondent's net semi-monthly pay. Said child support shall be reduced to Twenty-Seven Percent (27%) when Matthias and Matthew become 18 years of age, and to Twenty Percent (20%) of the Respondent's net income when Marilyn attains the age of 18.

F. The Respondent shall pay to the Petitioner the sum of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) per month for Petitioner's expense in obtaining health insurance for the minor children.

G. The Respondent shall pay to the Petitioner the sum of Four Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$470.00) representing the amount of temporary support ordered May 7, 1985.

H. The Respondent shall pay to the Petitioner the sum of Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) as and for her attorney's fees incurred in connection with prosecution of this action.

I. The Respondent is hereafter barred from seeking maintenance from the Petitioner. The issue of maintenance to the Petitioner is reserved.

In the event a child shall remain in the home of one of the parties while attending college, the other party shall be responsible for one-half of the reasonable value of such room and board. This obligation shall continue until each child is twenty-two years of age or has completed four continuous years of college, whichever comes first.

L. The Petitioner shall be responsible for the minor children's ordinary medical expenses, and the Respondent shall be responsible for the children's extraordinary medical expenses.

M. The Petitioner and Respondent shall carry out all of the terms, provisions and conditions of this Judgment, and each party shall execute any documents and do any act necessary to vest title in the other and otherwise to carry out the terms of this Judgment.

N. This Court reserves jurisdiction of the subject matter of the case and the parties for purpose of enforcing the terms of this Judgment.
