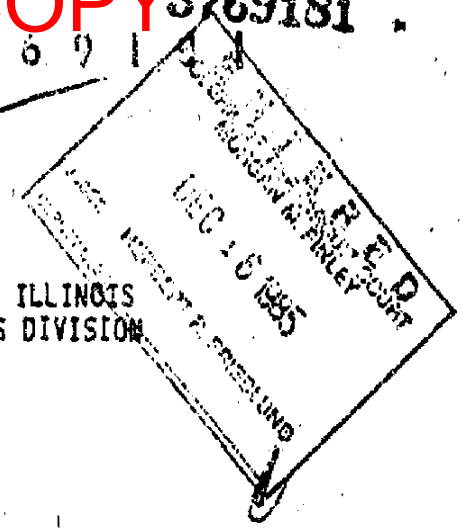

HILL, by and through her attorneys; the law firm of BRUNDAGE & WELCH, the Defendant having been served by publication pursuant to statute and having been held in default for failure to appear or plead, the Court having taken testimony in open Court in support of the verified Petition filed herein, a certificate of which evidence having been ordered to be filed herein within 21 days, and the Court being fully advised in the premises;

FINDS:

1. That the Court has jurisdiction of the Parties and the subject matter.
2. That one of the Parties was residing in the State of Illinois at the time of the filing of the verified Petition for Dissolution herein, and said residency has been maintained continuously for ninety (90) days next preceding the making of the findings herein.

3. That the Parties were lawfully married on May 31, 1958, and said marriage was registered at South Mill, North Carolina.

4. That the Plaintiff, CHRISTINE A. HILL is presently residing in Chicago, Illinois, and is employed as a licensed practical nurse, and is self-supporting.

5. That the Defendant, JACOB D. HILL is presently residing at an address unknown to CHRISTINE A. HILL.

6. That the following children were born to or adopted by the Parties, to wit: ROSLYN, age 30; SHELIA, age 27; both the natural children of CHRISTINE A. HILL and adopted by JACOB D. HILL; SUMNER, age 26, born September 18, 1958; YOLANDA, age 25, born July 20, 1962; DANIEL, age 21, born May 27, 1984; and BETTINA, age 19, born April 8, 1966; said children are now adults and emancipated. That, upon information and belief of CHRISTINE A. HILL, no other children were born to or adopted by the Parties, and none are expected.

7. That the Parties have lived separate and apart since February 15, 1978, for a continuous period of not less than two years, and irreconcilable differences have caused the irretrievable breakdown of their marriage.

8. That the Parties acquired in joint tenancy during the course of the marriage the real property commonly known as 5039 West Kamerling, Chicago, Illinois, which is legally described as follows:

A. That the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Plaintiff, CHRISTINE A. HILL and the Defendant, JACOB D. HILL be dissolved, and the marriage is accordingly dissolved as to both Parties.

B. That CHRISTINE A. HILL is awarded the personal property in her possession in the State of Illinois as her sole and separate property.

C. That CHRISTINE A. HILL be awarded the real property described in paragraph 8, free of any claim by JACOB D. HILL.

D. That the Court reserves all other issues until personal jurisdiction is obtained over the Defendant.

E. That this is a final judgment, and there is no just reason for delaying enforcement or appeal.

F. That the Court retains jurisdiction for the purposes of enforcing this Judgment.

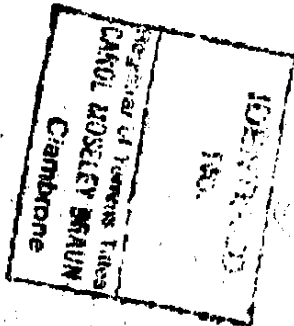
