MORTGAGE

THIS INDENTURE, made as of this 157% of 1989, by and between CHICAGO TITLE AND TRUST COMPANY as Trustee, under Trust Agreement dated August 15, 1985 and known as Trust No. 1067323 and by VERDIE L. BRACY aka VERDIE BRACY, a widow and BARBARA A. BRACY, A SPINSTER ; HOMER A. BRACY and MARY L. BRACY, his wife; and BONNIE C. BRACY and SADIE M. BRACY, his wife (hereinafter referred to as the "Mortgagor"), and SEAWAY NATIONAL BANK OF CHICAGO, a National Banking Association, (hereinafter referred to as the "Mortgagee") having an office at 645 East 87th Street, Chicago, Illinois.

WITNESSETH:

Mortgagor is justly inclebted to Mortgagee in the principal sum of TWO HUNDRED DIGHTY SEVEN THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$287,390.00) DOLLARS evidenced by a certain Mortgage Note (the "Note", of even date herewith in that amount, made by Mortgagor and payable to the order of and celivered to Mortgagee, in and by which said Mote, Mortgagor promises to may the said principal sum and interest thereon in the manner and at the rates as provided therein. The propaid principal amount and all accrued and unpaid interest due under the Mote, if not sooner paid, shall be due on the Maturity bace as defined under the Note. All such payments on account of the indettedness evidenced by the Note shall be paid at such place as the holder of the Note may from time to time in writing appoint. In the absence of such appointment, all amounts due under the Note and this mortgage shall be paid at the office of Mortgagee, 615 E. 87th Street, Chicago, Illinois 60619.

MOW THEREFORE, Mortgagor to secure: (i) the payment of said principal sum of money and said interest in accordance with the terms, provisions and limitations of this Mortgage and of the Note secured horeby, together with any extensions, renewals or refinancings thereot; (ii) the performance and observance of the covenants, conditions and agreements contained in the Note, this Mortgage and the Coan Documents (as hereinafter defined); (iii) the reimbursement of Mortgagee for any and all sums expended or advanced by Mortgagee pursuant to any term or provision of any Additional Indebtweness secured by this Mortgage or any of the Loan Documents with interest thereon as provided in herein or therein.

In consideration of the sum of TEN (\$10.(0) DOLLARS in hand paid, the receipt whereof is herely acknowledged, Mortgagor does by these presents MORTGAGE, GRANT REMISE, RELEASE AND CONVEY unto Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the real estate and all of its estate, right, title and interest therein situated, located in Cook County, Illinois and legally described in Exhibit A stucked hereto and made a part hereof (the "Land"), which together with the property hereinafter described is referred to herein as the "Premises".

TOGETHER WITH all buildings, structures and improvements of every nature whatsoever now or hereafter situated on the Land and all fixtures, machi exy, appliances, equipment, furniture, and personal property including but not limited to the items of colluteral ("colluteral") listed on Exhibit B, of every nature whatsoever now or hereafter owned by Mortgagor and located in, on or attached to, used or intended to be used in connection with the operation of the Land, buildings, structures or other improvements, or in connection with any construction being conducted or which may be conducted thereon and owned by Mortgagor, including all extensions, additions, improvements, betterments, renewals, substitutions and replacements to any of the foregoing and all of the right, title and interest of Mortgagor in and to any such personal property or

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fixtures together with the benefit of any deposit or payments now or hereafter made on such personal property or fixtures by Mortgagor or on its behalf (the "Improvements");

TOGETHER WITH all easements, rights of way, gones of land streets, ways, alleys, passages, sewer rights, waters, water courses, water rights and powers and all estates, hered taments and appurtenances whatsoever in any way belonging, relating or appertaining to the Land or which hereafter shall in any way belong, rel te or be appurtenant thereto, whether now owned or hereafter acquired by Mortgager, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof, and all the estate, right, title, interest, property possession, claim and demand whatsoever, at law as well as in equity of Mortgager of in and to the same;

TOGETHER WITH all rents, royalties, issues, profit: revenue, income and other benefits from the Premises to be applied against the indebtodness hereby secured; provided, however, that permission it horeby given to Mortgagor so long as no Event of Default has occurred hereunder, to collect, receive take, use and enjoy such rents, royalties, issues, profits revenue, income and other benefits as they become due and payable, but not more than one (1) month in advance thereof;

TOGETHER WITH all rights, title and interest of Mortgagor in and to any and all leaves now or hereafter on or affecting the Premises whether written or oral and all agreements for use of the Premisus, together with all security therefor and all monies payable thereunder, subject however to the conditional permission bareinahove given to Mortgagor to collect the rentals under any such lease;

now or hereafter owned by Morigigor and forming a part of or used in connection with the Land or the Improvements or the operation thereof, including, but without limitation, any and all air conditioners, antennae, appliances, apparatus, awnings, basins, bathtubs, bidets, bollors, bookcases tabinets, carpets, coolers, curtains, Cshumidifiars, disposals, cors, drapes, dryers, ducts, dynamos, glevators, engines, equipment, escalators, fans, fittings, floor coverings, firmaces, furnishings, furniture, hardware, heaters, humidifiers, inclusivers, lighting, machings, bacreational facilities, refrigerators, screens, security systems, shades, shelving, sinks, sprinklets, stokers, stoves, toilets, ventilators, wall coverings, washaze, windows, window coverings, wiring, and all renewals or replacements thereof or articles in substitution therefor, whether or not the same are or shall be attached to the Land or the Improvements in any manner. It is mutually agreed that all of the aforesaid property owned by Mortgagor and placed on the Land or the Improvements shall, so far as permitted by law, be deemed to be fixtures, a part of the realty, and security for the indebtedness hereby socured. Notwithstanting the agreement and declaration hereinabove expressed that certain articles of property form a part of the realty cowered by this Mortgage and be appropriated to its use and deemed to be realty, to the extent that such agreement and declaration may not be effective and that any of said articles may constitute goods (as said term is used in the Uniform Commercial Code), this instrument shall constitute a security agreement, creating a security incerest in such goods, as better, all in accordance with said Uniform Commercial Code; and

TOGETHER WITH all proceeds of the foregoing, including without limitation all judgments, awards of damages and settlements hereafter made resulting from condemnation proceeds or the taking of the Premises or any portion thereof under the power of eminent domain, any proceeds of any policies of

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insurance, maintained with respect to the Premises or proceeds of any sale, option or contract to sell the Premises or any portion thereof; and Mortgagor hereby authorizes, directs and empowers, Mortgagee, at its option, on behalf of Mortgagor, or to collect and receive such proceeds, to give proper receipts and acquittances thersfor, and after deducting expenses of collection, to apply the net proceeds as a credit upon any portion, as selected by Mortgagee, of the indebtedness hereby secured, notwithstanding the fact that the same may not then be due and payable or that the indebtedness hereby secured is otherwise adequately secured. All of the Land, estate and property hereinabove described real, passonal and mixed, whether affixed or annexed (except where otherwise horeinabove specified) and all rights hereby conveyed and mortgaged are intended so to be as a unit and are hereby understood, agreed and declared, to the maximum extent permitted by law, to form a part and parcel of the real estate and to be appropriated to the use of the real estate and shall for the purposes of this Mortgage be deemed real citate and conveyed and mortgaged hereby.

TO MAVE AND TO HOLD the Premises unto the said Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, forever, for the purposes and uses herein set with.

PROVIDED NEVERTHELESS, that if Mortgagor shall pay in full when due the indebtedress hereby secured and shall duly and timely perform and observe all of the terms, provisions, covenants and agraements herein and in the Note and the Loun Documents provided to be performed and observed by the Mortgagor or its beneficiaries, then this Mortgage and the estate, right and interest of Mortgages in the Premises shall cease and become void and of no effect, but shall otherwise remain in full force and offect.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT:

i. Title.

Mortgagor represents to and covenants with Mortgages that (a) Mortgagor holds fee simple title to the Premises, free and clear of all liens and encumbrances, except the 'Permitted Exceptions' set firth on Exhibit B attached hereto and made a part hereof and other liens and encumbrances as shall have been expressly approved in writing by Mortgages and (b) Mortgagor has legal power and authority to mortgage (with a wavier of the right of redemption) and convey the Premises.

2. Maintenance, Mapair and Restoration of Improvements, Payments of Prior Liens, etc.

Mortgagor shall (a) promptly repair, restore of rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hersefter on the Premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (b) keep the Premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from magnanics' liens or other liens or claims for lien, except that Martgagor shall have the right within fifteen (25) days after the filing thereof (1) to place a bond with Mortgagee in an amount, form, content and issued by a surety reasonably acceptable to Mortgagee for the payment of any such lien or (2) to cause the title company which has issued the loan policy of title insurance to Mortgagee insuring the lien of this Mortgage to issue an endortement thereto insuring against loss or damage on account of any such lien; (c) subject to the provisions of subparagraph (b) above, immediately pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the Premises superior to, of equal priority with or inferior to the lien hereof (no such superior, equal or inferior lien is to be permitted hereunder), and upon request swhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of any such lien to Mortgagee; (d) complete within a reasonable time any improvements now or at any time in process of construction upon

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the Premises; (a) comply with all requirements of law, municipal ordinances and restrictions of record with respect to the Premises and the use and development thereof, including without limitation, those relating to building, zoning, environmental protection, health, fire and safety; (f) make no structural or non-structural alterations to the Premises without the prior written consent of Mortgagee; (g) suffer or permit no devolition of the Premises and no change in the general nature of the occupancy of the Premises without the prior written consent of Mortgagee; (h) initiate or acquiesce in no zoning reclassification without the prior written consent of Mortgagee; and (i) pay each item of Indebtedness secured by this Mortgage when due according to the terms hereof or of the Note. As used in this paragraph and elsewhere in this Mortgage, the term "Indebtedness" shall mean and include the principal sum evidenced by the Note, together with all interest thereon, Additional Indebtedness, accrued interest thereon all other amounts payable to Hortgage thereunder, and all other sums at any time secured by this Mortgage.

3. Payrent of Taxes and Assessments.

Mortgagor shall pay before any penalty or interest attaches all general and special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges and all other liens or charges levied or assessed against the Premises of any nature whatsoever when due and Mortgagor shall furnish to Mortgagee duplicate receipts of payment therefor. If any special assessment is permitted by applicable law to be paid in installments, Mortgagor shall have the right to pay such assessment in installments, so long as all such installments are paid prior to the due date thereof. In the event of a dispute as to the amount of taxes owed, Mortgagor shall pay such tax or assessment in full under protest in order to prevent a default under this Mortgage on account thereof.

4. Tax Deposits.

The Mortgagee may request Mortgagor to deposit with its monthly Principal and Interest payment as provided for in the Note a sum equal to one-twelfth (1'17th) of the annual takes and assessments (general and special) on the Premises (unless said takes are based upon assessments which exclude the improvements thereof now constructed or to be constructed, in which event the amount of such deposite shall be based upon Mortgagee's reasonable estimate as to the amount of take and assessments to be levied and assessed). Immediately following an Event of Default (as hereinafter defined), Mortgagor shall deposit with Mortgagee an amount of money, when together with the aggregate of the monthly deposits to be made pursuant to the above as of one month prior to the date on which the total annual taxes and assessments for the current calendar year become due, shall be sufficient to pay in full the total annual taxes and assessments estimated by Mortgagee 'c become due and pureble with respect to the Premises for the current calendar year. Such deposits are to be held without any allowance of interest and are to be used for the payment of taxes and assessments (general and special), respectively, on the Premises next due and payable when they become due.

Mortgagee may, at its option, pay such taxes and assessments when the same become due and payable (upon submission of appropriate bills therefor from Mortgagor) or shall release sufficient funds to Mortgagor for payment of such taxes and assessments. If funds so deposited are insufficient to pay any such taxes and assessments (general or special) for any year when the same shall become due and payable, Mortgagor shall within ten (10) days after receipt of demand therefor, deposit additional funds as may be necessary to pay such taxes and assessments (general and special) in full. If the funds so deposited exceed

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the amount required to pay such taxes and assessments (general and special) for any year, the excess shall and special) for any year, the excess shall are be applied on a subsequent deposit or deposits. Said deposits need not be kept separate and apart from any other funds of Mortgages and Mortgagor shall not be entitled to the payment of interest thereon. Anything in this Paragraph 4 to the contrary notwithstanding, if the funds so deposited are insufficient to pay any such taxes and assessments (general or special) or any installment thereof, Mortgagor will, not later than the thirtieth (30th) day prior to the last day on which the same may be paid without penalty or interest, deposit with Mortgagee the full amount of any such deficiency.

5. Mort cages's Interest In and Use of Deposit.

In the event of a default in any of the provisions contained in this Mortgage or the Note secured hereby, the Mortgagee may at its option, without being required so to do, apply any monies at the time on deposit pursuant to Paragraph 4 hereof, on any of Mortgager's obligations herein or in the Note contained, in such order and manner as Mortgagee may elect. When the indebtedness secured raraby has been fully paid, any remaining deposits shall be paid in Mortgager. Such deposits are hereby pledged as additional returity for the indebtedness hereunder and shall be irrevocably applied by Mortgagee for the purposes for which are made hereunder and shall not be subject to the direction or control of Mortgager; provided, however, that Mortgages shall not be liable for any failure to apply to the payment of taxes, assessments and insurance premiums any amount so deposited unless Mortgager, while not in default hereunder, shall have requested Mortgages in writing to make application of such funds to the payment of which they were deposited, accompanied by the bills for such taxes, assessments and insurance premiums. Mortgagee shall not be liable for any act or omission taken in good faith or pursuant to the instruction of any party.

6. <u>Insurance.</u>

Mortgagor shall at all times keep all Improvements, including buildings, site improvements, fixtures and articles of personal property now or hereafter situated on the Premises insured against loss or damage by fire and such other hizards as may reasonably be required by Mortgage, including without limitations (a) all-risk fire and extended coverage insurance, with vandalism and malicious mischief endorsements for the full replacement value of the Premises, in an agreed amount, with inflation guard endorsement; (b) if there are tenants under leases at the Premises, rent or business loss insurance for the same perils described in (a) above payable at the rate per month and for the period specified from time to time by Mortgages; (c) boiler and sprinkler damage insurence in an amount reasonably satisfactory to Mortgagee, if and so long as the Premises shall contain a boiler and sprinkler system, respectively; (d) if the Premises are located in a flood hazard district, flood insurance whenever in the opinion of Mortgagee such protection is necessary and available; and (e) such other insurance as Mortgagee may from time to time reasonably require. Mortgagor also shall at all times maintain comprehensive public liability, property damage and workmen's compensation insurance covering the Premises and any employees thereof, with such limits for personal injury, death and property damage as Mortgagee may from time to time reasonably require. All policies of insurance to be furnished hereunder shall be in forms, companies, amounts and deductibles reasonably satisfactory to Mortgagee, with mortgage clauses attached to all policies in favor of and in form satisfactory to Mortgagee, including a provision requiring that the coverage evidenced thereby shall not be terminated or modified without thirty (30) days' prior written notice to Mortgagee. Mortgagor shall deliver all policies, including additional and renewal policies, to Mortgagea, and, in the case of insurance about to

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expire, shall deliver renewal policies not less than thirty (30) days prior to their respective dates of expiration.

Mortgagor shall not take out separate insurance concurrent in form or contributing in the event of loss with that required to be maintained herounder unless Mortgages is included thereon under a standard mortgage clause acceptable to Mortgages. Mortgagor shall immediately nourly Mortgages whenever any such separate insurance is taken out and shall promptly deliver to Mortgages the policy or policies of such insurance.

In the event of loss Mortgagor will give immediate notice by mail to Mortgagee, who may make proof of loss if not made promptly by Mortgagor, and each insurance company concerned is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for such loss directly to Mortgagee instead of to Mortgagor and Mortgagee jointly, and the insurance proceeds, or any part thereof, shall be applied by Mortgagee to the restoration or repair of the propercy damaged as provided in Paragraph 21 hereof. In the event of foreclosure of this Mortgage, all rights, title and interest of Mortgagor in and to any insurance policies then in force shall pass to the purchaser at the foreclosure sale. Mortgagor chall furnish Mortgagee, without cost to Mortgagee, at the request of Mortgagee, from time to time, evidence of the replacement value of the Premises.

7. Cordennation.

If all or any part of the Premises are damaged, taken or acquired, either temperarily or paramently, in any condomnation proceeding, or by exercise of the right of eminent domain, the amount of any award or other payment for such taking or damages made in consideration therato, to the extent of the full amount of the remaining unpaid indebtedness secured by this instrument, is hereby assigned to Mortgager, who is empowered to collect and receive the name and to give proper receipts therefor in the name of Mortgagor and the sale shall be paid forthwith to Mortgage, who shall release any such award or monies no received or apply the same in whole or in part, there is no received or apply the same in whole or in part, there the payment of all of its expenses, including reasonable costs and attorneys' fees, to the restoration or repair of the property damaged as provided in Paragraph 22 hereof, if the property car be restored or repaired to constitute a complete architectural unit, then such award or monies received after the payment of expenses of Mortgagee as aforesaid shall be applied on account of the unpaid principal balance of the Note, irrespective of whether such principal damage is then due and payable. Furthermore, in the event such award or monies so received shall exceed the cost of restoration or repair of the property and expenses of Mortgagee as aforesaid, then such excess monies shall be applied on account of the unpaid principal balance of the Note, irrespective of viether such principal balance is then due and payable.

8. Stamp Tax.

If by the laws of the United States of America, or of any state or political subdivision having jurisdiction over Mortgager, any tax is due or becomes due in respect of the execution and delivery of this Mortgage or the issuance of the Note hereby secured, Mortgager covenants and agrees to pay such tax in the manner required by any such law. Mortgager further covenants to reimburse Mortgages for any sums which Mortgages may expend by reason of the imposition of any tax on the issuance of the Note secured hereby.

9. Pffect of Extensions of Time.

If the payment of said indebtedness or any part thereof be extended or varied or if any part of any security for the payment of the indebtedness be released, all persons now or at any time

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hereafter liable therefor, or interested in the Premises, shall be held to assent to such extension, variation or release, and their liability and the lien and all provisions hereof shall continue in full force, the right of recourse against all such persons being expressly reserved by Mortgagee, notwithstanding such extension, variation or release.

10. Effect of Changes in Laws Regarding Taxation.

In the event of the enactment after this date of any law of the state in which the Premises are located deducting from the value of the land for the purpose of taxation any lien thereon, or imposing upon Mortgagee the payment of the whole or any part of the taxes or assessments or charges or liens herein required to be paid by Mortgagor, or changing in any way the laws relating to the texation of mortgages or debts secured by mortgages or Mortgagee's interest in the Premiser, or the manner of collection of taxes, so as to affect this Mortgage ox the debt secured hereby or the holders thereof, then, and in any event, Mortgagor, upon derand by Mortgagee, shall pay such taxes or assessments, or reimbure. Mortgagee therefor; provided, however, that Mortgagor shall not be deemed to be required to pay any income or franchise taxes of lawtgagee. Not withstanding the foregoing, if in the opinion of counsel for Mortgages (a) it might be unlawful to require Mortgagor to make such payment or (b) the making of such payment might result in the imposition of interest beyond the maximum amount permitted by law, then and in such event, Mortgages can elect, by notice in writing given to Mortgagor, to declare all of the indebtedness secured hereby to be and become due and payable sixty (60) days from the giving of such notice.

11. Mortgagee's Performance of Default Acts.

In case of default herein. Mortgagee may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act herein required of Mortgagor in any form and manner deemed expedient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sain or forfeiture affecting the Premises or consent to any tax or assessment or cure any default of Mortgagor in any lease of the Premise. All monies paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including reasonable atterneys' iees and any other monies advanced by Mortgagee in regard to any tax referred to in paragraph 8 or to protect the Premises or the lien heroof, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby, and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at the rate then in effect under the Note. The interest under this Paragraph II shall be immediately due and payable by Mortgagor to Mortgagee, and shall be indebtedness evidenced by the Note and secured by this Mortgage. An action of Mortgagee shall never be considered as a waiver of any right accruing to it on account of any infault on the part of Mortgagor. Should the proceeds of the Note or any part thereof, or any amount paid out or advanced by Mortgagoe hereunder, or pursuant to any agreement executed by Mortgagoe in connection with this Loan be used directly or indirectly to pay off, discharge or satisfy, in whole or in part, any lien or encumbrance upon the Premises or any part thereof, then as additional security hereunder, the Mortgagee shall be subrogated to any and all rights, equal or superior titles, liens and equities, owned or claimed by any owner or holder of said outstanding liens, charges and indebtedness, however remote, regardless of whether said liens, charges and indebtedness are acquired by assignment or have been released or recor

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12. Mortgagee's Reliance on Tax Bills and Claims for Lions.

Mortgages in making any payment hereby suthorised: (a) relating to taxes and assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or title or claim thereof; or (b) for the purchase, discharge, compromise or settlement of any other prior lien, may do so without inquiry as to the validity or amount of any claim for lien which may be asserted, provided that Mortgages shall give to Mortgagor five (5) days prior written notice thereof.

13. Acceleration of Indebtedness in Event of Default.

Each of the following shall constitute an "Event of Default" for purposes of this Mortgage:

- (a) Nortgagor fails to pay when dum any payment of Additional Indebtedness payable pursuant to the Note or this Mortgage;
- (b) Nortgagor fails to pay ten (10) days after same becomes due any principal installment of principal and interest payable pursuant to the Note;
- (c) Mortgage, fails to promptly perform or cause to be performed any other obligation or observe any other condition, covenant, term, agreement or provision required to be performed or observed by Mortgagor under (i) the Note and (ii) this Mortgage, of even date herewith made by Mortgagor to Mortgages, (the documents described in sections (i) through (ii) above, both inclusive, being hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Loan Documents"); provided, however, that unless and until the continued operation or safety of the Premises, or the priority, validity or enforceability of this Mortgage or the lien hereof or the lien of any other security granted to Mortgagee or the value of the Premises is immediately threatened or jeopardized, Mortgagor shall have a period not to exceed thirty (30) days after written notice of such failure of performance or observance to cure the same;
- (d) Any material inaccuracy or untruth in any representation, covenant or warrenty made in this Mortgage or any of the other Loan Documents by Mortgagor, or of any statement or contification as to facts delivered to Mortgagee pursuant to the Loan Documents;
- (e) The death or legal incompetency of Mortgagor;
- (f) At any time, Mortgagor, files at any time a voluntary petition in bankruptcy or is adjudicated a bankrupt or insolvent or files any petition or answer seeking any reorganization, arrangement, composition, readjustment, liquidation, dissolution or similar relief under the present or any future Federal, State, or other statute or law, or seeks or consents to or acquiesces in the appointment of any trustee, receiver or similar officer of Mortgagor, for all or any substantial part of the property of Mortgagor for any of the Premises;
- (g) The commencement of an involuntary petition in bankruptcy against Mortgagor or the institution against Mortgagor, of any reorganization, marrangement, composition, readjustment, dissolution, liquidation or similar proceedings under any present or future

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Pederal, State or other statute or law, or the appointment of a receiver, trustee or similar officer for all or any substantial part of the property of Mortgagor, which shall remain undismissed or undischarged for a period of ninety (90) days; or

(h) The occurrence of any "Default" including any "Prohibited Transfer" (as defined in the "DUE ON SALE" clause of the Note).

If an Event or Default occurs, Mortgagee may, at its option, declare the whole of the injebtedness hereby secured to be immediately due and payable without notice to Mortgagor, with interest thereon from the date of such Event of Default at the Default Interest Rate (and defined in the Note). If while any insurance proceeds or condemnation awards are being held by Mortgagee to reimburse Mortgagor for the cost of rebuilding or restoration of buildings or improvements on the Premises, as set forth in Paragraph 21 hereof, Mortgagee shall be or become entitled to, and shall accelerate the indebtedness secured hereby, then and in such event, Mortgagee shall be entitled to apply all such insurance proceeds and condemnation awards then held by it in reduction of the indebtedness hereby secured and any excess held by it over the amount of indebtedness then due hareunder shall be returned to Mortgagor or any party entitled thereto without interest.

14. Pareclow vor Expense of Litigation.

when the indebtedness hereby secured, or any part thereof, shall become due, whether by acceleration or otherwise, Mortgagee shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof for such indebtedness or part thereof. In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Mortgagee for reasonable attorneys' fees, appraisars' fees, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographers' charges, publication costs, and costs (which may be estimated procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches and examinations, title insurance policies, and similar data and assurances with respect to the title as Mortgagee may down reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such docree the true condition of the title to or the value of the Fremises. All expenditures and expenses and fees as may be incurred in the enforcement of Mortgager's obligations hereunder, the protection of said Premiser and the maintenance of the lien of this Mortgage, including the reasonable fees of any attorney employed by Mortgagee in any litigation or proceeding affecting this Mortgage, the Note, or the Premises, including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, or in preparations for the commencement or defense of any proceeding or threatened suit or proceeding shall be immediately due and payable by Mortgagor, with interest thereon at the Default Interest Rate.

15. Application of Proceeds of Foreclosure Sale.

The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the Premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: first, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in Paragraph 14 hereof, second, all other items which may under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the Note, with interest thereon as herein provided and all principal, Additional Indebtedness and interest remaining unpaid on the Note; and third, any surplus to Mortgagor, its successors or assigns, as their rights may appear.

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16. Appointment of Receiver.

Upon, or at any time after the filing of a complaint to foreclose this Mortgage, the court in which such complaint is filed may appoint a receiver of the Fremises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency of Mortgagor at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the then value of the Premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead. Mortgagee hereunder or any holder of the Note may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have power to collect the rents, issues and profits of the Premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and in case of a sale and a deficiency during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further times when Mortgagor, except for the intervention of such receiver would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the Premises during the whole of said period. The court from time to time may authorize the receiver to apply the net income in his hands in payment in whole or in part of:

(a) the indibtedness secured hereby, or by any decree foreclosing this Mortgage, or any tax, special assessment or other lien which have be or become superior to the lien hereof on of such decrea, provided such application is made prior to foreclosure sale; (h) the deficiency in case of a sale and deficiency or (c) both.

17. Mortgagee's Right of Possession in Case of Default.

In any case in which under the provisions of this Mortgage, Mortgagee has a right to institute formclosure precedings, Mortgagee shall forthwith and upon demand of Mortgagee, surrender to Mortgagee and Mortgagee shall be entitled to take actual possession of the Premises or any part thereof personally, or by its agents or attorneys, as for any condition broken. Mortgagee's rights and remedies under this Paragraph 17 shall be effective whether before or after the whole principal sum secored hereby is declared to be immediately due and provided hereunder, or whether before or after the institution of legal proceedings to foreclose the lien hereof or before or after sale thereunder. In the event Mortgagee is entitled to take possession of the premises, Mortgagee in its discretion may, with or without force and with or without process of law, enter upon and take and maintain possession of all or any part of said Premises, together with all documents, books, records, papers and accounts of Mortgager or then owner of the Premises relating thereto, and may exclude Mortgagor, its agents or servants, wholly therefrom. In such case Mortgagee under the powers herein granted, may hold, operate, manage and control the Premises and conduct the business, if any, thereof, either personally or by its agents. Mortgagee shall have full power to use such measures, legal or equitable, as in its discretion may be deemed proper or necessary to enforce the payment or security of the avails, rents, issues, and profits of the Premises, including actions for the recovery of rent, actions, in forcible detainer and actions in distress for rent. Mortgagee shall have full power:

- (a) to cancel or terminate any lease or sublease for any case or on any ground which would entitle Mortgagor to cancel the same;
- (b) to elect to disaffirm any lease or sublease which is then subordinate to the lien hereof;
- (c) to extend or modify any then existing leases and to enter new leases, which extensions, modifications and leases may provide for terms to expire, or for options to lessees to extend or renew terms to expire, beyond the maturity date of the indebtedness secured hereby and beyond the date of the issuance

of a doed or deeds to a purchaser or purchasers at a foreclosure sale, it being understood and agreed that any such leases, and the options or other such provisions to be contained therein, shall be binding upon Mortgager and all persons whose interest in the Premises are subject to the lien hereof and upon the purchaser or purchasers at any foreclosure sale, notwithstanding any redemption from sale, discharge of the mortgage indebtedness, satisfaction of any foreclosure judgment, or issuance of any certificate of sale or deed to any purchaser;

- (d) to make any repairs, renewals, replacements, alterations, additions, betterments and improvements to the Premises as to it may seem judicious;
- (e) to insure and reinsure the same and all risks incidental to Mortgagee's possession, operation and management thereof; and
- (f) to receive all of such avails, rents, issues and profit; hereby granting full power and authority to exercise each and every right, privilege and power herein granted at any and all times hereafter without notice to Mortgagor.

Mortgages shall not be obligated to perform or discharge, nor does it hereby undertake to perform or discharge, any obligation, duty or liability under any leases. To the extent provided by law, Mortgagor shall and does hereby agree to protect, indemnify, defend and hold Mortgagee harmless of and from any and all liability, loss or damage which it may or might incur under said leases or under or by reason of the assignment thereof and of and first any and all claims and demands whatsoever which may be asserted against it by reason of any alleged obligations or undertakings on its part to perform or discharge any of the terms, covenants or agreements contained in said leases except for such claims and demands as result directly from the negligent or willful actions of Mortgagee. Should Mortgages incur any such liability, loss or damage under said leases or under or by reason of the assignment thereof, or in the defense of any claims or demands, the arcent thereof, including costs, expenses and reasonable attorneys fees, shall be secured hereby, and Mortgagor shall reimburse Mortgagor therefor immediately upon demand.

18. Application of Income Received by Mortgagee.

Mortgagee, in the exercise of the rights and powers hereinabove conferred upon it shall have full power to use and apply the avails, rents, issues and profits of the premises to the payment of or on account of the following, in such order as Mortgage may determine:

- (a) to the payment of the operating expensive of said property, including cost of management and leasing thereof (which shall include reasonable compensation to Mortgagee and its agent or agents, if management be delegated to any agent or agents and shall also include lease commissions (but not with respect to the renewal of existing leases unless provided for therein) and other compensation and expenses of seeking and procuring tenants and entering into leases), established claims for damages, if any, and premiums on insurance hereinabove authorized;
- (b) to the payment of taxes and special assessments now due or which may hereafter become due on the Premises. Additionally, if this is a leasehold mortgage, of all rents due or which may become hereafter due under the underlying lease;
- (c) to the payment of all repairs, decorating, renewals, replacements, alterations, additions, betterments, and improvements of the premises, including the cost from time to time of installing or replacement of refrigeration and gas or

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electric stoves therein and of placing the Premises in such condition as will, in the judgment of Mortgagee, make them readily rentable; and

(d) to the payment of any indebtedness secured hereby or any deficiency which may result from any foreclosure sale.

19. Rights Cumulative.

Each right, power and remedy herein conferred upon Mortgages is cumulative and in addition to every other right, power or remedy, express or implied, given now or hereafter existing, at law or in equity, and each and every right, power and remedy herein set forth or otherwise so existing may be exercised from time to time as often and in such order as may be deemed expedient by Mortgages. The exercise of one right, power or remedy shall not be a waiver of the right to exercise at the same time or thereafter any other right, power or remedy. No delay or omission of Mortgages in the exercise of any right, power or remedy accruing hereunder or arising shall impair any such right, power of remedy, or be construed to be a waiver of any default or acquiesce of therein.

20. Maryagee's Right of Inspection.

Mortgages and/or its representative shall have the right to inspect the Premises at all reasonable times and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.

- 21. Disbursement of Insurance or Eminent Domain Proteeds.
- (a) Before commenting to repair, restore or rebuild following damage to or descruction of all or a portion of the Premises, whether by fire or other casualty or by a taking under the power of eximent domain, Mortgagor shall obtain from Mortgages its approval of all site and building plans and specifications pertaining to such repair, restoration or rebuilding.
- (b) Prior to the payment or application of insurance proceeds or condemnation or eminent domain award to the repair or restoration of the Improvements (including site improvements) upon the Premises as provided in Paragraph 6 and 7 hereof, Mortgages shall be entitled to evidence of the following:
 - (i) An Event of Default has not occurred under the Mote or the Loan Documents;
 - (ii) That Mortgages shall first be given reasonably satisfactory proof that either such improvements have been fully restored, or that the expenditure of money as may be received from such insurance proceeds or condemnation award will be sufficient to repair, restore or rebuild the Premises, free and clay of all liens, except the lien of this Mortgage;
 - (iii) That in the event such insurance proceeds or condemnation award shall be insufficient to repair, restore or rebuild the said improvements, Mortgagor or its Lessee(s) shall deposit with Mortgagee funds equaling such deficiency, which, together with the insurance proceeds or condemnation award, shall be sufficient to restore, repair and rebuild the Premises;
 - (iv) That prior to the disbursement of any such proceeds held by Mortgagee in accordance with the terms of this Paragraph 21 for the cost of any repair, restoration or rebuilding, Mortgagee shall be furnished with a statement of Mortgagee's architect, certifying the extent of the repair and restoration completed to

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the date thereof, and such repairs, restoration, and rebuilding have been performed to date in conformity with the plans and specifications approved by Mortgagee and with all statutes, regulations or ordinances (including building and zoning ordinances) affecting the Premises. Mortgagee shall be furnished with appropriate evidence of payment for labor or materials furnished to the Premises and total or partial lien waivers substantiating such payments; and

- (c) Prior to the payment of application of insurance proceeds or a condemnation award for the repair or restoration of the improvements upon the Premises as provided in Paragraph 6 and 7 there shall have been delivered to Mortgagee the following:
 - (i) A waiver of subrogation from any insurer who claims that no liability exists as to Mortgagor or the then owner or other assured under the policy of insurance in question;
 - (ii) Such performance and payment bonds, and such insurance in such amounts, issued by much company or companies and in such forms and substance, as are required by Mortgages.
- (d) In the event Mortgagor shall fail to restore, repair or rebuild the improvements upon the Premises within a reasonable time, Mortgagee, it its option, and upon not less than thirty (30) days' written notice to Mortgagor, may commence to restore, repair or rebuild the said improvements for or on behalf of Mortgagor, and for such purpose, may perform all necessary acts to accomplish such restoration, repair or rebuilding. In the event insurance proceeds or condemnation award shall exceed the amount necessary to complete the repair, restoration or rebuilding of the improvements upon the Premises, such excess shall be applied on account of the unpaid principal balance of the Note irrespective of whether such balance is then due and payable.
- (e) In the event Mortgager commences the repair or rebuilding of the improvements (including site improvements) located on the Premises, but fails to comply with the conditions precedent to the payment or application of insurance proceeds or a condemnation or eminent domain award set forth in this Paragraph 21 or Mortgager shall fail to restore, repair or rebuild the improvements upon the Premises within a reasonable time and if Mortgagee does not restore, repair or rebuild the said improvements as provided in subparagraph (d) above, then Mortgages may, at its option, accelerate the indebtedness evidenced by the Note and apply all or any part of the insurance proceeds or condemnation award against the indebtedness secured hereby.
- 22. Release Upon Payment and Discharge of Kortgagor's Obligations.

Mortgagee shall release this Mortgage and the lien thereof by proper instrument upon payment and discharge of all indebtedness secured hereby, including the payment of reasonable expenses incurred by Mortgagee in connection with the execution of such release.

23. Notices.

Any notice or demand given by United States mail shall be deemed given on the second business day after the same is deposited in the United States mail as registered or certified mail, addressed as above provided with postage thereon fully prepaid.

24. Waiver of Defense.

No action for the enforcement of the lien or of any provision hereof shall be subject to any defense which would not be good and available to the party interposing time in an action at law upon the Note hereby secured.

25. Waiver of Rights.

To the extent permitted by law, Mortgagor shall not and will not apply for or avail itself of any appraisement, valuation, stay, extension or exemption laws, or any so-called "Moratorium Laws," now existing or hereafter enacted, in order to prevent or hinder the enforcement or foreclosure of this Mortgage, but hereby waives the benefit of such laws. To the extent permitted by law, Mortgagor, for itself and all who may claim through or under it, waives any and all right to have the preperty and estates comprising the Premises marshalled upon in any foreclosure of the lien hereof and agrees that any court having jurisdiction to foreclose such lien may order the Premises sold as an entirety.

26. Transfer of Premisos: Further Encumbrance.

28. Business Purpose.

29. Audits.

Without expense to Mortgagee, Mortgagee shall furnish to Mortgagor within one hundred twenty (120) days after the end of each fiscal year of the Mortgagor, an annual audit prepared and certified by an independent certified public accountant reasonably satisfactory to Mortgagee in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles relating to real estate and in substance and form satisfactory to Mortgagea consistently applied with which shall include: (1) a statement of assets and Liabilities of Mortgagor with respect to the Premises; (2) a statement of the source and application of funds by the Mortgagor with respect to the Premises; (3) a detailed profit and loss statement relating to the ownership and operation of the Premises, including, without

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limitation, all ments and other income derived therefrom and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith.

30. Statement of Indebtedness.

Mortgagor, within seven (") days after so requerted by Mortgagee, shall furnish a duly acknowledged written statement setting forth the amount of the debt secured by this Mortgage, the date to which interest has been paid and stating either that no offsets or defense exist against the Mortgage debt or, if such offsets or defenses are alleged to exist, the nature thereof.

31. Further Instruments.

Upon request of Mortgages, Mortgagor will execute, acknowledge and deliver all such additional instruments and further assurances of title and will do or cause to be done all such further acts and things as may reasonably be necessary to fully effectuate the intent of this Mortgage.

32. Indemnify.

Mortgager shall indemnify and save Mortgagee harmless from and against any and all liabilities, obligations, losses, damages, claims, costs and expenses (including reasonable attornays' fees and court costs) of whatever kind or nature which may be imposed or, incurred by or asserted against Mortgagee at any time by any third party which relate to or arise from: (1) the making of the loan evidenced by the Mote and secured by this Mortgage (excluding any and all liabilities, obligations, losses, damages, claims, costs and expense (including reasonable attorneys' fees and court costs) which may be imposed on, incurred by or asserted against Mortgagee which relate to or arise from a violation of any federal banking law(s) or regulation(s) and any other federal law(s) or regulation(s), by Mortgagee); (2) any suit or proceeding (including probate and bankruptcy proceedings), or the threat thereof, in or to which Mortgagee may or does become a party, either as plaintiff or as a defendant, by reason of this Mortgage or for the purpose of protecting the lien of this Mortgage; (3) or the ownership, use, operation or maintenance of the Premises. All costs provided for herein and paid for by Mortgagee chall be so much additional indebtsdness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest at the Default Interest Rate.

33. Waiver of Right of Redemption.

At the written request and direction of Mortjauor, Mortgagor hereby releases and waives any and all rights to retain possession of the Premises after the occurrence of an Event of Default and any and all rights of redemption from sale under any order or decree of foreclosure, pursuant to rights therein granted, on hehalf of Mortgagor, and each and every person (except judgment creditors of Mortgagor in its representative capacity as Trustee of the Trust and the trust estate) acquiring any interest in, or title to, the premises described herein subsequent to the date of this Mortgage, and on behalf of all other persons to the extent permitted by the provisions of Chapter 110, Section 12-125 of the Illinois Revised Statutes.

34. Observance of Lease Assignment.

As additional security for the payment of the Note secured hereby and for the faithful performance of the terms and conditions contained herein, Mortgage and Mortgagox's beneficiaries, as lessor have assigned to Mortgagee all of their right, title and interest as lessor in and to all lesses, occupancy, operation and management agreements (herein, collectively "lease" and individually a "lease") which now or

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heroafter affect the Premises pursuant to the Assignment of Rents and Lessor's Interest in Leases of event date herewith.

Mortgagor will not, without Mortgagee's prior written consent (i) execute an assignment or pledge of any rents and/or any leases affecting all or any portion of the Premises; or (ii) accept any prepayment of any installment of any rents more than thirty (30) days before the due date of such installment, other than recurity and other deposits.

Mortgagor at its sole cost and expense will (i) at all times promptly and faithfully abide by, discharge and perform all leases effecting all or any portion of the Premises, on the part of the lessor thereunder to be kept and performed; (ii) appear in and defend any action or proceeding arising under, growing out of or in any manner connected with such leases or the obligations, duties or liabilities of the lessor or of the lessees thereunder; (iii) as additional security for the payment of the Note secured hereby and for the faithful performance of the terms and conditions contained herein, transfer and assign to Mortgagee any lease or leases of the Premises heretofore or hereafter entered into, and make, execute and deliver to Mortgagee upon demand, any and all involuments required to effectuate said assignment; (iv) give written notice to Mortgagee within five (5) days of the occurrence of the premises; and (vi) exercise within (5) days of any demand therefore by Mortgagee any right to request from the lessee under any lease affecting all or any portion of the premises a certificate with respect to the status thereof.

Mothing in this Mortgage or in any other documents relating to the loan secured hereby shall be construed to obligate Mortgagee, expressly or by implication, to perform any of the covenants of Mortgagor as lessor under any of the leases assigned to Mortgagee or to pay any sum of money or damages therein provided to paid by the lessor, each and all of which covenants and payments Mortgagor agrees to perform and pay.

In the event of the enforcement by Mortgages of the remedies provided for by law or by this Mortgage, the lesses under each lesse affecting all or any portion of the Premises shall, at the option of Mortgages, attorn to any person succeeding to the interest of Mortgages as a result of such inforcement and shall recognize such successor in interest as lessor under such lesse without change in the terms of other provisions thereof; provided, however, that said successor in interest shall not be bound by any payment of rent or additional remains for more than one month in advance or any assendment or modification to any lesse made without the consent of Mortgages or said successor in interest. Each lesses, upon request by said successor in interest, shall execute and deliver an instrument or instruments confirming such attornment.

Mortgagee shall have the option to declare this Mortgage (after the expiration of the cure period expressly provided for in Paragraph 13(b) above) in default because of a default of the lessor in any lease affecting all or any portion of the Premises, whether or not such default is cured by Mortgagee pursuant to the right granted herein. It is covenanted and agreed that a default remaining uncured after the expiration of any applicable cure periods expressly provided for under the Assignment of Rents and Lessor's Interest in Leases referred to in the first grammatical paragraph of this Paragraph 35 or under any assignment of leases executed pursuant to this Paragraph 35 shall constitute a default hereunder on account of which the whole of the indebtedness secured hereby shall at once, at the option of Mortgages, become immediately due and payable without notice to Mortgagor.

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35. Miscelleneous.

(a) Successors and Assigns.

This Mortgage and all provisions hereof shall be binding upon and enforceable against Mortgagor and its permitted successors, grantees and assigns, any subsequent owner or owners of the Premises who acquire the Premises subject to this Mortgage and all persons claiming under or through Mortgagor, and the word "Mortgagor" when used herein shall include all such persons and all persons liable for the payment of the indebtedness or any part thereof, whether or not such persons shall have executed the Note or this Mortgage. This Mortgage and all provisions hereof shall inure to the benefit of Mortgagee, its successors and easigns and any holder or holders, from time to time, of the Mote.

(A) Invalidity of Provisions.

In the event on or more of the provisions contained in this Mortgage or the Note secured hereby or in any security documents given to recure the payment of the Note secured hereby shall for any reason re held to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity, illegality or unenforceability shall at the option of Mortgages, not affect any other provision of this Mortgage, and this Mortgage shall be construed as if such invalid, illegal or unenforceable provision had never been contained herein or therein. This Mortgage and the Note it secures are to be construed and governed by the laws of the State of Illinois.

(c) Municipal and Toning Requirements.

Mortgagor shall not by act or emission permit any building or other improvement or premises not subject to the lien of this Mortgage to rely on the premises or any part thereof or any interest therein to fulfill any municipal or governmental require, and Mortgagor hereby as igns to Mortgages any and all rights to give consent for all or any portion of the Premises or any interest therein to be so used Similarly, no building or other improvement on the Premises shall rely on any premises not subject to the lien of this Mortgage or any interest therein to fulfill any governmental or municipal requirement. Mortgagor shall not by act or omission impair the intagrity of the Premises as a single roning lot separate and apart from all other premises. Any act or omission by Mortgagor which would result in a violation of any of the provisions of this subparagraph shall be void.

(d) Rights of Tenants.

Mortgages shall have the right and option to commence a civil action to foreclose this Mortgage and to obtain a Decree of Foreclosure and Sale subject to the rights of any tenant or tenants of the Premises. The failure to join any such tenant or tenants as party defendant or defendants in any such civil action or the failure of any Decree of Foreclosure and Sale to foreclose their rights shall not be asserted by Mortgagor as a defense in any civil action instituted to collect the indebtedness secured hereby, or any part thereof or any deficiency remaining unpaid after foreclosure and sale of the Premises, any statute or rule of law at any time existing to the contrary notwithstanding.

(e) Option of Mortgages to Subordinate.

At the option of Mortgagee, this Mortgage shall become subject and subordinate, in whole or in part (but not with respect to priority of entitlement to insurance proceeds or any eward in condemnation) to any and all leases of all or any part of the Premises upon the execution by Mortgagee and recording

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thereof, at any time hereafter, in the Office of the Recorder of Desds in and for the county wherein the Premises are situated.

(i) Use of Proceeds.

Mortgagor represents that the proceeds evidenced by the Note secured hereby will not be used for the purchase of registered equity securities within the purview of Regulation G issued by the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System.

(g) Walue for Purpose of Insurance.

Upon request by Mortgagee, Mortgagor agrees to furnish evidence of replacement value, without cost to Mortgagee, of the type which is regularly and ordinarily made for insurance companies, with respect to the buildings and improvements on the Premises.

(A) Mortgages in Possession.

Marigages shell in no event be construed for any purpose to be a partner, joint venturer, agent or associate of Mortgagor, lessee, contact, concessionaire or licensee of Mortgagor in the conduct of their respective businesses.

(i) Time of the Essence.

Time is of the essence of the payment by Mortgagor of all amounts due and owing to Mortgagee under the Note and the parformance and observance by Mortgagor of all terms, conditions, obligations and agreements contained in this Mortgage.

(k) No Marger.

It being the desire and intention of the parties hereto that the Mortgage and the lien thereof do not merge in fee simple title to the Premises, it is hereby understood and agreed that should Mortgagee acquire any additional or other interest in or to the Premises or the ownership thereof, then, unless a contrary intent is manifested by Mortgagee as evidenced by an express statement to that effect in an appropriate document duly recorded, this Mortgage and the lien thereof shall not merge in the fee simple title, toward the end that this Mortgage may be foreclosed as if owned by a stranger to the fee simple title.

(1) Fixture Financing Statement.

This Mortgage is intended to be a financing statement within the purview of Section 9-402(b) of the Uniform Commercial Code with respect to those items of equipment, goods or inventory which are fixtures on the Premises. The addresses of the Mortgagor (Debtor) and Mortgages (Secured Party) are nerein set forth. This Mortgage is to be filed for record with the Recorder of Deeds of the county where the Premises are located. The Mortgagor is the record owner of the Premises.

36. Insurance Deposits.

If requested by Mortgagee, Mortgagor covenants and agrees to deposit with Mortgagee, commencing on a date acceptable to Lender and on the fifteenth (15) day of each month thereafter until the indebtedness secured by this Mortgage is fully paid, a sum equal to one-twelfth (1/12th) of the annual premiums payable for the insurance required to be maintained in accordance with paragraph 5 hereof. Immediately following an Event of Default (as hereinafter defined), Mortgagor shall deposit with Mortgagee an amount of money, when together with the aggregated deposits to be made pursuant to the above as of one month prior to the date on which the next annual insurance premium estimated by mortgages to become next due and payable with respect to the premises. Such

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deposits are to be held without any allowance of interest and are to be used for the payment of insurance premiums on the Premises next due and payable when they become due. Mortgages may, at its option, itself pay such insurance premiums when the same become due and payable (upon submission of appropriate bills therefor from Mortgagor) or shall release sufficient funds to Mortgagor for payment of such insurance premiums. If the funds so daposited are insufficient to pay any such insurance premiums, for any year when the same shall become due and payable, Mortgagor shall within ten (10) days after receipt of demand therefor, deposit additional funds as may be necessary to pay such insurance premiums in full. If the funds so deposited exceed the amount required to pay such insurance premiums for the year, the excess shall be applied on a subsequent deposit or deposits. Said deposits need not be kept separate and apart from any other funds of Mortgagee and Mortgagor shall not be entited to the payment of interest thereon. Anything in this Paragraph 38 to the contrary notwithstanding, if the funds so deposited are insufficient to pay any such insurance premiums or any installment thereof, Mortgagor will, not later than the thirtieth (30th) day prior to the last day on which the same may be paid without or nalty or interest, deposit with Mortgagoe the full amount of (20) such deficiency.

37. Trustem's Exculpation.

This Mortgage is executed by Chicago Title and Trust Company, not percenally, but as Trustee as aforesaid, in the exercise of the power and authority conferred upon and vested in such Trustee, and it is expressly construed as creating any liability on such Trustee to personally perform any express or implied covenant, condition or obligation under this Assignment, all such liability, if say, being expressly waived by every person or entity now or asseafter claiming any right, title or interest under this assignment. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Assignee shall not be precluded from: (a) recovering any condemnation awards or insurance proceeds attributable to the Premises; (b) recovering and tenant security deposits, advance or pre-paid rents, earnest money deposits or proceeds due and payable under the terms of any contract; (c) pursuing any remedy and any security provided under any of the loan Documents; and (d) enforcing the personal liability of any of the individuals who have guaranteed the payment of the lots.


