#### IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT:

- 1. Maintenance, Repair and Restoration of Improvements, Paymont of Prior Liens, Etc. Mortgager shall (a) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (b) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanics' liens or other liens or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (c) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hercof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to Mortgagee; (d) complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (e) comply with all requirements of law, municipal ordinances, or restrictions of record with respect to the premises and the use thereof, (f) make no material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance; (g) suffer or permit no change in the general nature of the occupancy of the premises, without Mortgagee's written consent; (h) initiate or acquiesce in no zoning reclassification, without Mortgagee's written consent; (i) pay each item of indebtedness secured by this Mortgage when due according to the terms hereof or of the Note; (j) not to suffer or permit any unlawful use of or any nuisance to exist upon the premises; (k) not to duninish or impair the value of premises or the security intended to be effected by virtue of this Mortgage by any act or omission to act; (1) appear in and defend any proceeding which in the opinion of the Mortgagee affects its security hereun ler, and to pay all costs, expenses and attorney's fees incurred or paid by the Mortgagee in any proceeding in which Mortgagee may participate in any ap city by reason of this Mortgage; (m) not suffer or pennit, without Mortgagee's written consent, (i) any alterations, additions to, demolition or removal. ... any of the improvements, apparatus, fixtures or equipment now or hereafter upon said property, (ii) a sale, assignment or transfer of any right, title or interest in and to any of the improvements, apparatus, fixtures or equipment which may be found in or upon the premises, (iii) any change in the nature or can acter of the operation of the premises which will increase the intensity of the use thereof, and (iv) a change or alteration of the exterior and interior etractural arrangement (but not to the exclusion of others) walls, rooms and halls.
- 2. Sale or Transfer of Premissor: Interest Therein. Mortgagor agrees and understands that it shall constitute an event of default under this Morgage and the Note entitling the in nedies herein and in the Note to be exercised if (a) the Mortgagor, or any beneficiary of the Mortgagor, shall convey title to, or beneficial interest in, r, of erwise suffer or permit any equitable or beneficial interest in the premises to become vested in any person or persons, firm or corporation or other entity in cognized in law or equity other than the Mortgagor or the present beneficiary or beneficiaries, (b) allow any lien or security interest to attach to the premises or the beneficial interest in the premises other than the lien of this Mortgago, excluding taxos and sments not yet due and payable (c) any articles of agreement for deed or other installment contract for deed, title or beneficial interest or land contract in the premises are entered into, or (d) any partn red in interest of a partnership, if any, owning all or a portion of the beneficial interest in the Mortgagor or any stock of a corporation, if any, owning all or a portion of the beneficial interest in the Mortgager is conveyed, transferred, or hypothecated, in whole or in part.

  3. Payment of Taxes. Mortgagor shall pay before at y penalty attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water payment of Taxes, and other charges agains. the premises when due, and shall upon written request, furnish to Mortgagee duplicate the state of the state charges, sewer service charges, and other charges agains' the premises when due, and shall upon written request, furnish to Mortgages duplicate receipts therefor. To prevent default hereunder Mortgagor, shall may in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which Mortgagor may desire to contest.
- 4. Insurance. Mortgagor shall keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said promises insured, until the indebtedness secured by this Mortgage is fully paid, or in case of foreclosure, until the expiration of any period of redemption, against loss or damage by fire and such other hazards as may reasonably be required by Mortgages, including, without limitation on the generality of the foregoing, war damage insurance whenever in the opinion of Mortgages such protection is necessary. Mortgages half also provide liability insurance with such limits for personal injury and death and property damage as Mortgagee may require and if required by Mr rigagee, flood and rents (which will assure coverage for loss of rental income for twelve (12) consecutive months) insurance. All policies of insurance to be furnished hereunder shall be in forms, companies and amounts satisfactory to Mortgages, (but in no event less than the amount needed to pay in the indebtedness secured hereby) with mortgages clauses attached to all policies in favor of and in form satisfactory to Mortgages, including a provision requires that the coverage evidenced thereby shall not be terminated or materially modified without ten (10) days' prior written notice to the Mortgages. Nor ge zor shall deliver all policies, including additional and renewal policies, to Mortgages, and, in the case of insurance about to expire, shall deliver renewal policies to the test than ten (10) days prior to the respective dates of expiration.
- 5. Tax and Insurance Deposits. In order to more fully protect the security of this Mortgage and to provide security to the Mortgagee for the payment of real estate taxes, assessments (general and special), water and sewer charges, and his zence premiums for all insurance applicable to the mortgaged premises, Mortgager agrees to pay to Mortgages, at such place as Mortgages may from the bit in writing appoint and in the absence of such appointment, then at the office of the Mortgagee in Chicago, Illinois, each month at the due dute for the monthly installments of principal and interest as provided for under the Note (in addition to paying the principal and interest provided for under the Note) in an amount as determined by Mortgagee, in such manner as the Mortgagee may prescribe, to provide security for the payment of the eal estate tuxes, assessments (general and special), water and sewer charges, and insurance premiums for all insurance applicable to the premises. Mortgi & r shall deposit at least 60 days prior to the due date of any such real estate tax, assessment (general and special), water or sewer charges, or insurance) premiums or interest or amortization payment, such additional amount as may be necessary to provide Mortgages with sufficient funds in such deposit account to pay each such item at least 60 days in advance of the due date thereof.

If at any time the amount of the real estate taxes, assessments (general or special), water and sewer charges or insurince, premiums are increased or Mortgages receives information that the same will be increased, and if the monthly deposits then being made by Mortgagor for this purpose (if continued) would not make up a fund sufficient in the opinion of the Mortgages to pay such item 60 days prior to its due date, said monthly consider shall thereupon be increased and Mortgager shall deposit immediately with Mortgages on demand such additional sums as are determined by  $\frac{1}{2}$ , nortgages so that the moneys then on hand for the payment of said item plus the increased monthly payments and such additional sums demanded in  $\frac{1}{2}$ . Descriptions of the sufficient so that Mortgages shall have received from Mortgagor adequate amounts to pay such than at least 60 days before the same becomes due and payable. For the purpose of determining whether Mortgagee has on hand sufficient moneys to pay any particular item at least 60 days prior to the due date therefor, deposits for each item shall be treated separately, it being the intention that Mortgages shall not be obligated to use moneys deposited for the payment of an item, not yet due and payable for the payment of an item that is due and payable.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, it is understood and agreed (a) that deposits provided for hereunder may be held by Mortgagee in a single non-interest bearing account, and (b) that Mortgagee at its option may, if Mortgagor fails to make any deposit required hereunder, use deposits for one item for the payment of another item then due and payable. All such deposits shall be held in escrow by Mortgagee and shall be applied by Mortgagee to the payment of the said real estate taxes, assessments (general and special), water and sewer charges, and insurance premiums, when the same become due and payable. The said deposits shall bear no interest. Failure to pay any of the aforesaid monthly deposits for 10 days after they are due or failure to pay any of the aforesaid additional deposits for 5 days after demand by Mortgages, shall be an event of default under the Note secured by this Mortgage and under this Mortgage, in which event all remedies under the Note secured by this Mortgage and this Mortgage may be immediately exercised by the Mortgages and, further, all moneys on hand in the deposit fund may, at the option of Mortgages, be applied in reduction of the indebtodness under the Note secured by this Mortgage.

If the funds so deposited exceed the amount required to pay such taxes, assessments (general and special), water and sewer charges, and insurance premiums for any year, the excess shall be applied on a subsequent deposit or deposits. The Mortgagor further agrees that Mortgagor shall not be required to make payments for which insufficient funds are on deposit with the Mortgages. Mortgager agrees that nothing herein contained shall be construed as requiring the Mortgagee to advance other monies for such purpose and the Mortgagee shall not incur any liability for anything it may do or omit to do.

Upon an assignment of this Mortguge, Mortgugee shall have the right to pay over the balance of such deposits in its possession to the assignee and Mortgages shall thereupon be completely released from all liability with respect to such deposits and Mortgagor shall look solely to the assignee or transferse with respect thereto. This provision shall apply to every transfer of such deposits to a new assignee. Upon full payment of the indebtedness under the Note secured by this Mortgage and the Mortgage (or at any prior time at the election of the then holder of the Note and this Mortgage) the balance of the deposits in its possession shall be paid over to the record owner of the premises at the time of payment and no other party shall have any right or claim thereto in any event.

- 6. Mortgage's interest in and Use of Deposits. In the event of a default in any of the provisions contained in this mortgage or in the Note, the Mortgages may at its option, without being required to do so, apply any moneys at the time on deposit pursuant to paragraph 5 hereof, as any one or more of the same may be applicable, or any of Mortgage's obligations beroin or in the Note contained, in such order and manner as the Mortgages may elect. When the indebtedness secured hereby has been fully paid, any remaining deposits shall be paid to Mortgager or to the time owner or owners of the mortgaged premises. Such deposits are hereby pledged as additional security for the indebtedness hereunder and shall be held in trust to be irrevocably applied by the Mortgages for the purposes for which made hereunder and shall not be subject to the direction or control of the Mortgager; provided, however, that the Mortgages shall not be liable for any failure to apply to the payment of taxes, assessments, water and sewer charges and insurance premiums any amount so deposited unless Mortgager, while not in default hereunder, shall have requested Mortgages in writing not less than thirty (30) days prior to the due date therefor to make application of such finds to the payment of the particular taxes, assessments or insurance premiums for payment of which they were deposited, accompanied by the bills for such taxes, assessments and insurance premiums.
- 7. Mortgage's Right to Act. If Mortgagor fails to pay any claim, lien or encumbrance which shall have a prior lien to the lien of this indenture, or to pay, when due, any tax or assessment, or any insurance premium, or to keep the premises in repair, as aforesaid, or shall commit or permit waste, or if there be commenced any action or proceeding affecting the premises or the title thereto, then Mortgageo, at its option, may pay such claim, lien, encumbrance, tax, assessment or promium, with right of subrogation thereunder, may procure such abstracts or other evidence of title as it deems necessary, may make such repairs and take such steps as it deems advisable to prevent or cure such waste, and may appear in any such action or proceeding and retain counsel therein, and take such action therein as Mortgagee deems advisable, and for any of such purposes Mortgagee may advance such sums of money as it deems necessary. Mortgagee shall be the sole judge of the legality, validity and priority of any such claim, lien, encumbrance, tax, assessment and premium, and of the amount necessary to be paid in satisfaction thereof. Mortgager will put to Mortgagee, immediately and without demand, all sums of money advanced by Mortgagee pursuant to this paragraph, together with interest on each such advance at the rate set forth in the Note, and all such sums and interest thereon shall be secured hereby.
- 8. Adjustment of Losses with Insurer and Application of Proceeds of Insurance. In case of loss, the Mortgague (or after entry of decree of foreclosure, purchaser at the sale, or the decree creditor, as the case may be) is hereby authorized either (a) to settle, collect, compromise and adjust, in its discretion any claim under such insurance policies without consent of Mortgagor, or (b) to allow Mortgagor to agree with the insurance company or companies on the amount to be paid upon the loss. In either case Mortgageo is authorized to collect and receipt for any such insurance money. Mortgager agrees to sign, upon demand by Mortgages, all receipts, vouchers and releases required of him by the companies. If (a) Mortgager is obligated to restore or replace the damaged or r'estroyed buildings or improvements under the terms of any lease or leases which are or may be prior to the lien of this Morigage, (b) such damage or destruction does not result in cancellation or termination of such lease, (c) the insurers do not deny liability as to the insureds, and (d) such proceeds recufficient to restore or replace the damaged or destroyed buildings or improvements in the judgement of Mortgages, such proceeds, after deducting therefrom un expenses incurred in the collection thereof, shall be used to reimburse Mortgager for the cost of rebuilding or restoration of buildings and improvements of said premises. In all other cases, such insurance proceeds may, at the option of Mortgages, either be applied in reduction of the indebtedness secured by oby, whether due or not, or be held by the Mortgages and used to reimburse Mortgager for the cost of the rebuilding or restoration of buildings or 1 ho evenents on said promises. The buildings and improvements shall be so restored or rebuilt as to be of at least equal value and substantially the same che actor as prior to such damage or destruction. In the event Mortgagor is entitled to reimbursement out of insurance proceeds, such proceeds shall be made available, from time to time, upon the Mortgagee being furnished with satisfactory evidence of the estimated cost of completion thereof and with such are hitect's cortificates, waivers of him, contractors' sworn statements and other evidence of cost and of payments as the Mortgages may reasonable require and approve, and if the estimated cost of the work exceeds ten percent (10%) of the original principal amount of the indebtedness secured hereby, with all plans and specifications for such rebuilding or restoration as the Mortgages may reasonably require and approve. No payment made prior to the fir also appletion of the work shall exceed ninety percent (90%) of the value of the work performed, from time to time, and at all times the undisbursed balance of aid proceeds remaining in the hands of the Mortgages shall be at least sufficient to pay for the cost of completion of the work free and clear of liens.

In the case of loss after foreclosure proceedings have been it stiral at the proceeds of any such insurance policy or policies, if not applied as aforesaid in rebuilding or restoring the buildings or improvements, shall be 'a a' to pay the amount due in accordance with any decree of foreclosure that may be entered in any such proceedings, and the balance, if any, shall be path to the owner of the equity of redemption if he shall then be entitled to the same or as the court may direct. In case of the foreclosure of this mortgage, the court in is decree may provide that the nortgages's clause attached to each of said insurance policies may be cancelled and that the decree creditor may cause a new loss clause to be attached to each of said policies making the loss thereunder payable to said creditor; and any such foreclosure decree may first or provide, that in case of one or more redemptions under said decree, pursuant to the statute in such case made and provided, then and in every such case, each successive redemptor may cause the preceeding loss clause attached to each insurance policy to be canceled and a new loss clause to be attached, thereto, making the loss thereunder payable to such redemptor. In the ever at of foreclosure sale, Mortgagee is hereby authorized, without the consent of Mr Agr gor, to assign any and all insurance policies to the purchaser at the sale, or to take such other steps as Mortgagee may deem advisable, to cause the interest of such purchaser to be protected by any of the said insurance policies.

- 9. Stamp, Transfer or Revenue Tex. If, by the laws of the United States of America, or of any state having jurisdiction over the Mortgagor or the premises, any tax is due or becomes due in respect of the issuance of the Note or this Mortgagor or the recordation thereof, the Mortgagor covenants and agrees to pay such tax in the manner required by any such law. The Mortgagor further covenants of hold harmless and agrees to indemnify the Mortgagoe, its successor or assigns, against any liability incurred by reason of the imposition of any orch tax.
- 10. Prepayment Privilege. At such time as the Mortgagor is not in default either under the terms of the Note or under the terms of this Mortgago, the Mortgagor shall have such privilege of making prepayments on the principal of the Note (in addition to the required payments) as may be provided in the Note, and in accordance with the terms and conditions, if any, set forth in the Note.
- 11. Effect of Extensions of Time. If the payment of said indebtedness or any part thereof be extended or varied or if any part of the security be released, all persons now or at any time hereafter liable therefor, or interested in said promises, shall be held to as real to such extension, variation or release, and their liability and the lien and all provisions hereof shall continue in full force, the right of recourse against all such persons being expressly reserved by the Mortgagee, not withstanding such extension, variation or release.
- 12. Effect of Changes in Laws Regarding Taxation. In the event of the enactment after this date of any law of the structured which the premises are located deducting from the value of land for the purpose of taxation any lien hereon, or imposing upon the Mortgages the payment of the whole or any part of the taxes or assessments or charges or liens herein required to be paid by Mortgagor, or changing in any way laws relating to the taxation of mortgages or debts secured by mortgages or the mortgages indirest in the property, or the manner of collection of taxes, so as to affect that Mortgage or the debt secured hereby or the holder thereof, then, and in any such event, the Mortgagor, upon demand by the Mortgages, shall pay such taxes or assessments, or reimburse the Mortgages therefor; provided, however, that if in the opinion of counsel for the Mortgages (a) it might be unlawful to require Mortgagor to make such payment or (b) the making of such payment might result in the imposition of interest in excess of the maximum amount permitted by law, then and in such event, the Mortgages may elect, by notice in writing given to the Mortgagor, to declare all of the indebtedness secured hereby to be and become due and payable sixty (60) days from the date of giving of such notice.
- 13. Mortgages's Performance of Defaulted Acts. In case of default therein, Mortgages may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act herein required of Mortgages in any form and manner deemed expedient by Mortgages, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or forfeiture affecting said promises or context any tax or assessment. All moneys paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorneys' fees, and any other moneys advanced by Mortgages to protect the mortgaged premises and the lien hereof, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby, and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at the rate of interest then applicable to the indebtedness secured by this Mortgages. Inaction of Mortgages shall never be considered as a waiver of any right accruing to it on account of any default on the part of Mortgages.
- 14. Mortgagee's Reliance on Tax and insurance Bills, Etc. Mortgagee in making any payment is hereby authorized; (a) to pay any taxes, assessments and insurance premiums, according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office or vendor without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, insurance premiums, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or title or claim thereof, or (b) to purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any other prior lien, without inquiry as to the validity or amount of any claim for lien which may be asserted.

- 15. Acceleration of Indebtedness in Case of Default. If (a) default be made for fifteen (15) days in the due and punctual payment of the Note, or any installment due in accordance with the terms thereof, either of principal or interest; or (b) the Mortgagor shall file a petition in voluntary bankruptcy under the United States Bankruptcy Code or any similar haw, state or federal, whether now or hereafter existing, or an answer admitting insolvency or inability to pay its debts, or fail to obtain a vacation or stay of involuntary proceedings within the (10) days, as hereinafter provided; or (c) the Mortgagor shall be adjudicated a bankrupt, or a trustee or a receiver shall be appointed for the Mortgagor or for all of its property or the major part thereof in any involuntary proceeding, or any court shall have taken jurisdiction of the property of the Mortgagor or the major part thereof in any involuntary proceeding, or any court shall have taken jurisdiction of the Mortgagor, and such trustee or receiver shall not be discharged or such jurisdiction relinquished or vacated or stayed on appeal or otherwise stayed within ten (10) days; or (d) the Mortgagor shall make an assignment for the benefit of creditors, or shall admit in writing its inability to pay its debts generally as they become due, or shall consent to the appointment of a receiver or trustee or inquisitions of all of its property or the major part thereof, or (e) default shall be made in the due observance or performance of any other of the covenanta, agreements or conditions hereinbefore or hereinafter contained, required to be kept or performed or observed by the Mortgagor and the same shall continue for three (3) days, then and in every such case the whole of said principal sum hereby secured shall, at once, at the option of the Mortgagoe, become immediately due and payable, together with accrued interest thereon, without notice to Mortgagor.
- 16. Foreclosure; Expense of Litigation. To further secure the indebt scheen secured hereby, Mortgager does hereby sell, assign and transfer unto the Mortgages all the rents, issues and profits now due and which may herent's become due under or by virtue of any lease, whether written or verbal, or any letting of, or of any agreement for the use or occupancy of the premises of any part thereof, which may have been hereofore or may be hereafter made or agreed to or which may be made or agreed to by the Mortgages under the powers herein granted, it being the intention hereby to establish an absolute transfer and assignment of all of such leases and agreements, and all of the axio's thereunder, unto the Mortgages, and Mortgager does hereby appoint irrevocably the Mortgages its true and lawful attorney in its name and stead (wirk or without taking possession of the premises as provided in paragraph 19 hereof) to rent, lease or let all or any portion of said premises to any party or powers of the such rental and upon such terms as said Mortgages shall, in its discretion, determine, and to collect all of said avails, rents, issues and profits arising from or accruing at any time hereafter, and all now due or that may hereafter become due under each and every of the leases and agreements, written or verbal, in other tenancy existing, or which may hereafter exist on said premises, with the same rights and powers and subject to the same immunities, exoner then of liability and rights of recourse and indemnity as the Mortgages would have upon taking possession pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 20 hereof.
