NOW, THEREFORE, Mortgagee to secure the payment of said principal sum of money, but in no event more than two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000.00) and said interest in accordance with the terms, provisions and limitations of this mortgage, and of the mortgage note accepted hereby, and the performance of the covenants and agreements herein contained, by Mortgagee to be performed, and also in consideration of the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents MORTGAGE, CONVEY AND TRANSFER unto Mortgagee, its successors, assigns, heirs, administrators, executors, and assigns, the title and interest therein, to be and being in the Villages of Glenview and Winnetka, County of Cook, and State of Illinois, to-wit:

THAT WHEREAS Mortgagee is jointly indebted to Mortgagee upon a Mortgage Note (sometimes referred to herein as ("Note")) in the aggregate principal sum of NINE HUNDRED FORTY THOUSAND AND NO/100THS (\$940,000.00) DOLLARS evidenced by one certain mortgage note of Mortgagee of even date herewith, made payable to the order of DEVON BANK and delivered to Mortgagee in and by which Mortgagee promised to pay the principal sum of a maximum of \$940,000.00 and interest at the rate (sometimes referred to as "mortgage rate") as provided in said note, with a final payment of the principal and interest due on the 25th day of October, 1991, and all of said principal and interest are made payable at such place as the holders of the note may from time to time, in writing appoint, and in absence of such appointment, then at the office of the DEVON BANK, 6415 North Western Avenue, Chicago, Illinois 60645.

WITNESSETH

THIS INSTRUMENT, made October 25, 1990, by and between La Salle National Bank, not personally, but as trustee and Trust Agreement dated September 21, 1987 and known as Trust Number 112671 (herein "Mortgagee"), and DEVON BANK, an Illinois Banking Corporation (herein "Mortgagee").

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3. Mortgagor shall keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire and such other hazards as may reasonably be required by Mortgagee. Mortgagee shall also provide liability insurance with such limits for personal injury and death and property damage as Mortgagee may reasonably require. All policies of insurance to be furnished hereunder shall be in forms, from companies and in amounts reasonably satisfactory to Mortgagee, with mortgagee's attorney attached to all policies in favor of and in form satisfactory to Mortgagee, including a provision requiring that the coverage evidence thereby shall not be terminated or materially modified without ten (10) days prior written notice to Mortgagee. Mortgagee shall deliver all policies to Mortgagee, and, in the case of insurance about to expire, shall deliver renewal policies not less than ten (10) days prior to their respective dates of expiration.

INSURANCE

2. Mortgagor shall pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and shall, upon written request, furnish to Mortgagee duplicate receipts therefor. To prevent default hereunder Mortgagee shall pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which Mortgagee may desire to contest. In addition, Mortgagee shall have the right, in its sole discretion, to require the establishment of an escrow account for the payment of all items listed in this paragraph 2.

PAYMENT OF TAXES

1. Mortgagor shall (a) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (b) keep said premises in good conditions and repair, without waste, and free from mechanics' liens or other liens or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (c) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to Mortgagee; (d) complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance, or as preapproved in writing by Mortgagee; (e) after no change in the general nature of the occupancy of the premises, without Mortgagee's written consent; (f) initiate or acquiesce in no zoning reclassification, without Mortgagee's written consent; (g) pay each item of indebtedness secured by this mortgage when due according to the terms hereof or of the note.

MAINTENANCE, REPAIR AND RESTORATION OF IMPROVEMENTS, PAYMENT OF PRIOR LIENS, ETC.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the premises unto the said mortgagee, its successors and assigns, forever, for the purpose and uses herein set forth.

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4. In case of loss, Mortgagee (or after entry of decree of foreclosure, purchaser at the sale, or the decree creditor, as the case may be) is hereby authorized either (a) to settle and adjust any claim under such insurance policies without consent of Mortgagee, or (b) to allow Mortgagee to agree with the insurance company or companies on the amount to be paid upon the loss. In either case Mortgagee is authorized to collect and receipt for any such insurance money. If the insurers do not deny liability as to the insured, such proceeds, after deducting therefrom any expenses incurred in the collection thereof, shall be used to reimburse Mortgagee for the cost of rebuilding or restoration of buildings and improvements on said premises. In all other cases, such insurance proceeds may, at the option of Mortgagee, either be applied in reduction of the indebtedness secured hereby, whether due or not, or be held by Mortgagee and used to reimburse Mortgagee for the cost of rebuilding or restoration of buildings and improvements on said premises. The buildings and improvements shall be so restored or rebuilt as to be of at least equal value and substantially the same character as prior to such damage or destruction. In the event Mortgagee is entitled to reimbursement out of insurance proceeds, such proceeds shall be made available, from time to time, upon Mortgagee being furnished with satisfactory evidence of the estimated cost of completion thereof and with such architect's certificates, sworn statements and other evidence of the estimated cost of completion thereof and with such architects certificates, witnesses of item, contractors' sworn statements and other evidence of cost and of payments as Mortgagee may reasonably require and approve, and if the estimated cost of the work exceeds ten percent (10%) of the original principal amount of the indebtedness secured hereby, with all plans and specifications for such rebuilding or restoration as Mortgagee may reasonably require and approve. No payment made prior to the final completion of the work shall exceed ninety percent (90%) of the value of the work performed, from time to time, and at all times the undistributed balance of said proceeds remaining in the hands of Mortgagee shall be at least sufficient to pay for the cost of the work free and clear of liens.

In case of loss after foreclosure proceedings have been instituted, the proceeds of any such insurance policy or policies, if not applied as aforesaid in rebuilding or restoring the buildings or improvements, shall be used to pay the amount due in accordance with any decree of foreclosure that may be entered in any such proceedings, and the balance, if any, shall be paid to the owner of the equity of redemption if he shall then be entitled to the same or as the court may direct. In case of the foreclosure of this mortgage, the court in its decree may provide that the mortgagee's clause attached to each of said insurance policies may be canceled and that the decree creditor and any such foreclosure decree may further provide, that in case of one or more redemptions under said decree, pursuant to the statute in such case made and provided, then and in every such case, each successive redemption may cause the preceding loss clause to be attached thereto, making the loss thereunder payable to such redeemer. In the event of foreclosure sale, Mortgagee is hereby authorized, without the consent of Mortgagee, to assign any and all insurance policies to the purchaser at the sale, or to take such other steps as Mortgagee may deem advisable, to cause the interest of such purchaser to be protected by any of the said insurance policies.

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8. If the payment of said indebtedness or any part thereof be extended or varied or if any part of the security therefor be released, all persons now or at any time hereafter liable therefor, or interested in said premises, shall be held to assent to such extension, variation or release, and their liability and the lien and all provisions hereof shall continue in full force, the right of recourse against all such persons being expressly reserved by Mortgagee, notwithstanding such extension, variation or release.

EFFECT OF EXTENSIONS OF TIME

7. In the event Mortgagee, as additional security for the payment of the indebtedness described in and secured hereby, transfers and assigns, or may hereafter assign, any interest of Mortgagee as lessor in any lease or lease, Mortgagee expressly covenants and agrees that it shall fail to perform and fulfill any term, covenant, condition or provision in said lease or lease, or any of them, on its part to be performed or fulfilled, at the time and in the manner in said lease or lease provided, or it Mortgagee shall suffer or permit to occur any breach or default under the provisions of any assignment of any lease or lease of the premises given as additional security for the payment of the indebtedness secured hereby and such default shall continue for three (3) days, then and in any such event, such breach or default shall constitute a default hereunder.

OBSERVANCE OF LEASE ASSIGNMENT

6. At such time as Mortgagee is not in default either under the terms of the note secured hereby or under the terms of this mortgage, Mortgagee shall have the privilege of making payments on the principal of said note (in addition to the required payments) in accordance with the terms and conditions, if any, set forth in said note.

PREPAYMENT PRIVILEGE

5. If, by the laws of the United States of America, or of any state having jurisdiction over Mortgagee, any tax is due or becomes due in respect of the issuance of the note hereby secured, Mortgagee covenants and agrees to pay such tax in the manner required by any such law. Mortgagee further covenants to hold harmless and agrees to pay such tax in the manner required by any such law. Mortgagee further covenants to hold harmless and agrees to indemnify Mortgagee, its successor or assigns, against any liability incurred by reason of the imposition of any tax on the issuance of the note secured hereby.

STAMP TAX

13. If (a) default be made in the due and punctual payment of said notes, or any installment due in accordance with the terms thereof, either of principal or interest and such default shall not be cured within the earlier of ten (10) days following the sending of notice thereof to the Mortgagee or as otherwise provided in said notes; or (b) Mortgagee shall file a petition in voluntary bankruptcy or under Chapter 12, Chapter 11, or Chapter 7 of the Federal

ACCELERATION OF INDEBTEDNESS IN CASE OF DEFAULT

12. Mortgagee in making payment hereby authorized (a) relating to taxes and assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or title or claim thereof; or (b) for the purchase, discharge, compromise or settlement of any other prior lien, may do so without inquiry as to the validity or amount of any claim for lien which may be asserted.

MORTGAGEE'S RELIANCE ON TAX BILLS, ETC.

11. In case of default therein, Mortgagee may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act herein required of Mortgagee in any form and manner deemed expedient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal of interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or forfeiture affecting said premises or contest any tax or assessment. All money paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorneys' fees, and any other money advanced by Mortgagee to protect the mortgaged premises and the lien hereof, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby, and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at a rate which is three and one-half percent (3 1/2%) in excess of the mortgage rate. Inaction of Mortgagee shall never be considered as a waiver of any right accruing to it on account of any default on the part of Mortgagee.

MORTGAGEE'S PERFORMANCE OF DEFAULTED ACTS

10. In the event of the enactment after this date of any law of the state in which the premises are located deducting from the value of land for the purpose of taxation any lien thereon, or imposing upon Mortgagee the payment of whole or any part of the taxes or assessments or charge or liens herein required to be paid by Mortgagee, or changing in any way the laws relating to the taxation of mortgages or debts secured by mortgages or the mortgagee's interest in the property, or the manner of collection of taxes, so as to affect this mortgage or the debt secured hereby or the holder thereof, then, and in any such event, Mortgagee, upon demand by Mortgagee, shall pay such taxes or assessments, or reimburse Mortgagee therefor provided, however, that it is the opinion of counsel for Mortgagee (a) it might be unprofitable to require Mortgagee to make such payment or (b) the making of such payment might result in the imposition of interest beyond the maximum amount permitted by law, then and in such event, Mortgagee may elect, by notice in writing given to Mortgagee, to continue all of the indebtedness secured hereby to be and become due and payable sixty (60) days from the giving of such notice. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained herein, Mortgagee shall not be liable for any federal, state or local income, excess profit, franchise or capital stock taxes of Mortgagee.

EFFECT OF CHANGES IN LAWS REGARDING TAXATION

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13. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraph hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the note, with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the note; fourth, any surplus to be distributed to the mortgagor or assignee, as their interests may appear.

APPLICATION OF PROCEEDS OF FORECLOSURE SALE

14. When the indebtedness hereby secured, on any part thereof, shall become due, whether by acceleration or otherwise, Mortgagee shall have the right to foreclose the suit to foreclose the lien hereon, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Mortgagee for reasonable attorneys' fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographers' charges, publication costs, and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring and such abstracts of title, title searches and examinations, title insurance policies, Torrens certificates, and similar duties and assurances with respect to title as mortgagee may deem reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title to or the value of the premises. All expenditures and expenses of the nature in this paragraph mentioned, and such expenses and fees as may be incurred in the protection of said premises, including probate, housing and building code violation, and bankruptcy proceedings, or in preparations for the commencement or defense of any proceeding or threatened suit or proceeding, shall be immediately due and payable by Mortgagee, with interest thereon at a rate which is three and one-half percent (3 1/2%) in excess of the mortgage rate and shall be secured by this mortgage.

FORECLOSURE; EXPENSE OF ALL TYPES OF LITIGATION

15. When the indebtedness hereby secured, on any part thereof, shall become due, whether by acceleration or otherwise, Mortgagee shall have the right to foreclose the suit to foreclose the lien hereon, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Mortgagee for reasonable attorneys' fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographers' charges, publication costs, and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring and such abstracts of title, title searches and examinations, title insurance policies, Torrens certificates, and similar duties and assurances with respect to title as mortgagee may deem reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title to or the value of the premises. 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16. In addition to each and every remedy heretofore or hereafter described or otherwise existing by law or equity for Mortgage Note it secures, Mortgagee grants Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the right of set-off against and a lien upon any deposit, money, credits and other property held by such Mortgagee, successor or assignee belonging to the Mortgagee. Each remedy provided in this Mortgage is distinct and cumulative to all other rights or remedies under this Mortgage or afforded by law or equity, and may be exercised concurrently, independently, or successively, in any order whatsoever. Mortgagee's forbearance to exercise any remedy hereunder shall not be deemed and shall not constitute a waiver of any right or remedy hereunder.

17. Upon, or at any time after the filing of a complaint to foreclose this mortgage, the court in which such complaint is filed may appoint a receiver or assignee, its such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency of Mortgagee at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the value of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not and Mortgagee hereunder or any holder of the note may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have power to collect the rents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further time when Mortgagee, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the premises during the whole of said period. The court from time to time may authorize the receiver to apply the net income in his hands in payment in whole or in part of (a) the indebtedness secured hereby, or by any decree foreclosing this mortgage, or any tax, special assessment or other lien which may be or become superior to the lien hereof or of such decree provided such application is made prior to foreclosure sale; (b) the deficiency in case of a sale and deficiency.

18. In any case in which under the provisions of this mortgage Mortgagee has a right to institute foreclosure proceedings, whether before or after the institution of a foreclosure, or whether before or after the institution of legal sale hereunder, forthwith, upon demand of Mortgagee, Mortgagee shall surrender to Mortgagee and Mortgagee shall be entitled to take actual possession of the premises on any part thereof personally, or by its agents or attorneys, as for condition broken, and Mortgagee in its discretion may, with or without force and with or without process of law, enter upon and take and maintain possession of all or any part of said premises, together with all documents, books, records, papers and accounts of Mortgagee or the then owner of the premises relating thereto, and may exclude Mortgagee, its agents or servants, wholly therefrom and may as attorney in fact or agent of Mortgagee, or in its own name as Mortgagee and under the powers herein granted, hold, operate, manage and control the premises and conduct the business, if any, thereof, either personally or by its agents, and with full power to use such measures, legal or equitable, as in its discretion or in the discretion of its successors or

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(b) to the payment of taxes and special assessments now due or which may hereafter become due on said premises;

(c) to the payment of the operating expenses of said property, including cost of management and leasing thereof (which shall include reasonable compensation to mortgagee and its agent or agents, and shall also include lease commissions and other compensation and expenses of seeking and procuring tenants and entering into leases); established claims for damages, if any, and premiums on insurance hereinafter authorized;

19. Mortgagee in the exercise of the rights and powers here in able conferred upon it by paragraph 18 hereof shall have full power to use and apply the aforesaid rents, issues and profits of the premises to the payment of or on account of the following, in such order as Mortgagee may determine:

APPLICATION OF INCOME RECEIVER BY MORTGAGEE

Mortgagee shall not be obligated to perform or discharge, nor does it hereby undertake to perform or discharge, any obligation, duty or liability under lease, and Mortgagee shall and does hereby agree to indemnify and hold Mortgagee harmless of and for many and all liability, loss or damage which it may or might incur under said lease or under or by reason of the assignment thereof and of and from any and all claims and demands whatsoever which may be asserted against it by reason of any alleged obligations or undertakings on its part to perform or discharge and of the terms, covenants or agreements contained in said lease. Should Mortgagee incur any such liability, loss or damage, under said lease or under or by reason of the assignment thereof, or in the defense of any claim or demand, the amount thereof, including costs, expenses and reasonable attorneys' fees, shall be secured hereby, and Mortgagee shall reimburse Mortgagee therefor immediately upon demand.

Reasons may be deemed proper or necessary to enforce the payment or security of the aforesaid rents, issues, and profits, including actions for the recovery of rent, actions in forbearance and actions in distress for rent, hereby granting full power and authority to exercise each and every of the rights, privileges and powers herein granted at any and all times hereafter, without notice to Mortgagee, and with full power to use such measures, legal or equitable, as in its discretion or in the discretion of its successors or assigns may be deemed proper or necessary to enforce the payment or security of the aforesaid rents, issues, and profits of the premises, including actions for the recovery of rent, actions in forbearance and actions in distress for rent, hereby granting full power and authority to exercise each and every of the rights, privileges and powers herein granted at any and all times hereafter, without notice to Mortgagee, and with full power to use such measures, legal or equitable, as in its discretion or in the discretion of its successors or assigns may be deemed proper or necessary to enforce the payment or security of the aforesaid rents, issues, and profits of the premises, including actions for the recovery of rent, actions in forbearance and actions in distress for rent, hereby granting full power and authority to exercise each and every of the rights, privileges and powers herein granted at any and all times hereafter, without notice to Mortgagee, and with full power to cancel or terminate any lease or sublease for any cause or on any ground which would entitle Mortgagee to cancel the same, to reject to disaffirm any lease or sublease made subsequent to this mortgage or subordinated to the lien hereof, to make all necessary or proper repairs, decorating, renewals, replacements, alterations, additions, betterments, and improvements to the premises as to it may seem judicious, insure and reinsure the same and all risks incidental to Mortgagee's possession, operation and management thereof and to receive all of such aforesaid rents, issues and profits.

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23. Any notice which either party hereto may desire or be required to give to the other party shall be in writing and the mailing thereof by certified mail addressed to Mortgagee at the mortgaged premises (designated by street address) or to the Mortgagee at its place of business or at such other place as any party hereto may be notified in writing designate as a place for service of notice, shall constitute service of notice hereunder.

GIVING OF NOTICE

22. Mortgagee shall release this mortgage and the lien thereon upon proper payment and discharge of all indebtedness secured hereby and payment of a reasonable fee to Mortgagee for the execution of such release.

RELEASE UPON PAYMENT AND DISCHARGE OF MORTGAGOR'S OBLIGATIONS

21. Mortgagor hereby assigns, transfers and sets over unto Mortgagee the entire proceeds of any award or any claim for damages for any of the mortgaged property taken or damaged under the power of eminent domain or by condemnation. Mortgagee may also, to apply the proceeds of the award upon or in reduction of the indebtedness secured hereby, whether due or not, on to the Mortgagee to restore or rebuild, in which event the proceeds shall be held by Mortgagee and used to reimburse Mortgagee for the cost of the rebuilding or restoring or buildings or improvements on said premises, in accordance with plans and specifications to be submitted to and approved by Mortgagee. 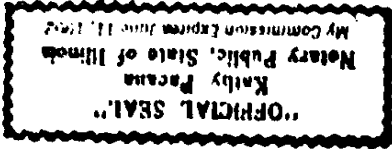

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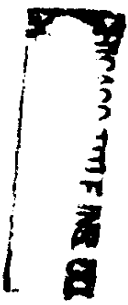
