- 3. That the parties were lawfully joined in marriage on May 7, 1944, and said marriage was registered in Chicago, Cook County, Illinois.

- A. That the parties be awarded a Judgment for Dissolution of Marriage and the bonds of matrimony existing between the Petitioner LYDIA HINES and the Respondent EMMETT HINES are hereby dissolved.
- B. That Petitioner LYDIA HINES be granted the care, custody, control and education of JEREMIAH, the minor child of the parties, and that Respondent EMMETT HINES shill have reasonable visitation rights with said minor child.



- C. That each of the parties shall pay his or her own attorney fees.
- D. That the marital home of the parties located at 9245 South Emerald shall be sold, and after all bank loans on the property are paid, the proceeds will be divided equally, and that both parties shall execute all locuments necessary to transfer and convey all right, title and interest in marital home to a bona fide buyer.
- E. That the Husband shall have the right to live in the home until the marital residence is sold, but that the Husband shall be required to pay all bills incurred for the upkeep of the home and to pay all utility bills while he resides in the house.
- F. That any arrearage in utility bills or other bills associated with the upkeep of the house that have accumulated at and up to the date of closing shall be debited from the Husband's share of proceeds of the marital home and paid therefrom.
 - G. That the Husband shall pay child support of \$200 per month, PAYARLE TO THE CLERK OF CIRCUIT COURT, COOK COUNTY, ILL.

- I. That the wife will be responsible for the ordinary medical expenses of JEREMIAH, and the Husband will be responsible for the extraordinary medical expenses of JEREMIAH, who is the minor child of the parties.
- J. That the Husband will provide a life insurance policy, with JEREMIAH as beneficiary, in the amount of ten thousand dollars.
- K. That the Husband will assist and cooperate in the Wife's continued participation in the Husband's medical insurance benefit policy, but such continued participation will be at the Wife's own expense.

- L. That the Wife shall have an appraisal done on the Husband's real estate located in Hale County, Alabama, and that the Wife will receive a credit for half the value listed in the appraisal of that property, and that when the marital residence is sold the Wife will receive that credit amount in addition to her 50% of net proceeds from said residence sale.
- M. That each party shall be solely responsible for debts incurred in his or her name
- their mutual satisfaction except that the Husband shall take certain agreed pictures from the marital home as his property but the Wife will have the right to make copies of those pictures. In addition, the Wife will be allowed to take from the home a stereo, certain metal cabinets, various papers and a dishwasher.
- O. That the Wife shall have all right, title and Interest in a 1978 Chevette and the Husband shall have all right, title and interest in a 1965 Buick and a 1972 Ford.
- p. That this Court retains jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter for purposes of enforcement of all terms of this Judgment.
