This day came again the Petitioner, CHARLES R. HUGHES, by his attorney, ROBERT W. MADDOCKED, and it appearing to the Court that said Respondent has been notified of the pendency of this suit by personal service of summons according to the statute in such case made and provided, that the default of said Respondent was taken and the Petitioner's Petition for Dissolution of Marriage is hereby granted as presented by said Respondent, and the Court having heard the testimony in open court of the Petitioner in support of the allegations contained in his Petition for Dissolution of Marriage; and the Court having considered all the evidence and now being fully advised in the premises, VINDS THAT

1. This Court has jurisdiction of the parties hereto and of the subject matter hereof;

2. The Petitioner was domiciled in the State of Illinois at the time the Petition for Dissolution of Marriage was commenced and has maintained a domicile

C. The parties were married on September 23, 1949 and said marriage was registered in Lake County, Illinois.

D. Three children were born to the parties as a result of the marriage, namely: RAYMOND HUGHES, Age 30, TIMOTHY HUGHES, Age 28; and CHRISTINE WAGNER, Age 32. No children were adopted by the parties and the Respondent is not now pregnant;

E. The Petitioner and Respondent have lived separate and apart continuously since September, 1978, and irreconcilable differences have caused the irretrievable breakdown of the marriage.

F. The Petitioner has agreed to transfer all his right, title and interest in and to the marital home located at 899 Home Terrace, Des Plaines, Illinois legally described on the attached Rider to the Respondent in lieu of maintenance.

G. The parties have not acquired any other marital property which has not been divided or disposed of.

ON MOTION OF THE ATTORNEY FOR THE PETITIONER, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

A. The parties are awarded a Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage; and the bonds of matrimony existing between the Petitioner, CHARLES R. HUGHES, and the Respondent, CAROL J. HUGHES, are hereby dissolved.

B. The Petitioner will transfer and convey all of his right, title, and interest to the marital home located at 899 Home Terrace, Des Plaines, Illinois legally described on the attached Rider to Respondent.
