- 5. Preservation and Maintenance of the Property, Leaseholds. THIS ADJUSTABLE RATE RIDER is made this 24TH day of MAY , 1991, and is incorporated into and shall be deemed to amend and supplement the Mortgage, Deed of Trust or Security Deed ("Security Instrument") of the same date given by the undersigned ("Borrower") to secure Borrower's Note ("Note") to CENTRUST MORTGAGE CORPORATION

(the "Lender") of the same date and covering the property described in the Security Instrument and located at: 1029 SOUTH 6TH AVENUE, La GRANGE, ILLINOIS 60525

THE NOTE CONTAINS PROVISIONS ALLOWING FOR CHANGES IN THE INTEREST RATE AND THE MONTHLY PAYMENT. THE NOTE LIMITS THE AMOUNT THE BORROWER'S INTEREST RATE CAN CHANGE AT ANY ONE TIME AND THE MAXIMUM RATE THE BORROWER MUST PAY.

ADDITIONAL COVENANTS. In addition to the covenants and agreements made in the Security Instrument, Borrower and Lender further covenants and agree as follows:

- 1. Under the Note, the intig, stated interest rate of SEVEN AND 500/1000 per centum (7.50000 %), per annum ("Initial Interest Rate") on the unpaid principal balance is subject to change, as hereinafter described. When the interest rate changes, the equal monthly installments of principal and interest also will be adjusted, as hereinafter provide, so that each installment will be in an amount necessary to fully amortize the unpaid principal balance of the Note, at the new adjusted interest rate, over the remaining term of the Note.
- 2. The first adjustment to the interest rate if any adjustment is required) will be effective on the first day of OCTOBER, 19 92 (which late will not be less than twelve months nor more than eighteen months from the due date of the first installment payment under the Note), and thereafter each adjustment to the interest rate will be made effective on that day of each succeeding year diring the term of the Security Instrument ("Change Date").
- 3. Each adjustment to the interest rate will be made be ad upon the following method of employing the weekly average yield on United States Treasury Securities adjusted to a constant maturity of one year ("Index"; the Index is published in the Federal Reserve Bulletin and made available by the United States Treasury Department in Statistical Release H.15 (519)). As of each Change Date, it will be determined whether or not an interest rate adjustment must be made, and the amount of the new adjusted interest rate, if any, as follows:
 - (a) The amount of the Index will be determined, using the most sec ntly available figure, thirty (30) days before the Change Date ("Current Index").
 - (b) TWO AND 000/1000 percentage points (2.00000 %; the "Margin") will be added to the Current Index and the sum of this addition will be rounded to the nearest one-eighth of one percentage point (0.125%). The rounded sum, of the Margin plus the Current Index, 'n' be called the "Calculated Interest Rate" for each Change Date.
 - (c) The Calculated Interest Rate will be compared to the interest rate being samed immediately prior to the current Change Date (such interest rate being called the "Existing Interest Rate"). Then, the new adjusted interest rate, if any, will be determined as follows:
 - (i) If the Calculated Interest Rate is the same as the Existing Interest Rate, the interest rr e vill not change.
 - (ii) If the difference between the Calculated Interest Rate and the Existing Interest Rate is less than or equal to one percentage point, the new adjusted interest rate will be equal to the Calculated Interest Rate (subject to the maximum allowable change over the term of the Security Instrument of five percentage points, in either direction, from the Initial Interest Rate, herein called the "5% Cap").
 - (iii) If the Calculated Interest Rate exceeds the Existing Interest Rate by more than one percentage point, the new adjusted interest rate will be equal to one percentage point higher than the Existing Interest Rate (subject to the 5% Cap).
 - (iv) If the Calculated Interest Rate is less than the Existing Interest Rate by more than one percentage point, the new adjusted interest rate will be equal to one percentage point less than the Existing Interest Rate (subject to the 5% Cap).
 - (d) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Adjustable Rate Rider, in no event will any new adjusted interest rate be more than five percentage (5%) points higher or lower than the Initial Interest Rate. If any increase or decrease in the Existing Interest Rate would cause the new adjusted interest rate to exceed the 5% Cap, the new adjusted interest rate will be limited to five percentage (5%) points higher or lower, whichever is applicable, than the Initial Interest Rate.

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- (e) Lender will perform the first ion required under Supara rapha 3(e), (b) and (c) to determine the amount of the new adjusted rate, if any. Any such new adjusted rate will become effective on the Change Date and thereafter will be deemed to be the Existing Interest Rate. The new Existing Interest Rate will remain in effect until the next Change Date on which the interest rate is adjusted.
- (f) If the Index is no longer available, Lender will be required to use any index prescribed by the Department of Housing and Urban Development. Lender will notify Borrower in writing of any such substitute index (giving all necessary information for Mortgagor to obtain such index) and after the date of such notice the substitute index will be deemed to be the Index hereunder.
- 4. - (a) Default. Lender may, except as limited by regulations issued by the Secretary in the case of payment defaults, require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Security Instrument if:
 - (i) Borrower defaults by failing to pay in full any monthly payment required by this Security Instrument prior to or on the due date of the next monthly payment, or

- (b) Sale Without Credit Approval. Lender shall, if permitted by applicable law and with the prior approval of the Secretary, require immediate payment in full of all the sums secured by this Security Instrument if:

- 10. Reinstatement. Borrowe. This right applies even after foreclosure proceedings are instituted. To reinstate the Security Instrument, Borrower shall tender in a lump sum all amounts required to bring Borrower's account current including, to the extent they are obligations of Borrower under this Security Instrument, foreclosure costs and reasonable and customary attentions fees and expenses properly associated with the foreclosure proceeding. - 11. Borrower Not Released; Forbearance By Len ar Not a Waiver. Extension of the time of payment or modification of amortization of the sums secured by this Security Instrument of Interest of Borrower shall not operate to release the liability of the original Borrower or Borrower's successor in interest. Lender shall not be required to commence proceedings against any successor in interest or refers to extend time for payment or otherwise modify amortization of the sums secured by this Security Instrument by reason of any (or and made by the original Borrower or Borrower's successors in interest. - 12. Successors and Assigns Bound; Joint and Several Liability, Co-Signers. Borrower's covenants and agreements shall be joint and several. Any Borrower who co-signs this Security Instrument but does not execute the Note: (a) is co-signing this Security Instrument only to mortgage, grant and convey that Borrower's interest in the Property under the terms of this Security Instrument; (b) is not personally obligated to pay the sums secured by this Security Instrument; and (c) agrees that the Lender and any other Letter may agree to extend, modify, forbear or make any accommodations with regard to the term of this Security Instrument or the Note without that Borrower's consent.
- 13. Notices. Any notice to Borrower provided for in this Security Instrument shall be given by delivering it or by mailing it by first class mail unless applicable law requires use of another method. The notice shall be directed to the Property Address or any other address Borrower designates by notice to Lender. Any notice to Lender shall be given by first class mail to Lender's address stated herein or any address Lender designates by notice to Borrower. Any notice provided for in this Security Instrument shall be deemed to have been given to Borrower or Lender when given as provided in this paragraph.
- 14. Governing Law; Severability. This Security Instrument shall be governed by Federal law and the law of the jurisdiction in which the Property is located. In the event that any provision or clause of this Security Instrument or the Note conflicts with applicable law, such conflict shall not affect other provisions of this Security Instrument or the Note which can be given effect without the conflicting provision. To this end the provisions of this Security Instrument and the Note are declared to be severable.
 - 15. Borrower's Copy. Borrower shall be given one conformed copy of this Security Instrument.
- 16. Assignment of Rents. Borrower unconditionally assigns and transfers to Lender all the rents and revenues of the Property. Borrower authorizes Lender or Lender's agents to collect the rents and revenues and hereby directs each tenant of the Property to pay the rents to Lender or Lender's agents. However, prior to Lender's notice to Borrower of Borrower's breach of any covenant or agreement in the Security Instrument, Borrower shall collect and receive all rents and revenues of the Property as trustee for the benefit of Lender and Borrower. This assignment of rents constitutes an absolute assignment and not an assignment for additional security only.

If Lender gives notice of breach to Borrower: (a) all rents received by Borrower shall be held by Borrower as trustee for benefit of Lender only, to be applied to the sums secured by the Security Instrument; (b) Lender shall be entitled to collect and receive all of the rents of the Property; and (c) each tenant of the Property shall pay all rents due and unpaid to Lender or Lender's agent on Lender's written demand to the tenant.

Borrower has not executed any prior assignment of the rents and has not and will not perform any act that would prevent Lender from exercising its rights under this Paragraph 16.

Lender shall not be required to enter upon, take control of or maintain the Property before or after giving notice of breach to Borrower. However, Lender or a judicially appointed receiver may do so at any time there is a breach. Any application of rents shall not cure or waive any default or invalidate any other right or remedy of Lender. This assignment of rents of the Property shall terminate when the debt secured by the Security Instrument is paid in full.

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NON-UNIFORM COVENANTS, Borrower and Lender further covenant and agree as follows:

17. Foreclosure Procedure. If Lender requires immediate payment in full under Paragraph 9, Lender may foreclose this Security Instrument by judicial proceeding. Lender shall be entitled to collect all expenses incurred in pursuing the remedies provided in this Paragraph 17, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorneys' fees and costs of title evidence.

18. Release. Upon payment of all sums secured by this Security Instrument, Lender shall release this Security Instrument without charge to Borrower. Borrower shall pay any recordation costs.

19. Waiver of Homestead. Borrower waives all right of homestead exemption in the Property.

20. Acceleration for Insurance Ineligibility. Borrower agrees that should this Security Instrument and the note secured thereby not be eligible for insurance under the National Housing Act within NINETY DAYS from the date hereof, Lender may, at its option and notwithstanding anything in Paragraph 9, require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Security Instrument. A written statement of any authorized agent of the Secretary dated subsequent to NINETY DAYS from the date hereof, declining to insure this Security Instrument and the note secured thereby, shall be deemed conclusive proof of such ineligibility. Notwithstanding the foregoing, this option may not be exercised by Lender when the unavailability of insurance is solely due to Lender's failure to remit a mortgage insurance premium to the Secretary.
